This article has a two-fold purpose. One for the dancers and one for the callers. So let's start with the one for the callers. We here in the Monterey Bay Area have an association, perhaps small as compared to others, but we do expect the callers to instruct the dancers of square dance etiquette. Almost everyone who dances here in our area is aware of the no drinking before or during the dance, use of deoderants, no garlic or onion breath, being courteous, etc. We also insist anyone coming to a dance, whether it be new dancer or club level, must wear the proper attire. If a woman comes to the dance in slacks we have to refuse to let her dance according to our rules. This has happened with people from outside our area and we felt badly at having to tell them that they could not participate. I'm wondering how many callers are really getting the word to their new dancers and club level dancers about this sort of thing. Perhaps if you have already told them it would do well to remind them again. We don't insist on the woman being in a square dance dress; an ordinary dress will do fine. But we do insist on men wearing long-sleeved shirts. Please put the word out fellow callers! It's very disappointing to drive some fifty mile to a dance all to find out you will be refused the chance to dance because of the way you are dressed or, for that matter, for abusing any of the other rules.

Now dancers, it's your turn. In discussing the matter of running into a workshop at a supposedly open dance or hoedown, I am still of the same opinion as I have always been; however, it has been brought up in some of my conversations with dancers that too many club level people are arriving at dances that are advertised as mainstream plus one and two all to find out they are not prepared or have not been taught these basics by their caller. The important factor here is the embarrassment and disappointment to the dancers who usually end up going home early. Another important factor is that the dancer who knows these basics and goes with the happy thought that he will enjoy an evening of good dancing. It becomes a chore when he finds he is in a square with people who cannot dance this level. It is not only unfair to him, since he has paid his money and wants his money's worth, but it is certainly not fair to the caller who in all innocence has advertised his dance and must stick to that particular level. So dancers, be sure and read carefully any flyer you see and check with your caller to find out if you have been taught the basics to be used. You'll be happier in the long run and so will everyone else. Have fun dancing no matter what level, but be sure it's your level.



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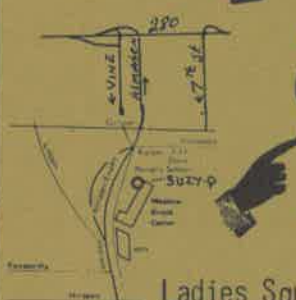

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NEWER DANCERS CHIT CHAT

with BARBARA



Hi everybody! Now that you're into your intermediate class sessions, everyone will have to remember to stop calling you "beginners." How does "newer dancers" sound?

Most of you have gotten out to hoedowns by now. Wasn't it nice to meet and dance with so many folks from other classes? Isn't it interesting to dance to different callers? Each one has a little different style; you learn to listen for just the command and that's good. If you get a little excited and feel you can't move fast enough, try promenading close to the center of the square, take shorter steps, step on each beat of music, and try to keep your square smaller (do this at class also).

Styling tip: Ladies, in a Courtesy Turn (Ladies Chain, Right and Left Thru) use your free right hand to hold out your skirt. In a Weave the Ring, use each hand to hold out your skirt (it's very pretty). Gents, when you have a free hand, put it on your hip pocket with your palm out (it's very neat).

There's an old saying that square dancing is friendship set to music. Act as if you're the host in each square. Try to dance with many different dancers each evening. Mistakes happen. When they do, don't stop and talk about it and try to figure out what went wrong and where. As our good friend ROD T. says, "Grab one, they all work!" Keep moving even if you change partners. After you promenade home, you will have time to get your partner back. If you get too mixed up to keep going, get home quickly and be ready to go at the first appropriate call. Again, don't talk. Just listen and smile! In class, if there's some movement you don't quite understand, then ask your caller. Chances are good there are others who wonder about the same thing, but are too shy to ask.

Most classes are held in schools (hoedowns also) and we have to be extra careful about smoking. If smoking is permitted in the hall, be extra careful to use the ashtrays. If smoking is not permitted inside, then don't smoke. When you smoke outside, use the cans provided to throw your cigarette butts in. Don't throw them down on walkways or grass or even bushes. And never drop one on the floor and step on it! Groups have been known to lose the use of their hall due to carelessness with cigarettes.

And that's my soap box message for the month. See you next month!
