A reminder, purchase your Jubilee Ribbon from your club Delegate early and save.

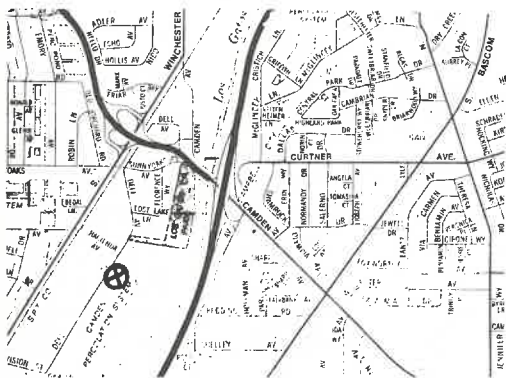

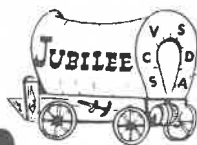

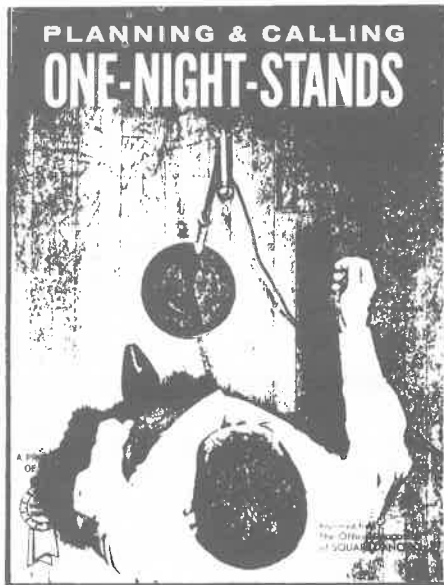
