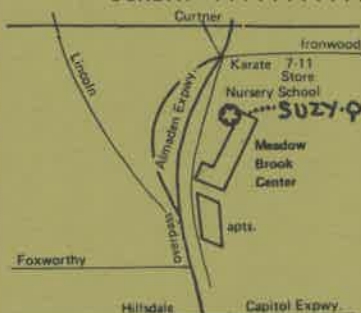

NEWER DANCERS CHIT CHAT

with BARBARA



Hi Everybody! A month has gone by, and if you want to feel great, just take a minute to think of all the things you've learned. Now don't you feel proud of yourselves? Week after week, you work hard each class night, concentrating on each new movement, straining to remember each basic. Then suddenly, everything falls into place, you sail thru everything with ease, relaxed and comfortable. You have reached a 'plateau', as I call it. This will happen every few weeks. You will know it -- and "how sweet it is!"

Here's a couple of helpful hints: For the ladies, when extending your hand to the men, always keep your palms down. Check yourself on a Ladies Chain especially! Also, in a Courtesy Turn (ending a Ladies Chain, etc.) do not put your right hand at your waist to hold the man's right hand as his arm goes around your waist. As you get into styling, you will use your free right hand to hold out your skirt, so don't get into a bad habit now. We always assure the ladies that we will watch where the men put their hands!

For the men, (gals too), be careful not to grasp hands or forearms. For example, in a Right and Left Grand, you can sort of cup your hand and gently pull by. In an arm swing, such as Alemande Left, keep your thumb against the side of your hand. By cupping your hand you can get the same hold for giving each other the gently resistance needed.

Now it's Hoedown Time! If your class started in September or the First part of October, you are ready for your first Hoedown. What a wonderful experience is in store for you! Look for the ads in this magazine that say "Beginner" or "Newer Dancer" Hoedown. They might also list "Callerlab 1 - ?", depending on how far the Caller plans to go. You can check the Callerlab list your Caller gave you. I always want to know what to expect when I go somewhere I haven't been. So I'll let you in on a few things to expect. Nowhere is there a better bargain! The cost will be from \$3.50 to \$4.00 per couple. This usually included two Callers who work very hard calling basics you know, and maybe some you didn't know you knew! They sometimes show you some little fun things to do just that night. You get to dance with people from many other classes and you'll enjoy meeting nice people who share your enjoyment in Square Dancing. Be sure to wear your badge. If you don't have one, something is usually provided. Refreshments are also included, in the form of coffee, punch and cookies or some kind of finger food. Now where can you beat that? See you at that first Beginner Hoedown!!

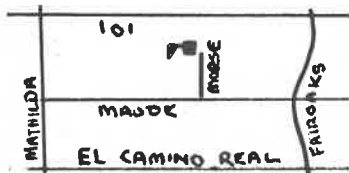

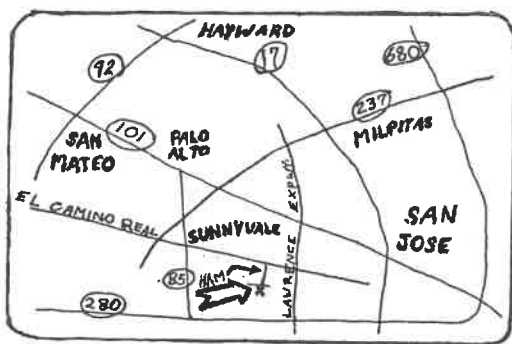

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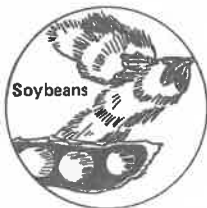
