SINGLE SQUARE DANCERS, U.S.A.

This past year while serving as president of Single Square Dancers, U.S.A., we wanted to do something helpful for all single dancers.

For years dancers have asked for a directory of singles' clubs. This project was undertaken and a list of approximately 200 clubs was compiled and printed in a booklet called "THE YELLOWROCK."

Since our organization is a non-profit club we needed a project to spend the proceeds from this book on. It was decided that we should do something to promote square dancing for the young adult, at the age of 18 to 24. When a young person is ready to step out on their own, it is a challenge of their lifetime. It would be great if we could motivate the teenage dancers to stay with square dancing through this period of their life.

It was decided to set up a scholarship fund for young callers that are attending college and are continuing their calling.

The proceeds from "THE YELLOWROCK" will be set aside for this fund. To make this project a worthy adventure, we feel that all square dancers should have an opportunity to participate. Any individual, club, or organization wishing to participate can do so by making a donation to the scholarship fund or by purchasing a "YELLOWROCK" at \$1.00 each plus postage. 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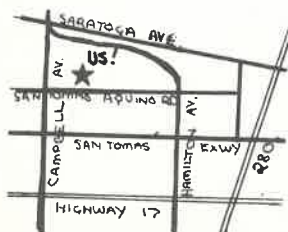

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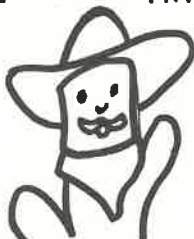

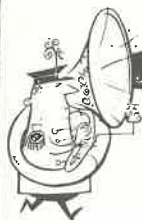
