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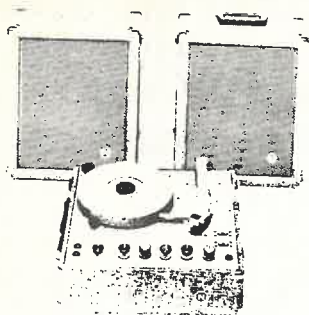

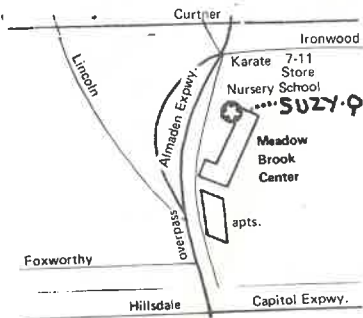

Hi Everybody! As I watch you dance, it gets harder and harder to distinguish the new dancers from club members! At this point in your square dance life, I can only offer you a little guidance. So here are some do's and don't's I hope will help you.

Do get out to Hoedowns. There aren't too many for your level so get out to the ones offered. Dancing to different callers is great practice. You'll find that each caller has something a little different to offer. It's the best experience you can get.

One of the nicest things about square dancing is courtesy. I'm sure you've been told most of our "Unwritten rules" by now. But some bear repeating. Never leave a square that's being formed, even when you see friends forming a square across the floor. Don't talk and prevent others from hearing the call. Be gentle with any hand or arm movements. Don't grasp or yank. At the end of the dance, remember to thank the Caller(s) for the evening of dancing. Remember it's a team effort, so do your part.

Until we square-up together again---keep smiling!

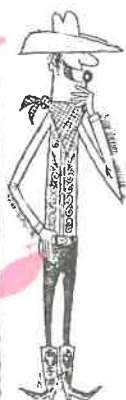

FROM THE PRESIDENT

As President of Santa Clara Valley Square Dancers Association, Ione and I have stepped on many peoples toes, to put it bluntly, and feel that we will have to do a lot more of this before we complete our term of office.

To begin with, we have many codes of ethics for Square Dancers, some regarding personal cleanliness, others regarding roughness, in a square, and even some regarding politeness and manners of conduct, but not one that we could find that pointed a finger at the touchy problem of smoking. We, as President of the Association have on numerous occasions been asked to do something about this problem.

Citing two examples that have been obvious to all of us are: The last Whing Ding which was held at Monta Vista High School in Cupertino, on January 29, 1977, and where the floor is beautifully wood grained, and lovely to dance on, several officers of the Association observed people stubbing out cigarettes on the floor, while ignoring buckets that were placed throughout the ante room for that purpose. Others even knocking out their pipe ashes on this same floor. Result of this, No more smoking in the building, or we can lose the use of the school. Another example is smoking at meetings. Small rooms, or even large rooms do not allow the non-smokers much opportunity to escape the cloud of smoke produced by smokers sitting next to them or even in the same room. So what is the answer? Will we be considerate of our fellow dancers and leave the room for a smoke? Some people are not able to tolerate smoke and it makes them sick or at least uncomfortable.

This is a problem that can be easily solved, but it will take all of us to solve it. Be considerate, think of your fellow dancers, and don't think too harshly of us for bringing this up. (I am a former smoker and Ione is a non-smoker, so we can appreciate both sides, some one had to bring this up, and we are on the hot seat.)
