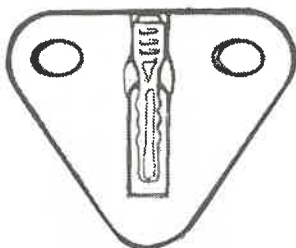

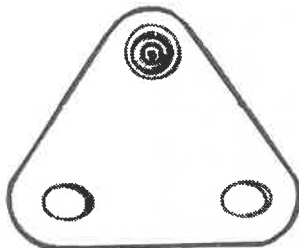

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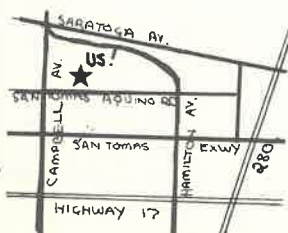

# Letters to THE EDITOR

From the Editor:

This letter was sent to us in reference to the Editorial in our Oct. issue on kicking, which many of our readers had asked us to mention.

Dear Mr. Oburn:

We are 18 and 16, President and Activities Chairman respectively, of the Blue Jeans & Calicos Square Dance Club. We have both been dancing for over four years. We have always admired your book "the Square Dance News". We thought it was a well written, accurate and fair source of information about square dancing. I cannot believe that I could have read such a biased cold, and unfair article in your book.

In your October issue of Square Dance News, you printed a section on "Kicking". As an editor, I see fit for you to edit articles that other people send to you to print so they are clean and fair. Don't you think you should edit your own writings too. This article has caused a great upset among square dancers of all ages.

Teen clubs are not the only groups that "kick" when they dance. "Kicking" is an expression of enthusiasm that many square dancers of all ages use. We could name a dozen clubs of adult married dancers that "kick". Square dancing is good clean fun and NEVER have I known of any person getting "kicked" while dancing, NEVER.

We have probably been to just as many or more dances & conventions as you have this year, and NEVER heard of or saw that anyone got "kicked".

We think the problem with "kicking" lies in adults trying to act young. People like you, Mr. Oburn, who think it's cute to make a joke out of it. That's where people get hit and get mad.

Teens are not perfect, nor are you, Mr. Oburn, nor anyone else. Your remark about teens though was based on personal biases and was definitely unfair. It would be like saying, closed clubs are too good for other dancers, they prohibit teens and treat outside dancers coldly. Ken Oburn's clubs shouldn't you think about what you are doing. Think of the name you are giving square dancing in general.

We want to see square dancing grow as a national, fun event for all age groups. Here in this area, this state we have more dancers than any other area or state. Let's keep it that way and keep it growing & spreading. Let's give people good clean fun for their free time.

Mr. Oburn, we do feel that you owe all teen dancers an apology, a big one. You have completely ruined your image of the good guy.

All we ask for is an apology and a rewrite of your paragraph in Square Dance News, Oct. 1975. Isn't that only fair, Mr. Oburn.

## CALLERLAB

For the three months period starting January, 1976 the Quarterly Movements Committee of CALLERLAB suggests one movement for the mainstream workshops and dances in January, February and March, 1976. The single selection is: Locket. The Committee after sorting through all current movements decided that this single choice was appropriate at this time. It is the Committee's hope that all caller/teachers will include Locket in their mainstream dance program and workshops during the coming quarter. Here is the description and two drills for this Quarterly Movement selection:

### LOCKIT LEE KOPMAN

The action in Locket can start either in an ocean wave or a two-faced line formation (actually the ocean wave set up is the more acceptable). From an ocean wave, the centers of the wave will do a one-quarter arm turn (hinge) while the dancers on the ends move forward and a round as in a fan the top. The movement terminates with the dancers once again in an ocean wave at right angles to the original formation. When Locket starts from a two-faced line dancers follow the same action with the entire line rotating 90 degrees as the dancers move forward. Examples:

Heads do sa do  
To an ocean wave  
Locket  
Square thru 3/4  
Left allemande

Heads lead right & circle to a line  
Do sa do to a wave -- Locket  
Swing thru -- Boys trade  
Boys run -- Bend the line  
Crosstrail -- Left allemande
