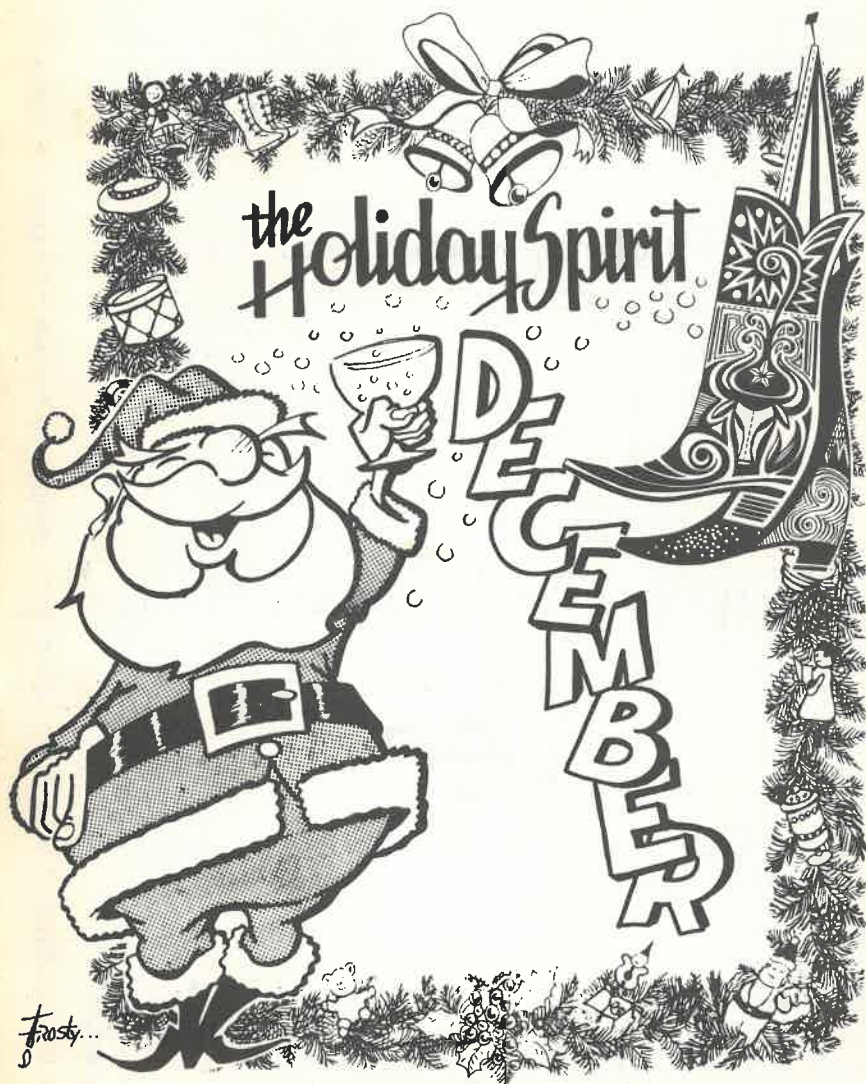

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JOKERS CELEBRATE 25TH ANNIVERSARY...Jokers began with Johnny White's first class in the Spring of 1952. This group and his second class formed the club in October, but we celebrate whenever appropriate.

The club name came from the joker in a card deck that was particularly expressive of our male membership. The first animated club banner, the tongue-wagging, eye-blinking "Joker" made its appearance at the 1954 Golden State Round-up. It attracted great attention at Anaheim, in 1976.

For Hoedowns, in the early days, we went across the Bay or up to San Francisco. Jokers were the real leaders of the space age. We were "Dancing on the Moon" in 1955!

For many years, we had an annual Camp Campbell Family Weekend, with sports, dancing, and a terrific show late Saturday Night, for which we prepared months in advance.

Jokers put on a fun-type exhibition, THE OLYMPIC SQUARE DANCE TEAM, at the State Convention in 1962, hosted by the S.C.V.S.D.A. Our club helped form the association and supplied its first President.

We lost many "caller" members who got too busy with their own clubs; the Oburns, Crawfords, Clarks, Fischers, Hills, Firenzis, Patnudes, Steinhauers, Lowes, and others.

