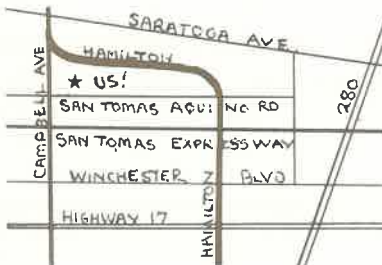

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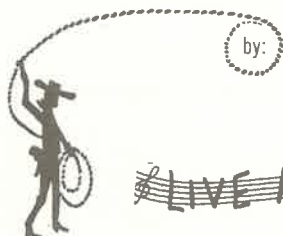

Now there is no way an immediate solution can be found; but with the understanding and cooperation of all clubs in our Association we can come up with a program that will, over a two or three year period, bring order out of chaos.

Mac & Mary McClure, of the Spinning Wheels, will head up this Committee and are looking for helpful hints. If you have some constructive thoughts or ideas, pass them along through your Director or send them through the Association Mail Box. Working with Mac & Mary are: Irv Ross & Marge Horton, Bachelors 'N Bachelorettes, Wes & Shirl Leigh, Mavericks Mike & Norma Degmetich Caller for Wheeler Dealers, Jack & Billie Coble, Calendar Chairman, John & Dorothy Calahan, Pub.

Let's all work with these people so that we Dancers won't have to pick and choose one Saturday then have to dance out of area another Saturday.

CALLERLAB

The CALLERLAB Quarterly Movements Committee selects for April May, June Quarter one experimental movement and one review movement from the Mainstream Basic List. The experimental movement is Chase Right. Here is the description, some comments and a few examples.

CHASE RIGHT -- Lee Kopman

The action starts from couples back to back. On the command Chase Right, those in the girls positions do a "large" (but not wide) zoom action moving to the place of the girls position in the couple behind them. The zoom action brings the girl to a facing-in position. The persons in the boys positions will run or fold into the vacated girls positions and then the boys circulate one position. The boys will end facing out. From normal lines of four facing out, the Chase Right call will place the square in two parallel ocean waves with the girls facing in and the boys facing out. When the action takes place with the couples back to back in a trade by formation the result is a column formation. All the flow is to the RIGHT as the dancing action takes place, thus the name Chase Right. (It is possible to Chase Left or Left Chase, however, for mainstream dancing the basic Chase Right is suggested.)

NOTE: A simple zero figure will allow you to easily become acquainted with the actions.

Normal Facing Couples: ... Pass thru -- Chase right
Boys run -- Zero (Back to original starting position)

During the coming Quarter the Committee suggests the review of Dixie Style to an Ocean Wave rather than the selection of another new experimental figure. Dixie Style to a Wave is part of the Mainstream program but in many areas could use a good dancing review and some attention given to how it can best fit into the club dancing program.

The action starts with facing couples in motion or in single file. The girls extend right hands and move by to extend left hands to the waiting man. The left hands are joined & as the dancers move by the left hands remain joined and the men reach to join right hands with each other causing all dancers to turn as the left handed wave is formed. The nature of the action leads to the suggestion that Dixie Style be preceded with a right and left thru or square thru 3/4 courtesy turn to help lead into the starting action of the girls leading for the Dixie Style. This type of start smooths out the entry into the figure for better dancing.

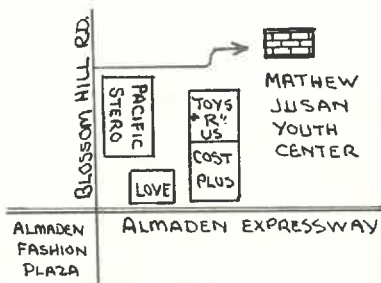

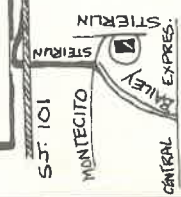

MODULE CHOREOGRAPHY by John Strong

In the preface of this booklet the author explains — "Module Choreography is a term I developed to describe the method of sectionalizing your dance figures so that they may be used to their fullest extent to give maximum variety to your program with a minimum of effort. It might also be described as "Understanding B1-4, Z-L, etc."

"By using this information contained in this booklet you should have adequate material to get started on your programs and the basis for developing your own set of modules and your own choreography."

Part one of this 26-page booklet covers "Explanation of Terms, How to use Starting and Ending Positions, How to use Basic Modules, and When should you use Basic Modules?"

Part two concerns "Get Ins", "Get Outs", "Changes" and "Main Modules."

Part three warns the caller "Look Before You Leap!" and explains well the expanded terms and the use of the expanded module system.

Parts four and five give further information on modules.

In his epilog, John Strong writes —

"Module calling will make your programming easier and more enjoyable due to the variation of material you will be able to use.

"A module system is quite simple to set up and works well with your existing method of calling. It is not a complete method of calling, but rather one tool that will blend well with what you are now using.

"Callers will find the module concept fits especially well into a Zero and Equivalent System. Many of the basic idea of these two systems are features of both.

"For sight callers the ideas of modules can be most helpful, you'll find new material easier to introduce and much more variation of your existing material will appear.

"I am certain that after reading this booklet you will have gained valuable insight into what your existing system and sources can do, and even before becoming completely familiar with modules, the basic ideas contained here will be helpful to you."
