"A Past to Remember — A Future to Mold"

Each June when the National Square Dance Convention is held it marks the gathering of tens of thousands of dancers, square, round and contra enthusiasts. Each of these areas of the American folk dance are covered to their fullest.

More than 275 hours of dancing have been programmed during the three days of the Convention. This will include all categories and levels, from beginning to advanced, challenge and youth. Yes, every aspect of the square, round and contra dance movements will be represented with a complete program of activities.

Those desiring a recess from the rigors of the dance are encouraged to become enlightened during the 200 plus hours of educational programs to be offered as an integral part of the Convention. Here again, all facets of the activity will be allotted space and time on the program.

In addition, many special projects are included. Those arriving on Wednesday will be afforded the opportunity to visit and dance at the site of the First National Square Dance Convention, Riverside, California, in 1952 was the birth place of the National Convention and will provide the setting for a Trail End Dance with top callers, many of whom were on the program when it all began twenty-five years ago.

While traveling to the Convention dancers will be afforded the opportunity of attending various Trail Dances. These will be held all along the Trail to Anaheim. Among those scheduled in California will be the Tenth Annual Cup of Gold, Sonora, June 18, 19, and 20, Palm Springs, June 19, and Camarillo, June 22. Should you be planning a Trail Dance in your area please notify: 25th National Square Dance Convention, P.O. Box 1976, Dept. 25, Vista, Calif. 92083.

The "Little Red School House" will provide childcare service for those having children not yet ready to dance. This unique aid is available for youngsters from the age of five through nine for the nominal charge of fifty cents per hour and their registration to the Convention. In charge of the "Little Red School House" will be personnel trained in the techniques of handling children.

For those traveling from foreign countries a bilingual information center will be available. Truly the need of every dancer will be cared for during the convention.

All of these activities will be held simultaneously, under one roof, at the Anaheim Convention Center, Anaheim, Calif. June 24, 25, and 26, 1976.

*** * * Presidents Message * * ***

Every new year or new administration brings with it a need for many things, most of which require "MONEY", so here, in a nut shell, is the topic for Feb.

First, let's take a look at our income. The primary source is Dues, and at \$1.00 per person we will average about \$2500.00 annually. Our dues have remained at \$1.00 per person for nearly twenty years. The secondary source of income is realized from excess delegate registrations at Jubilees and Whing Dings. We also share in excess Delegate registrations at State Conventions, and Nationals when they are held in our State.

Second, we will examine our proposed budget to see where the Dollars will go in 1976. The proposed total is \$3535.00. Some of the major items follow; Liability Insurance \$700.00, Meeting Hall Expense \$400.00, State Council Expense \$440.00, Calendars, Manuals & Printing \$650.00, Surety Bonds Audit Fees & Legal Fees \$250.00, Secretarial Supplies \$250.00, Square Dance Public Relations \$200.00. Sub total \$2890.00, a detailed accounting of budget and expenditures are available through your Delegate. Our Association is in a healthy financial position, with adequate reserves to handle unforeseen reverses. We may even have enough, soon, to form the nucleus of a Square Dance Center Building Fund. Many of us have dreamed this dream over and over again.

Third, let's take a look into the future. Through the dedicated efforts of your past Jubilee and Whing Ding Committees, plus the support of the Dancers and Callers, we have generated a healthy financial climate. While it's nice to contemplate some of the many ways we can make use of these dollars, we must, at the same time, consider certain changes in the financial structure of our Association to ensure its operation on a sound Dollar basis.

As the hoedown is the source of something more than enjoyment, to the club sponsoring the event; so are the Dancing events sponsored by the Dancers and Callers Associations. With Dancers support of all dancing events we will not only have a more enjoyable dancing life; but the clubs and associations will better be able to help make Square Dancing more fun for everyone.

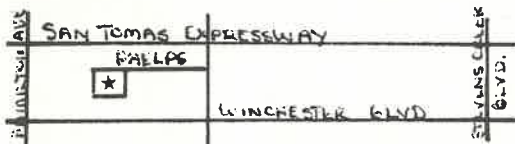

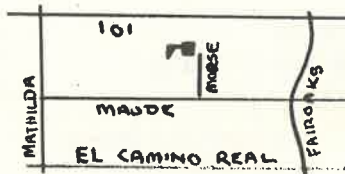

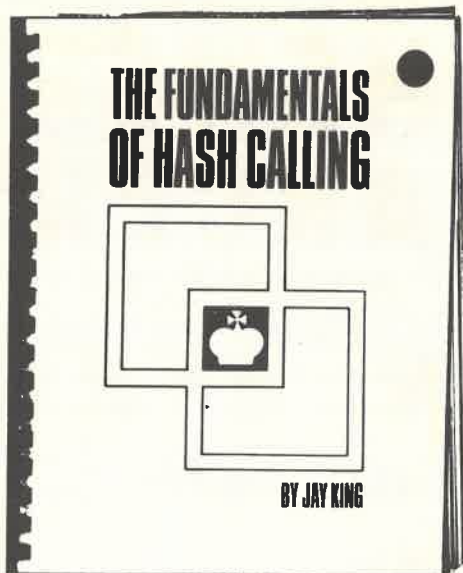
