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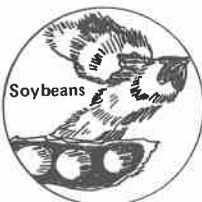

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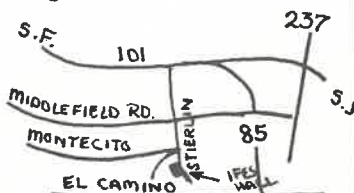

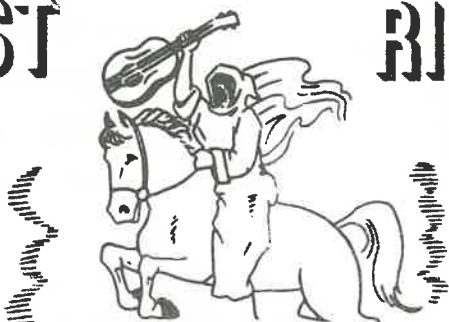

Dear Reader:

"They tell me all the calls are directed to the men, well, yes & no. Dixie Style is directed to the ladies...but it should be given the same treatment as being a mans basic. It poses a problem for the men in that the automatic reflex is for the man to use his right hand. When teaching this movement it should be emphasized that is is a left hand basic for the men. If nothing else works have the men put their right hand in their pocket. It works wonders to make the man use his right (proper) hand. A good basic, Dixie Style gives versatility to tag figures & left swing thrus, an others. This one I like!"

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Why Round Dancing ?? by Millard & June McKinney

Mostly because it is fun, you will enjoy doing it, and it will improve your Square Dancing.

Round Dancing on Saturday nites can provide many pleasures it will permit R/D to partake of the "Whole Dancing Picture", many consider it the Frosting on the Cake. However from Loyd Shaws time and even before couple dancing has always been a part of Western Dance picture.

The personal benefits are many: Round Dancing stresses dancing to the beat of the music, following the Rhythm. Once the R/D beginner has mastered "listening to the music for the beat" (rhythm) the footwork isn't difficult. This attribute of rhythm dancing can certainly be a great benefit to S/D also. Round Dancers can also be smoother dancers because they follow the music. Once you realize that there are only 3 (or four) functions to Round dancing its easy: 1. Placing the foot, 2. Changing the weight, 3. In time to the music, 4. Gracefully.

Many of the more experienced R/D Teachers follow the adage of "Basics First, routines second". If the neophyte can put up with 6-8 weeks of working with Basics and Rhythm interpretations, then the Routines (Dances) will come easily. However if you attempt Basics and Routines at the same time, the result may be disastrous.

Give me the dancer who says "I have 2 left feet:", at least this person will be correct half of the time.

After Basics most R/D can master the S/D ROM during the teach month, and dance it fairly well as long as they receive a few well timed cues. "Cues" are the key words, related to Basics that assist the R/D to dance the routine comfortably. How much cueing?? Enough to keep the floor moving well, so the dancers can enjoy the routine.

Most Dancers can, after Basics, develop to become good dancers, the man should lead - the woman should follow, thats the way that it works (Womens lib advocates - thats my view point and thats the way it works for me), most women prefer it this way.

Most Dancers Can Develop Thru The Four Stages:

1. Inaccurate footwork, not very graceful,
2. Accurate footwork, with some grace, or inaccurate footwork, but very graceful,
3. Accurate footwork, and graceful,
4. Accurate footwork, very graceful, highly enjoyable.

The goal is yours to seek, find good help to achieve your Goal. The end result will be proportionate to the effort you expend in the task.

Remember that all of those people out there dancing the Rounds were once on the sideline. The strongest motivation to Round Dance is the intense desire "I want to be out there with those dancers, the stronger the desire, the easier the achievement.

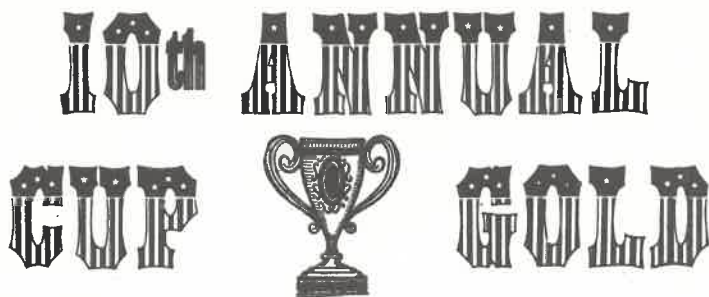

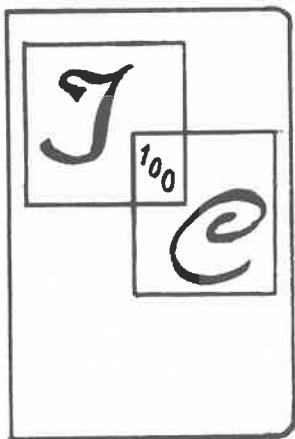

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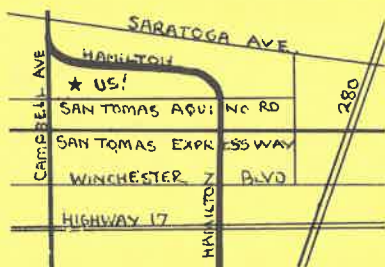
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