Johnny's "1 JOKER" license plate can be seen on his motorhome at club campouts. The members do other things together--bowling, skating, shows, trips, beach parties, etc.

Many dancers shared in the good times of the Jokers for the last 25 years. The opening lines of our constitution are as true today as when first written, "The members of the Jokers are banded together in the spirit of friendliness and good fellowship to share the pleasures of square dancing."

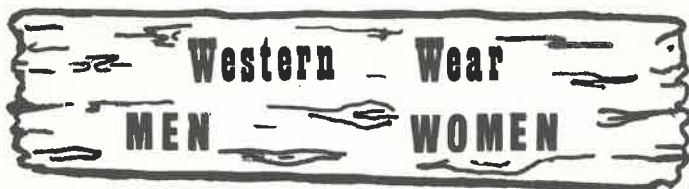

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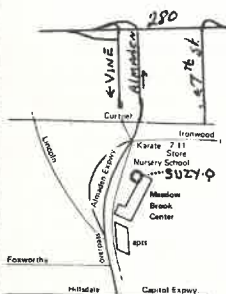
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Last month, we left the column out and on page 11 we printed the new list of Advanced Basics. As you saw, many of these are older figures and you have danced them before. The major thing to note is the last sentence at the bottom of the page with the All Position Concept in mind, we will talk about a few problems for us as dancers related to this concept. First, we should think about how we perceive the basics we already know. When we think about a

Right & Left Thru, we tend to say we pull by with the right and the man courtesy turns the girl. When we Chase Right, we say the girl zooms and the man runs, then circulates or walks forward one position. These are just some of the examples of the way we think about the figures we do now. However, if we change the above to the APC, and put the girl on the left side of the man, the action changes as to who does what to whom so to speak. We would now have to look at RLT as a right pull by and the person on the left courtesy turns the person on the right. Chase Right would be, the person on the right does a zoom and the person on the left runs and circulates one spot. These are just a couple of examples, there are many others. For instance, a Slide Thru is not a Star Thru without hands. It may feel like that from some positions, but certainly not when two men or girls are facing each other. Try it, you'll see.

As we have said before, Mainstream Basics can become very Advanced when the APC is used. Why is this? One of the reasons is the way we think about how to do the basics, and another one is a lack of "Square Awareness". What does this mean? It means, where am I in the square and what does this position do when a given basic is called? Note, we said, what does the position do, not what do I do, for that will vary depending on what your position is when you get the call. So, All Position Dancing really requires that you learn the basics you already know by what the position does that you are in, rather than, what do the boys or girls do when you hear the call.

Let's look for a moment at some "easy" calls that many have trouble with on the dance floor. Cast Off 3/4 seems easy when done after a Centers In, but, when done from Ocean Waves has presented us with some problems. We have been told many things to help from count walls to all kinds of others. Well, walls don't help unless you start parallel to them. Many times you don't. How many of us can't do a Trade in an Ocean Wave? We never miss, right! How about thinking of Trade and a 1/4 more when we Cast Off 3/4? This will work with many basics like Fan the Top, Spin the Top, Spin Chain Thru and others like Touch 3/4. If you line yourself up Shoulder to Shoulder and then Trade and go 1/4 more, you will have moved

in a 3/4 circle. We usually don't have any trouble getting these basics started, it's where they finish that gives us trouble.

If you want to increase your ability and get into Advanced or Challenge, increase your "Square Awareness" on the basics you already know and learn what each "position" does on each basic. See you Dancing.

PRESS RELEASE....ROUNDALAB, The International Association of Round Dance Teachers held their first Annual Meeting in Memphis, Tennessee on October 24, 25, and 26, 1977. The established purpose of ROUNDALAB is to promote, protect, and perpetuate the general Round Dance movement as a complement to the overall Square Dance picture.

Honorary life-time memberships were bestowed on Dorothy Stott Shaw and Frank and Carolyn Hamilton in recognition of their many accomplishments and outstanding leadership in the Round Dance Teaching profession.

