Welcome to the wonderful world of Square Dancing! By now your class is well underway and you are on the road to many happy evenings of dancing and learning. I want to take this opportunity to share some thoughts with you, hoping to help you get more enjoyment from Square Dancing and maybe answer some questions you've been wondering about.

You'll be learning some ground rules along with the Square Dance basics. These rules are based on courtesy and consideration, and are intended to help you have the maximum of enjoyment..

Be there each week -- and be on time! If you are late it may mean three other couples must sit out. Also, the caller uses the first tip to review and to build his evening's program upon.

Because the enjoyment of the folks in each square depends on you and your coordination -- before you square dance don't drink. Be at your absolute dancing and thinking best.

Form squares quickly as soon as you hear the music and the caller announces "sets in order". You'll have a lot of exciting things to learn each evening and you'll want to get as many tips in as possible. By the way, a "tip" consists of a patter call and a singing call. You probably won't be doing too many singing calls at first -- patter records can be stopped for explanations and started anywhere.

Clothing should be comfortable and functional. For the ladies, a full skirt and blouse in lightweight material is fine for class. Pants are not suitable for several reasons -- one is you will be taught skirt work for styling and you need to make it a habit. When you are ready to buy or sew a square dance dress, you will want a bouffant petticoat and sissie pants. Where do you find them? Look in the ads in this magazine!
