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# Your Rovin' Corners

*Jim and Betsy have traveled across the US and around the world, dancing and promoting dancing. Each month we share with you our experiences and thoughts. This month we are looking at dancing in Europe in September.*

Last month we told you we were on our way to Germany to dance at the 50th Anniversary of the EAASDC. If you have not yet accessed the EAASDC Web Site, we highly recommend it. Dancing in Germany is doing well, and it is beginning in France as well. The Germans began dancing over 50 years ago in the aftermath of WWII. The American troops who were stationed in Germany started square dance clubs and over the years invited their German friends to join them. The German love of music and dance drew more and more Germans and they soon formed clubs of their own. Over time, the Americans were brought home, leaving a legacy of square dancing in Germany.

The EAASDC Bulletin, the official publication of European Square Dancing, devoted an entire issue to the 50th Anniversary. The first "Roundup" was in the German town of Bad Wildungen, chosen because the resort hotel there could accommodate the 250 dancers who attended, and offer good venues for dancing. German newsreel cameramen were present and were captivated by the display out of the "Wild West." The local newspaper reported that "The dances performed were very lively and colorful in their picturesque costumes, and the costume of the Caller drew special attention. He is probably the most important person at any Square Dance." Not much has changed!

The Caller in question was Cal Golden who, as reported in the Bulletin was "one of the world's greatest callers. He was a superb showman and a tremendous personality. He was certainly a most colorful character and his costumes had to be seen to be believed. Perhaps the greatest thing about Cal is that he was always very approachable. He never held himself aloof." The article goes on to report that he was "a native of Hot Springs Arkansas, he started dancing in 1947 and calling in 1948 in Colorado Springs, Colorado. He was first known as the Arkansas Kid, but later was given the title of 'the Man with the Golden Voice.' He called all over Colorado and Kansas until he was transferred to March Air Force Base in California in 1949. While there he called all over California and other states. In 1952 Cal MC'ed and called the world's longest square dance, being on stage for 25 successive hours."

"Cal and his family were transferred to England in 1954 and in 1955 he

MC'ed and called at the foundation dance of the EAASDC in Germany. At that event, Cal and two squares and a five piece band went outside and danced on the grass for 15 minutes for hundreds of German spectators. The group was recorded by two German newsreel companies and this film was shown in 1500 theaters before an estimated audience of 3,000,000."

The article goes on to detail his further achievements as a caller—leading 110 square dancers to the Brussels World Fair, calling dances all over Germany, his return to Arkansas, recording a 15 week square dance segment on Louisiana Hayride and much more. Cal received many awards and was one of the early members of the Square Dance Hall of Fame.

He called until health problems forced his retirement in 1986 after 40 years of service to Square Dancing all over the world. Cal is one of the 23 founder callers of Callerlab and was a member of the Board of Governors for 13 years. He was one of the first 10 Callerlab accredited coaches.

The EAASDC has two official "Jamborees" in Europe annually: Spring and Fall. Like the U.S. National Convention it is rotated about the continent. With over 500 clubs, the Germans have taken the lead in square dancing, and are training new dancers and callers, and forming new clubs. They have taken the lead in exporting Square Dancing to the former Soviet Bloc countries.

The 55th Anniversary of the EAASDC was in Bergheim, Germany, near Cologne. Over 2000 dancers attended from all over Europe and around the world. There were eight callers: Kenny Reese, Al Stevens, and Thorsten Gephardt and Stefan Forster from Germany; Mike Sikorsky and Doug Bennett from the USA; Terry McCann from England; Jason Dean from Australia; and many cuers, clogging leaders and contra leaders.

This was truly a great event in square dancing. We have followed up by dancing in local clubs in Hanover, Hamburg, Berlin, Nurnberg, and Stuttgart. As I write this we are preparing to leave for St. Petersburg, Russia to help train the first square dance class there. Big problem will be to develop a caller! Then back to Paris. We will report on Russia and Paris next month.

