Hi Everybody! We've had the good fortune to meet many of you at our New Dancers Hoedowns, and all we can say is, "You've come a long way, Baby!" Your Callers are doing a terrific job, and you too! We've never seen better dancers.

Another thing we notice is that many Club dancers are going with Class members to Hoedowns. And that's great! They are very helpful -- as well as fun.

You will notice Club dancers doing some little fancy extras that are unfamiliar to you. Many times you pick up styling points just by watching others. Most of these are great-- and do try them. However, if it's something that changes a movement in any way, you would do well to ask your Caller what he thinks about it.

By now you really know you have to listen and pick out the commands you are to do. Especially when you are dancing to a Caller other than your own teacher. Let me share with you a secret: WHEN MOUTH OPENS - EARS CLOSE! When we hear a call that sounds unfamiliar, we have a tendency to open our mouth and draw in a quick gasp of air, or say "What did he say?", or groan, etc. As soon as we do any one of those things, our ears close. Callers usually give some help words after the command words. So keep those ears open!!

It seems like you have been Square Dancing a long time, doesn't it? You really have learned so much. However, there still is a lot more to learn. Isn't that great! Think of all you have to look forward to. It really does get more interesting all the time.

If you don't already subscribe to Square Dance News, do yourself a favor and do it! Would you like to do all Square Dancers a favor? When you go into one of the Square Dance Shops, tell them you saw their ad in Square Dance News. The more they're impressed by the number of Square Dancers, the more willing they are to carry a wider variety of square dance apparel. So let's help each other, and ourselves!
