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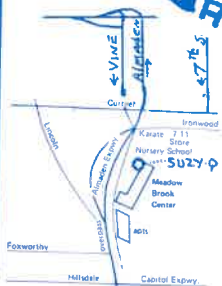

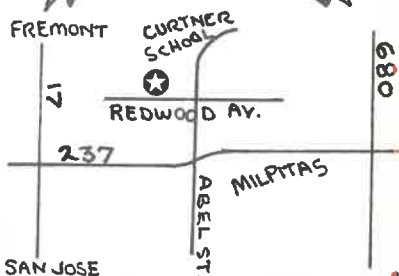
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SQUARE DANCING With FUN!

Hi Everyone,

There have been many good Christmas dances in the area and everyone is looking forward to the new year with good intentions for resolutions. If it wouldn't cause such an uproar, I'd almost resolve to live and let live about all the square dance junk that we are confronted with every day. My idea of high-level dancing is certainly not going to an advertised, high-level dance and find out it is really a caller's workshop. My idea of A.P.D. is challenge dancing, some of which I visualize three imaginary floors, stationed one above the other with people dancing on each level. Some might even be looking over the side to see who's down on the next level. Many callers could put the best of us through a challenging evening and never touch anything beyond the mainstream list. In fact, it could be so challenging some people might start wearing a red face. My husband and I do attend dances when we are not on the other end of the mike and most of the time we enjoy the evening. But sometimes we get to a dance that has been advertised as mainstream and caller lab experimental only to find out that the caller is teaching new things that night. I assure you I would not be writing these articles had I nothing on which to base them. As far as telling my dancers to attend only dances they are capable of keeping up with, "I DON'T!" They can read, and they can also decide for themselves what dances they want to attend. It has become a sorry day for square dancing if we have to instruct our people what dances to attend. After all, these people, you remember, are square dancers in the first place. We open Pandor's Box when we tell new people what a great time and how much fun they will have learning to become a square dancer. Then graduate them, only for them to find out they almost need a degree to have that fun. I am not ashamed of the dancing ability of either of the clubs for which I call. In fact I'm pretty proud of their ability, but it doesn't alter the fact that they will, at times, run into a "fast-clipped, smooth-tounged Charlie" of a caller who will make them feel like a bunch of dummies when he turns the Hoedown into a "Breakdown!"

For the first quarter of 1978, the CALLERLAB Quarterly Selection Committee has voted Two movements to be used for Mainstream dancing. These moves are for the months of January, February and March of 1978.

The two movements selected are: 1. TRADE THE WAVE
2. PING PONG CIRCULATE

TRADE THE WAVE

From any 4 handed ocean wave, dancers facing the same direction in the wave exchange places (TRADE) with one another, walking in a semi-circle and passing Right shoulders at the half-way point. Right-hand waves change to Left-hand waves and vice versa. All dancers change their facing direction.

NOTE: It sometimes helps to have the dancers bend forward slightly and look at the other dancers with whom they will exchange places. Everyone moves simultaneously, so everyone has to know exactly where they will end up.

The value of this movement is that it is a natural follow-up on Follow Your Neighbor which was a recent quarterly selection. It is a convenient way to change from a Left-handed wave to a Right-handed wave.

HEADS SQUARE THRU .. CURLIQUE .. FOLLOW YOUR NEIGHBOR
TRADE THE WAVE .. TRADE THE WAVE (AGAIN) ALLEMANDE LEFT.

SIDES CURLIQUE .. MEN RUN .. SWING THRU .. TRADE THE
WAVE .. LADIES RUN .. WHEEL & DEAL .. ALLEMANDE LEFT

PING PONG CIRCULATE

This movement starts from a $\frac{1}{4}$ Tag Position which is an Ocean Wave in between two couples facing in, and parallel to those couples. The following description is based on a squared up set having Heads Pass the Ocean:

The Center dancers in the Ocean Wave step thru. Everyone does a Pass To The Center and the new center dancers step directly into a Right-Handed Ocean Wave. Caution - remember that the dancers moving towards the outside of the set do an automatic Partner Trade in executing the Pass To The Center motion. Original Heads are now the Outside Couples and the original Sides are now in the Center Ocean Wave.

FOUR LADIES CHAIN .. HEADS PASS THE OCEAN .. PING PONG
CIRCULATE .. CENTER LADIES TRADE .. CENTERS RECYCLE ..
PASS THRU .. ALLEMANDE LEFT

SIDES PASS THE OCEAN .. PING PONG CIRCULATE .. EXTEND ..
SWING THRU .. MEN RUN .. $\frac{1}{2}$ TAG, TRADE, ROLL .. ALLEMANDE LEFT
