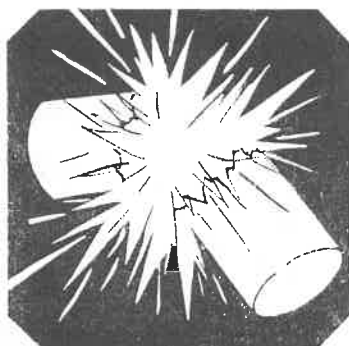
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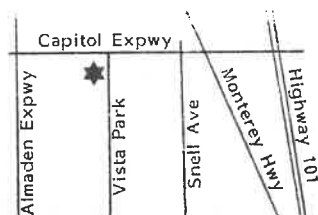

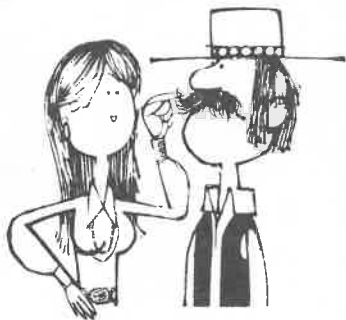
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"OUR" OPINION !

I attended two meetings this past week -- a meeting of the Union School District Board and a special meeting of the SCVSDA to discuss insurance options.

We went to the School Board meeting to speak against a proposal to increase hall rent -- **from \$25.00 to \$75.00 per night, specifically aimed at square dancers.** After several dancers spoke to the economic impact such an increase would have (clubs moving, or folding), the Board discussed the issue. Unfortunately, several false statements were made by District employees -- "we have to pay overtime to have someone at the schools", "the floors require more maintenance after the square dancers are in there with taps on their shoes!" -- and we were not given the opportunity to refute these statements before a vote was taken. The decision? Non-profit square dance clubs who wish to use schools in the Union District will now be charged the same fee as profit-making users: \$50.00 per night.

The SCVSDA insurance meeting was called at the request of club delegates. During their May meeting, the delegates voted to reconsider their earlier decision to continue medical insurance, and to consider any alternatives available.

This meeting was well attended, and Ed Peterman did a good job of explaining many of the factors involved in choosing insurance, both liability and medical.

One policy considered was a group plan through United Square Dancers of America (USDA). This plan, while including medical at a very reasonable price, does not have enough fire liability coverage to satisfy our local school districts. Ed pointed out that one reason for the lower cost was that the medical was "secondary", that is, it only pays in cases where a dancers' other insurance doesn't.

A possible solution: Find the lowest priced liability policy that meets SCVSDA needs, and also take the USDA policy as low cost medical coverage to cover the few dancers who need the insurance.



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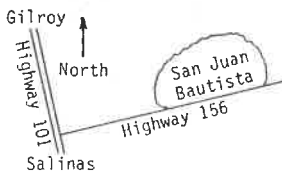

We haven't received the See's certificate yet, but when we do, you can bet we'll enjoy the candy.

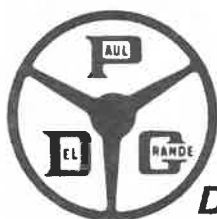

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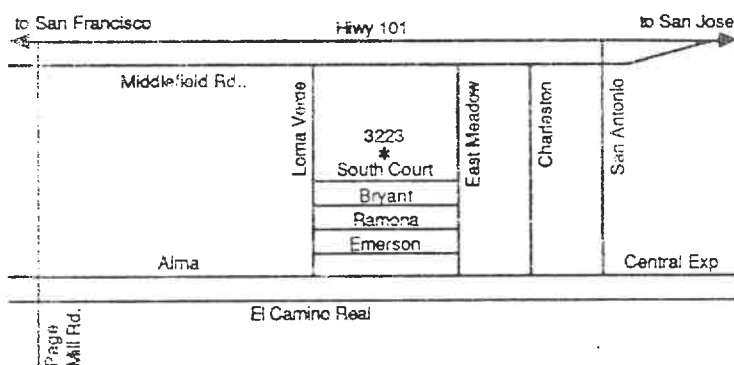
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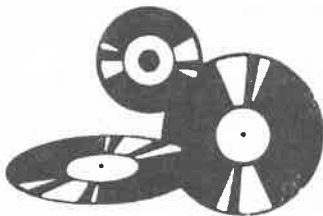

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CHALLENGE



★ CORNER

Thinking about taking up A&C? How is your Plus? Is it Mainstream with a little Plus thrown in now and then? Is it Plus from only "standard" positions and formations? If so, you may not be ready for A&C if you expect to go to dances where the "national level" is being called.

Can you do Peel the Top from a Column? Can you do Spin Chain and Exchange the Gears starting with men in the middle, or a boy-boy-girl-girl ocean wave? How about only turning the star one-half, or not turning it at all? How about Load the Boat starting with the ends facing out, or all girls or guys in the center?

If you can do all of the above, you are really good, and you are ready for A&C! If not, you have some work to do before you will be highly successful at A&C level.

As I have observed in many classes and dances, not all, but most of today's A&C dancers are weak on many Plus figures when they encounter them from other than "standard" positions. Many have never even seen a left-handed Coordinate, for instance. In this case, then, what do you think their success rate will be on a left-handed Transfer the Column or a left-handed Relay the Shadow?

If you can't do these things, how do you learn? You must seek out the callers who are capable of

calling these things and who do call them. You need to attend workshops in which material like this is taught. You need to vary your experience by attending weekend festivals and going to the higher level workshops. Too much work you say? Well, you will be working a lot harder in your first A&C class if you haven't prepared, than the dancer who did prepare.

As an A&C caller who teaches classes, I often reflect on the extra time that it takes to get through a class due to having to teach Plus calls from "other" positions. This becomes a double-edged sword. I have to have longer classes due to this, when I could teach more classes per year if I didn't have to do it, and add more dancers to the movement each year.