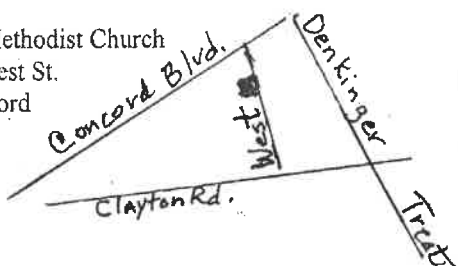

# For What It's Worth...

## Square Dance Etiquette

Last month we spoke about personal hygiene, this month I want to address issues that need to be dealt with at the club level. I call this section:

### *For the Good of the Club*

#### Visitors First

Ok, so you have a gathering. Everyone is excited about the dance, the caller and the cuer. Common courtesy tells us to allow all visitors to line-up for refreshments first. Some clubs insist that even the caller, cuer and their respective partners lead the line. I have always felt that this was a by-product of the Roman Taste-Testers. The idea is; you'll know if the food is bad, if the caller and/or cuer die first. After all you can always get another caller or cuer, but, you can't afford to lose any dancers. Just a thought...

#### Greet Visitors

The bread and butter of your club are visitors. Let all visitors know that they are welcome by greeting them at the door, thanking them personally and by inviting them into your square. If visitors feel welcome, they will continue to attend your club workshops and dances. Who knows – they may even eventually want to become members!

#### Volunteer – Don't Refuse to Serve

If at all possible, be responsible for something, even if it's a small thing. There is little actual work to be done if everyone pitches in, even if you can only help once a month. A club cannot exist without some assistance with the daily work (like end-of-dance clean-up.)

I still believe in the old-fashioned "Barn Raising"; where everyone gets together to help build your neighbors barn, has a pot-luck and then follows up with a square dance. My earliest childhood memories are of my father repairing a wall or replacing a toilet at the Rollingwood Rec Center in San Pablo, just because it needed to be done, we danced there and we took the maintenance of the hall personally.

#### Who Has the Floor?

Be conscious of your voice and its volume while someone is on the microphone making announcements or trying to teach. Even if you already know what is being offered you, others may find the information being conveyed important to them and your voice may be distracting.

#### Inappropriate Behavior

If you are witness or victim to any inappropriate behavior, such as verbal or

physical abuse of any kind, or contact that is too personal in nature, report it immediately to the president and/or caller/caller's partner. It must be dealt with immediately. This type of behavior must be stopped; even if you are able to handle it yourself, there are others that might not be as forthcoming as you are. This is not just personal, someone needs to know!

### **Let the Caller Instruct**

Your instructors have been chosen because they are experts at what they do. They understand the mechanics and definitions of the calls being used. If someone is having a problem with a particular movement, let the caller know – he/she will probably know the appropriate method of instruction. In most cases they have already seen the problem and are taking the proper steps to solve it. If, on the other hand, you have a suggestion or idea that may help, speak to the caller after the tip. Who knows? They may even use it! If you need to instruct a dancer in a particular movement, take it to the sidelines between the tips and in an area that does not block any other dancing.

### **Never Walk Out**

Never, ever, ever, ever, leave a square without enough people to dance. If you went there, stay there. It's only one tip – you can stick it out. I know how frustrating it can be to dance with someone who just doesn't have a clue and the square is in a constant state of break-down. However, it is extremely rude to walk out in a huff. Remember that you were once where they are and sometimes a little kindness can go a long way.

### **Set Squares**

A set square refers to the procedure of asking three other couples to dance with you. There are times where it is appropriate to set a square. For the most part it is rude to dance with the same people all evening long at your club. My rule of thumb is: if you are going to set a square (unless it is to assist a weaker dancer, or you are attempting some styling that others may feel is inappropriate) leave one position open for other dancers. If you intend to set a square make sure that all of the set positions are in place and that all of your dancers move to the floor at one time. If one of your dancers is unavailable at the time, at least make sure that all of the positions of the square have someone in place. If by accident you got in a square that you did not intend to – stay there, it is just one tip and you can put the square together next tip.

And last, but not least....

### **Make Sure Others Dance**

Make sure that all new dancers are up and dancing during your regular class time. They should have priority on the floor during class. Make sure that any visitors that wish to dance are indeed dancing. If it looks like a visitor wishes to dance and there is no spot available, start a square for them or offer your position to them. If your visitors or new dancers for some reason do not wish to dance, encourage them, but don't force them (it could be induced by a medical condition, after all!)

Well, there it is, for what it's worth...

