FROM THE PRESIDENT

During the week end of April 15,16 and 17, 1977, at the State Convention in Sacramento, we participated in a discussion concerning Association and Club problems. We were not surprised to find that there are similar problems every where we have Square Dancing. The problem of getting and keeping places in which to dance seems to be a common one. This difficulty seems to be one that is solved day by day, since each area is so different. One solution was to be especially helpful and considerate to the Custodian, if you can get him into your club, you have it made, they say. Others work through the Parks and Recreation Departments, or rent halls at no small cost, while others have patiently worked with the school system.

Working patiently means exactly that. When we become aggressive and demanding, this is the time we will lose out. Of course a club must earn the reputation of being considerate of school property, leaving it in the same or better condition than it was, there is no other way we will be welcomed then to be an example of what we consider other people should be. If our efforts to make the Square Dance our National Folk Dance are successful, it is felt that this will open many doors that are now shut to us. So, there's a good close to home reason to work for this goal.

The difficulty of keeping dancers after graduation was also discussed, and it was agreed that rather than trying to coerce people to stay in a club, we should keep bringing in new dancers, since the older dancers often come back to dancing sometime later.

Some clubs have the problem of turning into a social coffee time, leaving the Caller frustrated as he tries to teach the new figures, only to have a few couples ready to dance, while others sit. This can only lead to a tragic division among members, those who want to learn, but need dancers to practice with, and those who couldn't care less to learn new figures. This is especially devastating when they all go to a Hoedown, and guess who gets blamed when the square is stopped? The Caller, of course, who is accused of "never teaching us anything". So we must consider our fellow dancer in this respect, just as we consider him by being clean, friendly, on time, and cooperative.

There are no easy solutions to these problems, but it helps to discuss them and know that they are universal.
