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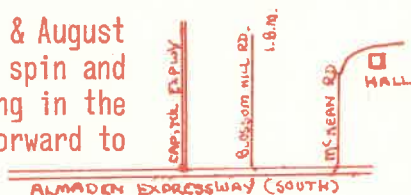

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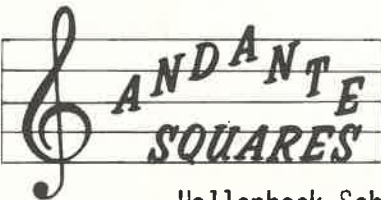

It Has Taken Almost 25 Years But The National Square Dance Convention Is Right Back Where It Started From .. Well Almost!

The First National Square Dance Convention was held in May, 1952, at Riverside, Calif. with CARL & VARENE ANDERSON as General Chairman. Now, 25 years later, the 25th National Square Dance Convention is back - this time on June 24, 25, and 26, 1976 in Anaheim, Calif.

The first to register for the 25th National was the number one couple in the hearts of Calif. Square Dancers, CARL & VARENE ANDERSON. The ANDERSONS are still working for the good of the National Convention, this year as Senior Advisors where their many years experience is invaluable.

KEN & AUDREY PARKER are General Chairman for this very special Silver Anniversary National. KEN'S square dance career dates back to 1939 when he organized a Square Dance Club on the campus of Bowling Green State University.

The PARKERS have been working hard since receiving the bid in Des Moines in 1972 gathering together a group of highly qualified Chairman to work with them.

Once the Convention begins on Thursday there will be dancing to suit everyone's taste. For the Square Dancers there will be easy level, mainstream, challenge and advance dancing. The Anaheim Convention will have an area for each of these levels.

Round dancers can choose there area and level as well. There will be Square Dance Rounds, Intermediate or Advanced level Round dancing.

There will also be a varied program for those who would like to give Contra Dancing a whirl.

Nor have the teens and pre-teens been forgotten. There will be a special youth hall - with clinics, workshops, and all levels of Square and Round dancing scheduled.

The small fry have not been overlooked either. There will be a "Little Red School House" child care center, set up at the Convention Center to keep the youngsters ages four through nine, entertained while momma and daddy dance. This service will be provided for a nominal extra charge.

The grand finale of the Anaheim Convention will be an after party at world famous Disneyland, just across the street from the Convention Center.

Tours which highlight attractions in Southern Calif. are also being planned. Tours to places such as Disneyland, Universal Studios, Sea World and Tijuana, Mexico will be available before, during and after the Convention.

Even if we retain the Plateau System, I hope the Callers won't keep changing the format of A, B & C. I notice that in the May issue of Square Dance News the 3/25/75 revision of calls has changed the sequence all around so you can no longer refer to the same numbers as in the publications of the American Square Dance Society, making it a bit harder for us to do our home work.

The CALLERLAB Quarterly Movements Committee has announced that there will be no movements selected for July, August, and September 1975.

When the Committee was originally formed with JACH LASRY, Miami, Florida, as Chairman, it was decided that no more than two movements would be suggested by the Committee for mainstream dancing in any one quarter. During the December 1975 to March 1975 quarter the movement "Coordinate" was selected as a single selection. Now, for the first time, because the Committee members who voted were not strongly supporting any one or two movements, the quarterly movements clearing house suggests NO QUARTERLY MOVEMENT for the next three month's period.

In lieu of new material the Committee suggests that during the summer months workshop on the existing quarterly movements, Recycle, Walk and Dodge, Coordinate, Transfer the Column and Half Tag, Trade and Roll and drill on any of the basic 75 movements.

To those who might be disappointed in not having the maximum number of new movements presented each quarter, it should be pointed out that it would be relatively simple for the Committee to suggest one or two of the dozen new figures recently invented. The Committee deserves special credit for its restraint and for adhering to the purpose of the clearing house -- to suggest one or two movements when, in the judgment of a majority of the Committee members, there are movements warranting this special attention.



