Last month we reported at length on the Nationals. We really enjoyed the Nationals as we have every time we have attended. We have already purchased early registrations for St. Paul Minnesota in 2002 and Oklahoma City in 2003. The Nationals will be held in Denver in 2004 and Portland in 2005. We intend to attend every Nationals we can from this time forward!

Many California dancers volunteered to work at the Nationals. We served on the committee for over a year. We found that our volunteer work for the 50th was extremely rewarding and satisfying. Our job was to promote the 50th wherever we went. In other words we were "getting the word out" about the Anaheim Convention. We were very rewarded for our efforts and were stopped again and again in the halls of the convention by dancers who wanted to tell us they had come to the convention because of our invitation. In addition to our efforts, literally dozens and dozens of California Square Dancers worked untold hours of volunteer time to make the convention a success. For these efforts we are truly grateful.

Callers from across the nation and around the world came to lead the dancing and entertain the crowd in Anaheim, just as they do each and every year. The very biggest names in calling block their calendar every year so they can attend and call at the Nationals. Just a few of the well known callers are: Tony Oxendine, Jerry Story, Bob Baier, Ken Bower, Jet Roberts, Joe Saltel, Debra Parnell-Jones, Daryl Clendenin, Ernie Kinney, and the list goes on and on and on. Many callers from the San Francisco Bay area came to the Nationals and called. Keith Ferguson, Byron Yoshimura, Jill Marci, John Sybalsky, Andy Shore, Al Knoppe, Bob Elling, Ed Kremers, Ben Goldberg, and many others came, many coming with dancers from their clubs. Many clubs went dark the week before the convention, and some for the week following. Even USA West which usually occurs in August, agreed to go dark and support the California Nationals. Most callers urged their dancers to support the 50th in Anaheim. After all, the last time a convention was held in California was in 1988, in Anaheim. At this time, no other National Conventions are scheduled for California.

Square Dancing could hardly exist without the volunteer spirit of so many talented and hard-working callers. Think of the caller or callers who taught you to dance. They dedicated themselves to learning to call Square Dancing, a matter that requires years of effort and work. After buying all of their equipment and records and devoting countless hours to learning to call, they continue to give of themselves. They come, night after night to teach uncoordinated learners who stumble through the sets. Where is the payoff in all of this effort? Mostly in the smiles and cheers of the dancers.

This is September, Square Dance Month. This is the time when many square dance classes begin. Is your club having a class? Where will the new square dancers come to fill the ranks of those who leave? Have each of you dedicated yourself to recruiting just one dancer? Have you signed up to be an angel? Each of us must double and redouble our efforts to help square dancing grow.

Most of all, have you thanked your caller for his effort, caring, and work on your behalf? Do so now, and do again by bringing in a new beginning dancer for the Fall class.
