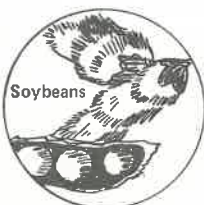

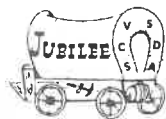

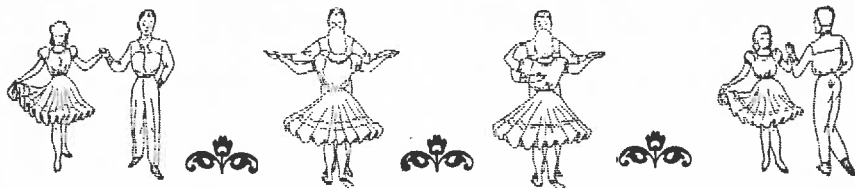

# ROUNDS

## ABOUT THOSE ROUND DANCERS

What is it that makes it desirable to learn those Round Dances? Every Saturday Hoedown those early birds arrive for the Pre-Rounds. They must enjoy the activity, they stay until the end of the dance, so let's analyze the situation.

In most cases Round Dancers have Square Danced before learning to R/D and it seems to have a tendency to keep the people in the dancing activities. The most probable reason is RYTHMN!! After all dancing only requires 4 parts to remember, "Place the Foot", Change the Weight", In time to the Music (rythmn), "GRACEFULLY"!!!

Today's good music offers many wonderful opportunities to "Couple dance", that's what R/D is, a couple (male & female) dancing to a fixed choreography, to designated music, in a fixed pattern.

Hopefully, in R/D, all of the couples on the floor are executing the same "Basic" footwork, in the same direction, at the same time. That's why they very seldom bump each other.

How is it possible for these dancers to do the same basic at the same time (in unison) on a large floor?? Simple, good basic fundamentals and following the music (rythmn).

Round Dancing has about 15 basic movements that can be executed forward or backward (directionally), that's about 30 basics total. Learn these and you are in good shape to do most of the TWO STEP and WALTZ routines used on a Saturday Dance program. That's about one half of the 1-68 required for a Saturday Hoedown.

Take the same 30 basics and change the Rythmn a little and you can have TANGO, CHA CHA, and FOXTROT. Hard to believe but it's true, same footwork new rythmn yields many more dance routines.

Practice the 30 x 2 basics (60 total now) for a year or so and you can become a real smooth dancer, both Round & Square Dancing, also pretty slick at Social Events.

Once a R/D becomes "Rythmn Disciplined" they will naturally dance to the rythmn when S/D, no more rushing and finishing the call early. Now the dancer will take the time to dance to the Music and be ready for the "next call" right on time. It's the FUN way to Dance.

Remember only 4 things to dancing. Place the Foot, Change the Weight, In time with the Music, GRACEFULLY..

By the time you read this col- we will have done some Advanced Level Calling at Square Affair. Congratulations to them for having this level on their program. Last month, we said we would cover APD, so here goes. APD is simply being able to do all of the basics that can be done from different dancer alignments from those alignments. There are six dancer alignments from which many basics can be done. Most of us have done Chase Right from the SPD align-

ment with the guy on the left and the girl on the right. How many of us have done this basic with two guys and two girls together? All Position Dancing requires you to be able to do all of the basics possible from all six of these possible alignments. The "level" will seem considerable higher if all six of these alignments are used at a "Mainstream" Hoedown. Try it, you may like it.

If you are interested in progressing to Challenge level, and note we said progressing, you will have to make certain commitments to achieve this goal. Most of us start with a beginners class, move into a club, and continue dancing with this club, while attending some Hoedowns on Saturday nites. Some dancers, because of available time, interest, and enthusiasm, begin, on a frequent basis, to go to other clubs, workshops, and festivals. They become "high frequency" dancers, dancing 6-9 hours per week or up to 300-500 hours per year. These dancers usually have the best chance to reach Advanced or Challenge level, since they are already putting in the hours required. They only need to be directed to those places where they can learn the basics that keep them progressing toward their own goals. They're weirdos, right? That's a matter of opinion! Some people play bridge, tennis, golf, or watch TV 300-500 hours per year. No, they are just dancers who want to do more than dance once a week and have time to devote to our activity.

Articles we have read, say you should dance at club level for 2-3 years before attempting Advanced or Challenge level. This writer disagrees. It is possible to do the equivalent of the "average" dancers year in six months, if you double your frequency of dancing.

We are sure, by now, you have the message in the above. That's right, it's TIME! How much time do you have, and how much do you want to devote towards reaching Advanced or Challenge level dancing? If it's 3 hours a week, forget it!

Think about 6-9 or more hours, not including traveling some considerable distances at times, and you are a prime candidate for this level. Those dancers who desire, or express an interest in Advanced or Challenge levels, and fail to make it usually fail because they will not make and keep the commitment in TIME required to dance that level.

Bill Davis (Call 854-6037) will be starting an Intro. to Advanced Dancing class in the near future in the Mt. View-Sunnyvale area. Bill will also handle the Intro. to Advanced Dancing at the Jubilee this year. We'll see you at those sessions. By the way, last month I couldn't spell Challenge Caller, today I am one.