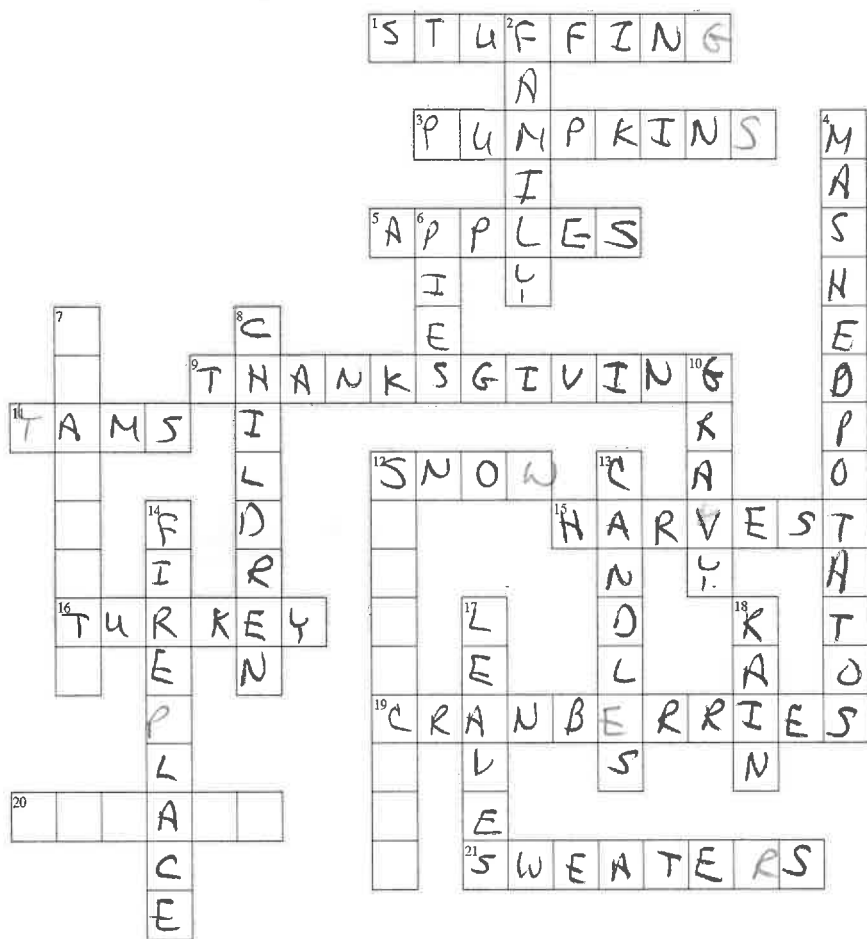

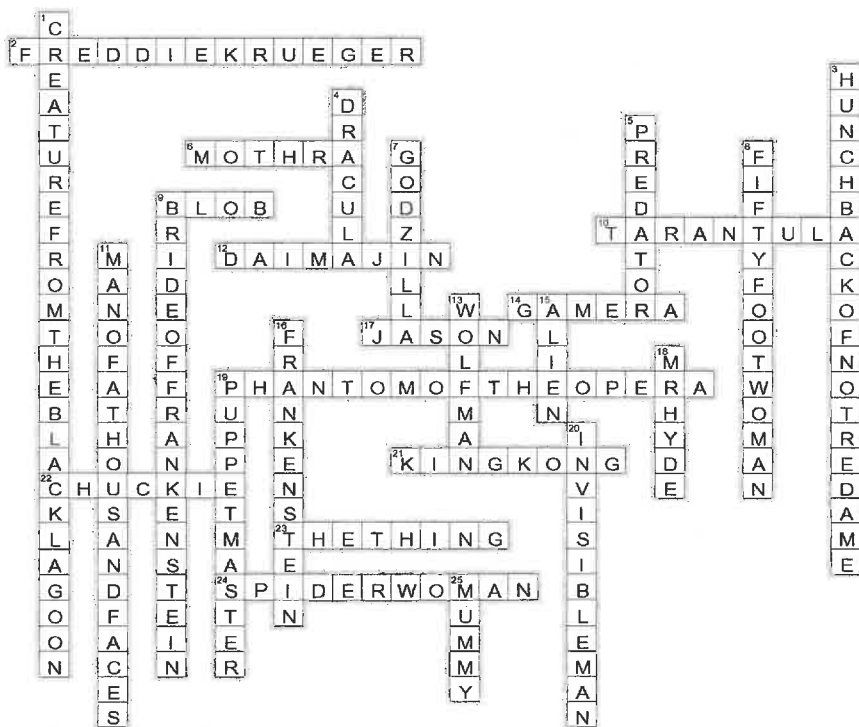

### Instructions for Registration (left side)

1. Print *legibly* all names, address, city, state, zip code, nation, and ages (the projected age of youth under eighteen) to ensure correct registration.
2. Recently enter all amounts in the Subtotals including registration fee for each dancer plus quantity and amounts for all other materials. If tours are selected, complete and return the Tour Registration Form and payment with this registration.
3. **Important!** Daily schedules are only available with the purchase of a Program Book. Daily schedules will not be available separately at the Convention. Most delegates will want to purchase the Program Book.
4. **Correctly calculate Total** and include credit card information (with signature), check or money order payable in U.S. funds, to the 55<sup>th</sup> National Square Dance Convention and return it with your registration.
5. **RV Camp and Rental:** Indicate RV Camping on your Registration Form and enclose the required fees (four-night minimum) to cover the nights that you intend to stay. Please check appropriate boxes. RV camp sites will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. If you plan to camp together, you must arrive together. *Bus passes are recommended.*
6. A \$5.00 fee *per registrant* will be assessed for cancellation or changes.

### Instructions for Housing (right side)

7. Check the *No* box on the Housing Required block if providing your own housing, or if staying in an RV arch.
8. Check the date boxes for each night a room is required. If you request housing in the headquarters hotel (the Menger or Crockett Hotel) you must have four nights of lodging.
9. **Room Sharing:** The 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau does not find or assign roommates. To avoid double booking, only ONE couple or individual should request the room.