What can be done to help solve this problem? First, instead of callers trying to get into A&C because they think that is where the money is or as an ego trip, they can do better for themselves, and for their dancers, by learning more about a level they already know -- Plus. They should learn to "sight call" first, not always an easy endeavour, making it easier to do Plus calls from all possible positions and formations.

Second, these callers should then hold workshops not at Plus level, but at Plus all formation and all position level.

Third, a dancer wanting to head in the A&C direction, should attend these workshops. This makes the whole thing work for you and the callers, and you can learn A&C more easily when you move on to that level.

Those of you who have the first Prompter will find my article in it, and in most issues thereafter except when I was on vacation or had writer's cramp, as Chuck calls it. Well, writer's cramp (I have nothing worth saying) seems to come around more than it used to. So, I have joined forces with Bill Davis sharing this column on alternating months. Starting in August, with BD it will be the BD & BS Challenge Corner.

MILLIE'S SUGARED NUTS

- 1 cup sugar
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water
- 1 Tbsp. cinnamon
- 2 cups nuts

In a large frying pan, bring sugar and water to soft ball stage. Remove pan from heat and immediately add cinnamon and nuts. Toss until all liquid is absorbed. Spread on waxed paper, working quickly to prevent nuts from sticking together. Cool completely and store in airtight container.

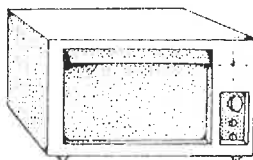
PARTY MIX

- 2 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce
- salted nuts

Break pretzels in half. Pour cereals into large roaster and sprinkle with salt and garlic salt. Melt butter with red pepper and Worcestershire sauce and pour this over mixture. Cover and bake at 250° for 1 hour, stirring every 20 minutes. Remove cover and bake 30 minutes longer. Mix in any kind of salted nuts. Cool and store in airtight containers. This will keep indefinitely.

QUARTER OUT CALLERLAB Advanced Call #34

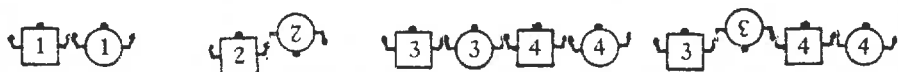
Definition

(CALLERLAB April 1984) Starting formation: Anywhere "partner" is defined, or the call FACE OUT can be done. Turn $1/4$ in place, turning away from your partner. If

you have no partner (as in single file promenade), then FACE OUT from the center of your half of the set. (Callers NOTE: The definition above replaces Burleson #61.)

QUARTER OUT

From Couples: Waves (R/L): Lines (1 Face): 3x1 Lines:



Turn $1/4$ away from your partner. If you have no partner, Face Out.



Dancing Hints

Quarter Out is another call that can be executed very rapidly and, if you are the least bit 'out of position' or hesitant, this call can catch you by surprise in a manner that may cause the square to break down. AND, this call is another example where EVERY dancer has an equally important part in assuring the correct execution of the call (and assuring the correct ending formation).

As with the companion call, Quarter In (see The Prompter, March 1988), the main 'secret to success' for Quarter Out is to very quickly establish exactly where you are in the set and WHO is your

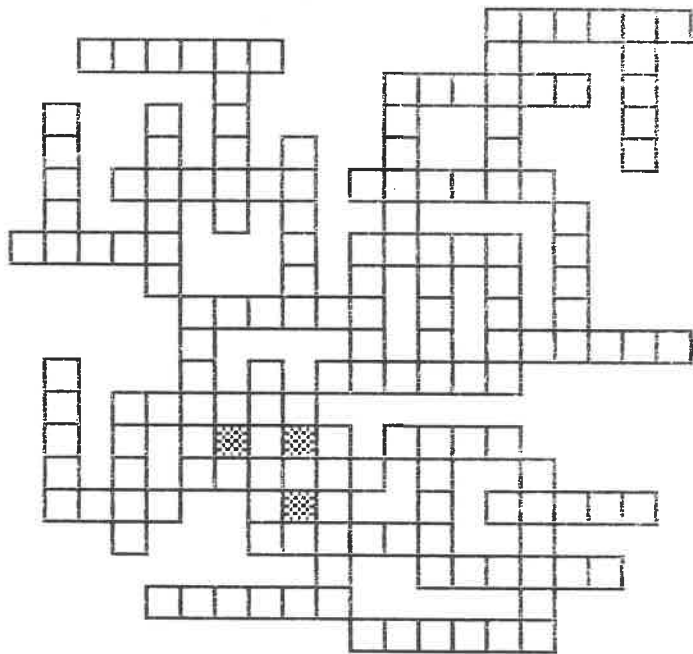
partner (if there is one).

In most situations, (1) when you are a center dancer, your partner is the nearest end dancer (and vice versa); and (2) when you have no partner, you will turn $1/4$ away from the center of your group of four (your half of the set) to execute the Face Out action.

When executing your portion of this call, you should be 'very crisp' in your $1/4$ turning action, and you should avoid any tendency to "wander" or move out of your position. A clean, crisp turn in place is recommended in order to achieve a high degree of success with Quarter Out.

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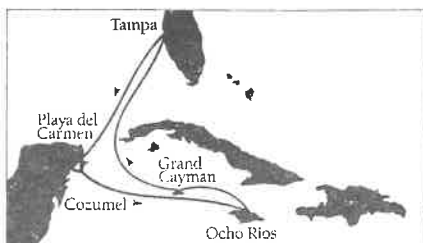

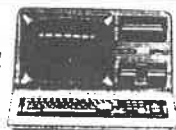
It's a great opportunity for you to help educate the public about what square dancing is all about. Hope to see you there!