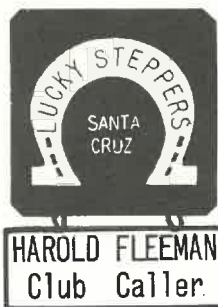
SANTA CLARA VALLEY CALLERS ASSOCIATION

Dedicated to HAROLD & MARGUERITE FURLONG who created and nurtured the club, and to HAROLD & LEE FLEEMAN who are perpetuating it. Compiled from club minutes and memories of some members.

HAROLD & MARGUERITE FURLONG'S dream was on the way to becoming a reality when HAROLD called the meeting to order on June 26, 1958, in Capitola School to discuss the formation of a Square Dance Club. Twenty weeks later, two squares were graduated.

Dancing started in a members lanai. Dues were \$4.00 a couple per month. The name, "Lucky Steppers", was adopted. Colors were green, white & gold.

Sept. 1958: Dances were held in the La Selva Recreation Hall. HAROLD FURLONG said of the hall, "It was a rustic old barn, perfect for Square Dancing."

June 1959: HAROLD & LEE FLEEMAN joined.

August 1959: First dance sponsored: The Soquel-A-Rama.

May 1960: Joined the Santa Clara Valley Square Dance Association.

August 1960: Started dancing in the C.P.D.E.S. Hall, Santa Cruz.

HAROLD FURLONG commented, "We were scared to death to go dancing there. It was like dressing up, like changing from work clothes to a tux for the first time."

1961: Black and Silver chosen for Hoedown dress.

August 1961: Present badge adopted. The badge had been designed earlier by HAROLD FLEEMAN for him and LEE to wear when traveling.

"We were a sight for sore eyes." HAROLD FURLONG laughingly recalled the 1962 "Hoot Owl", all night dance in Roseville. The dance floor had been painted green. Just before midnight, dancers noticed they were turning green. Dancing stopped. The floor vacuumed, the hall aired, and this had to be repeated. But when the dancers left for home, they were tinted green.

May 1963: Trip to Sonora. Later adopted as annual club activity.

HAROLD FURLONG resigned as caller in 1967. ERNIE TRIMPEY took over until 1969 when he resigned from the club and retired from the calling profession, and HAROLD & LEE FLEEMAN returned to the club, HAROLD as caller.

HAROLD FLEEMAN recalls a fun trip in Nov., 1959, to Napa area to qualify for Knothead badges. HAROLD said those who went in a car were worried about the fate of those who decided to make the trip in a small bus and were overdue.

ELMER & ROSEANNA DEWART, who joined in Sept., 1959, and were in the bus, said they arrived in time for the last tip, but only because they pushed the bus up hills.

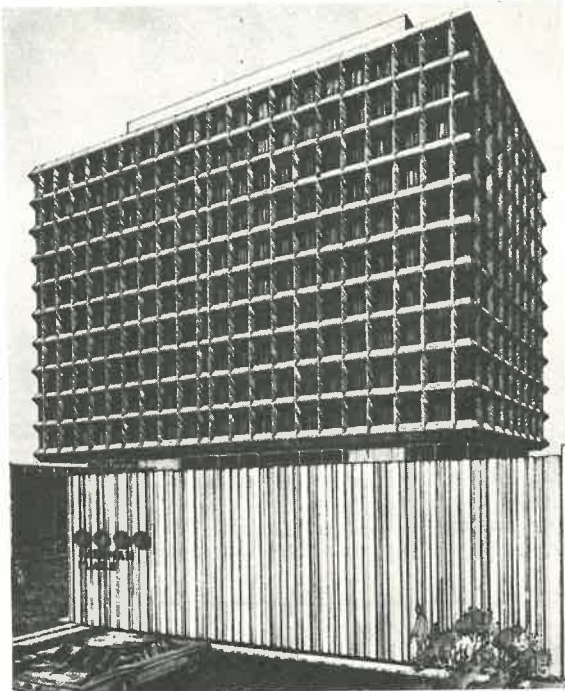