10. Those wishing "Single Hotel as a man" submit their registration form together in same envelope.
11. Enclose completed Registration Forms for all persons in a group in the group's travel envelope and do not send them later than September 15, 2005. Include name and telephone number of group leader.
12. Indicate four (4) choices of housing preference, in order, by specifying hotel code letters. Be sure to indicate smoking and room type preference. Hotels will be assigned on a first come, first served basis, according to availability.
13. **Room Guarantee:** The 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau requires one night's guarantee via credit card or money order. Inform the 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau of any change in your reservation by May 22, 2006. After that date, the 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC blocks will be released and the hotel may charge higher rates. Credit cards may be billed anytime after May 22, 2006, at the discretion of the confirmed hotel. Checks or cash will not be accepted for hotel guarantee.
14. **Confirmation:** If an E-mail address is provided on the Registration Form, the 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau will attempt to contact you by E-mail 7-10 days before the convention. If you do not receive your acknowledgment in this time frame, please contact the 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau by fax at 210-207-6702, or via E-mail: [shousing@sanantoniofolk.com](mailto:shousing@sanantoniofolk.com). You will not receive a confirmation slip from the hotel.
15. **Reserving Changes:** Any requests for changes/cancellations must be made through the 55<sup>th</sup> NSDC Housing Bureau. 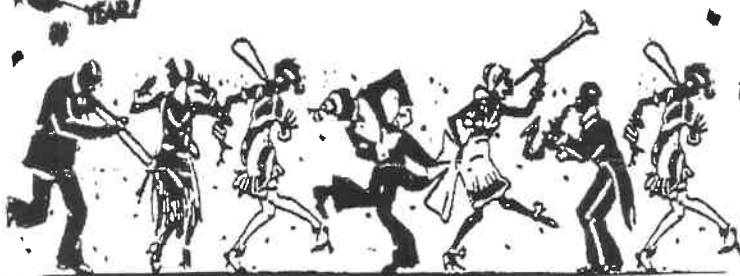

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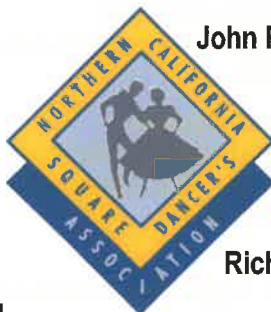

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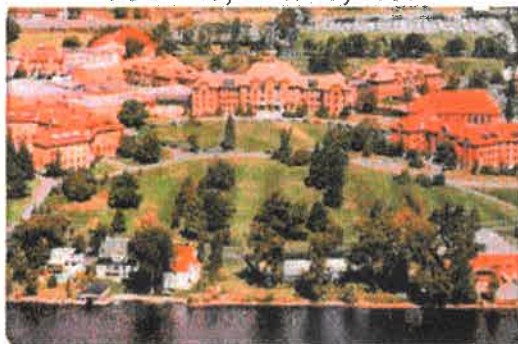
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