A tentative list of those things a new teacher needs to know in order to teach round dancing to people was developed by a committee chaired by Manning and Nita Smith and approved by the membership of ROUNDALAB. The list includes movements in the one-step, two-step, and waltz rhythms. Dance positions, cardinal directions used in round dancing, stepping to the beat of music, selected figures and secondary movements are covered through the first two phases of round dancing. Since this is the area of round dance teaching in which Square Dance Callers who teach rounds generally work, these initial phases will be coordinated with CALLERLAB prior to finalizing.

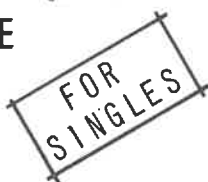

Hi Everybody! Look where you're at! You've only been going to class a few weeks and already you're starting to feel like a Square Dancer. You've hit that first plateau, they come about every six to eight weeks. It seems like you're working real hard each week trying to remember what you learned last week, trying to remember what you're learning this week, and all of a sudden you start the first tip one night and with no effort you sail through everything. What a beautiful feeling. And it happens about every six to eight weeks.

As I mentioned last month, Hoedowns for Beginners will be starting in December. Maybe your teacher will be one of the Callers, or maybe not. Do try to go to as many Hoedowns as you can. From now through March or April there will be one almost every Saturday night. No matter if it's your teacher or not, the Callers (usually two) will be working hard to give you a fun interesting evening.

The first thing that will strike you when you dance to a Caller other than your teacher is that you cannot understand a thing he says! But I'll tell you a secret, every Caller talks plainer as the evening goes on. After you dance a few tips it's amazing how much better that Caller is speaking.

Probably the best advice I can give you is always keep your tongue still. You should smile, but not talk. There's an old Indian saying, "When mouth opens, ears close." As soon as you start to say, "What did he say?" or, "I forgot that!", your ears close and you don't hear the help words that come after the command words. No matter how long you square dance, that advice will hold true.

Square dance attire not only looks good, it feels good also. Ladies need those full skirts and fluffy petticoats to make those Ladies Chains and Courtesy Turns look good, and gents need those smart looking western style duds to help them look handsome and hold the ladies gently! Christmas time is a great time to gift that special person with something for Square Dancing. And one of the nicest gifts you can give is a Subscription to Square Dance News! Maybe they'll let you read it too. It's the only way to keep up with what's happening in our valley in the Square Dance picture, so get in the picture!

Most of us are trying to cooperate with the CALLERLAB decisions even to teaching this movement. I would only wish and hope that we would some day not get a new quarterly movement just because we have too many already.

I'm sure most of you readers remember my article in the August 1977 issue of this magazine in which I was yelling about the changes we were given by CALLERLAB. Well, I did strike a nerve up there....and I was sent a letter from one of our piers....to make sure I understood what it was all about. The Mainstream 1 and 2, I mean. Surely, if we are having trouble teaching any one basic, it is going to be difficult to catch up with the changes that have been given us. I'm talking to more and more callers who are discussing plans to ignore the Mainstream #1 and 2, in order to give their dancers good dancing.....some A.P.D. and good forward motion smooth figures.

Then there are the callers who talk out of both sides of their mouths. At least I "mean what I say" and for that matter I "say what I mean."

We do have too many callers who agree to disagree. Whether it's in CALLERLAB or just in the general ranks of calling. Until some of these callers are willing to take a stand squarely on the subject, whether pro or con, we are going...I shudder when I hear a caller say "I think all the new things coming out have merit" and then argue about the Hyland Dosado and the Skaters Promenade....and of course we all know who promoted those two. Why, yes, the dancers did because they are space saving on a crowded floor and smooth to dance!

These represent the Callerlab list of 68 Basics in family groups & take approximately 41 weeks of 2 hour lessons to learn. Callerlab Mainstream Experimental moves (currently 12) Mainstream I (12) Mainstream plus 2 (12) Advanced Basic Calls (43 plus family groups) Challenge Dancing Basic Calls (45 plus family groups) and Extended Challenge Dancing Basic Calls (???)

Totaling it out, it comes to 192 Basics without the Extended Challenge. If it takes 82 hours to learn 68 basics, using the same ratio, it would take approximately 246 hours to reach the Extended Challenge level, or about 2 1/2 years dancing 2 hours once a week. Seeing as how the average Square Dancer only stays in the movement about 2 1/2 years, who is going into Extended Challenge Dancing??
