FROM THE PRESIDENT

This New Year message starts on a serious note, mostly because of increased insurance premiums. These increases were expected to be approximately fifty percent, but turned out to be almost 100% (total insurance this year is \$4433.00), thus with no increase in dues during the past many years, and the continuous increase in the insurance rates, the balancing of the budget will be difficult. Explanation of the dues versus the insurance picture is as follows: The dues have been 1.00 for many years, and for this amount the Association gave each member liability protection insurance. Each member prior to the By-Laws change this past year paid for his own Medical Insurance Package voluntarily by paying \$1.00. This is now in the \$2.00 per member package deal, and the Association pays for all the insurance, with all members of the Association being covered. The present insurance premium payments take \$1.55 out of each member \$2.00 payment, leaving the 45¢ of each member dues to the Association to function. Something must be considered in the near future.

With the added impetus of a square dancing President in the White House, Square Dance as the National Folk Dance program is being reactivated. MAC & MARY McCLURE are Chairmen of the committee, assisted by BOB & LOIS FERBER & KEITH MARCUSON, & we will all be asked to help in this big effort. There will be "Support The American Square Dance" badges sold again, and Northern Association has donated \$100.00 to get things started.

Have you noticed how many Newer Dancers Hoedowns are being held? This is a good time for "Seasoned" dancers to go to one or two or more of these dances to get acquainted with the people who will soon be joining our squares. Remembering how much it meant to have someone smile kindly and be friendly when we were insecure, it seems a really important part of square dancing to help the new comers.

Don't forget the January 29, 1977 Whing Ding at Monte Vista High School in Cupertino. It will be fun, and your attendance will help your Association.

NEWER DANCERS CHIT CHAT

with BARBARA



Hi Everybody! now that the big rush is over, we can get back to the business at hand! Most of us had to miss some dancing over the Holidays and we feel like we forgot everything we ever learned. But, t'ain't so! Your first back-to dancing night brings the happy surprise you haven't forgotten how. You may also be a little surprised to realize how much you missed square dancing, and at the satisfied feeling because you can get back to dancing each week! I share your feelings.

Most all of you have gotten out to Hoedowns by now. Wasn't it nice to meet and dance with so many folks from other classes? Isn't it interesting to dance to different Callers? Each one has a little different style, you learn to listen for just the command. And that's good. If you get a little excited and feel you can't move fast enough, try promenading close to the center of the square, take shorter steps--step on each beat of music, and try to keep your square smaller. (Do this at class also!)

Styling Tip: Ladies, in a Courtesy Turn (Ladies Chain, Right & Left Thru) use your free right hand to hold out your skirt. In a Weave the Ring, use each hand to hold out your skirt. Very Pretty. Gents, when you have a free hand, put it on your hip pocket, palm out. Neat.

There's an old saying that square dancing is friendship set to music. Act as if you're the host in each square. Try to dance with many different dancers each evening. Mistakes happen. When they do, don't stop and talk about it and try to figure out what went wrong where. As our good friend ROD T. says, "Grab one, they all work!" Keep moving -- even if you change partners. After you promenade home, you will have time to get your partner back. If you get too mixed up to keep going, get home quickly and be ready to go at the first appropriate call. Again, don't talk -- just listen -- and SMILE! In class, if there's some movement you don't quite understand, ask your caller. Chances are good there are others who wonder about the same thing but are too shy to ask.

Most classes are held in schools and we have to be extra careful about smoking. If smoking is permitted in the hall, be extra careful to use the ashtrays. If smoking is not permitted inside, don't. When you smoke outside, use the cans provided to throw your cigarette butts in. Don't throw them down on walkways or grass or even bushes. And never, never drop one on the floor and step on it. Groups have been known to lose the use of their hall due to carelessness with cigarettes.

And that's my soap box message for this month! See you next Month.

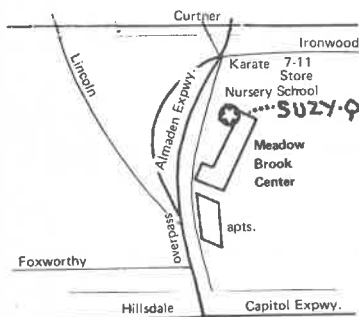

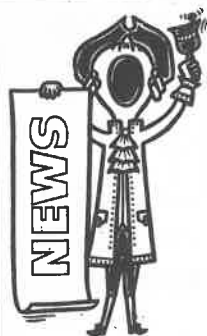

EXTEND (THE TAG)

CALLERLAB QUARTERLY SELECTION FOR JANUARY, FEBRUARY & MARCH

The present use of EXTEND THE TAG is best described as the ability to move from one ocean wave formation to another wave formation. All dancers in the ocean wave will step thru and form an ocean wave with the couples they are facing. If your extension leaves you facing out, then remain facing out. The action is most common from a wave between two couples as in the formation set up by having the HEADS PASS THE OCEAN. It may also be used after a fractional TAG THE LINE figure to extend into a different formation.

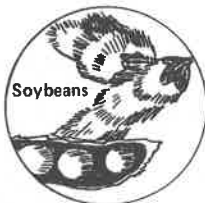

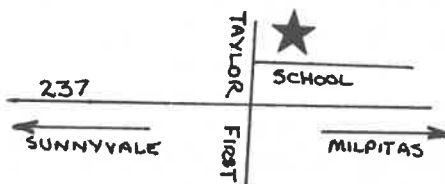
