This column is a new direction for Square Dance News and this writer. We will attempt to explain what Challenge dancing is and what will be involved for you, as a dancer, if you wish to try it and be successful in it's environment. First, let's see if we can get a handle on the various levels as recently defined by Callerlab. Most of us now dance at the Mainstream Basic Level and are dancing the

Mainstream Experimentasl (Quarterly Basics). Square Dance News has published lists of these in the past. Just above this level are Mainstream plus 1 & 2 (See S/D News, Aug. 77 Pg. 25). Most basics on the Plus list have been around for sometime, with continued usage, and are for the club dancer who wants a little more without going into Challenge Level.

Above Plus 1 & 2 is where Challenge Level begins. These levels have been recently defined as: Basic Advanced Level (About 50 basics); Basic Challenge Level (About 100); and extended Challenge Level (About 100). The basics on these lists are not new. They have been around for many years. Most dancers who go back a few years will remember many of them by name, although they may not now dance them. You might say, these are the workshop basics of yesteryear that many Callers still use in the Advanced or Challenge Levels. In addition to the above lists, the Challenge dancer is expected to keep up on the latest new basics, formations, etc. Quite a responsibility isn't it? More on that later!

Let's look for a moment at what Advanced and Challenge isn't. It's not the old high speed Hot Hash that we used to try to rat race thru at festivals. You remember that! How fast you could dance the regular basics was the criteria, not how well. Challenge is not just learning a bunch of the latest stuff written either. For if that's all you learned, you would not be able to dance in the Advanced or Challenge rooms at today's conventions. We can assure you, today's Challenge level is settling down to a well defined group of basics that are becoming more uniform across the country. Many of the conventions recently past, and many more in the future are listing the levels for these rooms and some even go so far as to list the basics that you are expected to know to dance in a particular room. This will be a great benefit to Callers and Dancers alike. At least, you will know what you are getting yourself into before you go in, and can decide whether you know the material in advance.

Next month, we will cover some of the aspects of All Position Dancing (APD) and it's relation to challenge. We will discuss who is a prime candidate for Challenge Level, the "high frequency" dancer. We will also cover why many dancers who want to try Challenge Level fail to make it happen for them. In future issues, we will talk about clubs, tape groups etc. that are active in Advanced and Challenge in our area. 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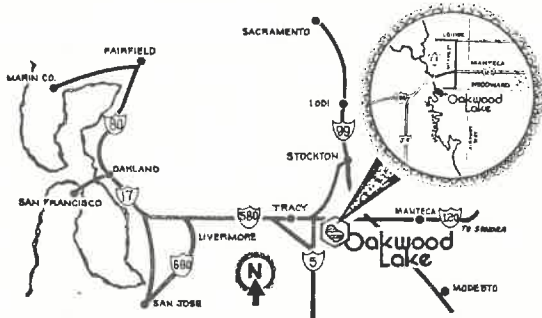

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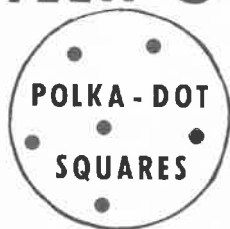
Hi, Square Dancers:
