# ☆ ROUNDALAB ☆

ROUNDALAB has completed a most successful charter membership drive with just under five-hundred member units in the organization. A member unit is a couple, team, or solo teacher. All members are active round dance teachers and represent forty-eight states, six Canadian provinces, Belgium, Germany, New Zealand, and the Netherlands. Much of the success of the membership drive is attributable to the excellent publicity given this new organization by the square and round dance newsletters and magazines and the active support of the Sets in Order American Square Dance Society, LEGACY, CALLERLAB, and the many local and area square and round dance organizations.

ROUNDALAB was a dream of a handful of round dance teachers at LEGACY in May of 1977 which became a reality at the organizational meeting in October of that year. A meeting attended by a representative cross section of the round dance teaching profession, including a large percentage of the "big" names in the business.

As we lay plans for our second annual meeting, to be held in Kansas City, Missouri on October 22nd, 23rd, and 24th, we are confident that we can start resolving the problems facing the round dance teaching profession. With over half of the round dance teachers of the world as members, we are in the unique position of being able to tackle those problems which can not be solved by any dancer-teacher organization or local teacher group.

This article contains some excerpts from articles in past issues as well as an in-depth commentary which reveals not only my own opinion, but that of many dancers.

I believe if you have something to say, say it! So here it is. I rebel and I know there are many other callers who feel the same way as I do about new movements and constantly having to change what is taught to dancers each year when Callerlab decides to mess up the works for the square dance activity. You and I, as club callers, have become the whipping boy or girl for the "big daddies." This year's list is not only bigger, but also different. So what if we drop a few movements here and there; the dancers can always adjust. This attitude seems to be the consensus of those who are in the lead position in our activity. I wonder just how many callers realize the real difference between a caller and a dancer. For one thing, a dancer does not eat and sleep square dancing. Dancers enjoy an evening of dancing and go home, perhaps to talk about the evening with friends, but certainly not to analyze the material used. Dancers know what they like in dancing and that just about says it all. However, the insultrious caller thinks about square dancing most of the time. The caller works out material, researches material, practices calling, and reads square dance magazines and caller association notes. He sometimes gets together with other callers and raps on the subject of calling. A steady diet of square dancing puts him a cut above the dancer. Does this tell any of you something? It should. It should tell you to be careful how you handle the masses of dancers we are responsible for in this activity! It should tell you that many dancers cannot cope with an ever changing format for their so-called pleasure. I still say we are endangering the species and asking for a large exodus of dancers who are not only discouraged, but confused by too much junk in our activity.

When this influx of new calls started, it was still the 10% who wanted to learn everything coming out. Now it is growing heavy on their minds and they are becoming weary of the constant learning effort. At festivals, dancers have complained about the caller workshoping at the Saturday Night Dance. Dancers have also complained about having too many calls thrown at them during the workshop program. Perhaps when the dancer says, "I can't hear you" to a caller, the dancer is really saying, "Call so I can dance!"

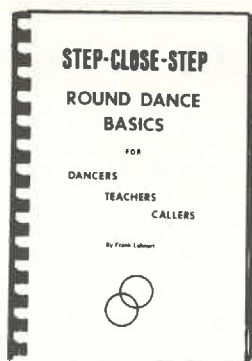

The theme of the Convention was "Working Toward Tomorrow". CALLERLAB is now actively encouraging groups and clubs to establish Dance Plateaus aimed at the Basic and Extended Basic Programs (see page 50). CALLERLAB also established a recommended Timing Chart for use by all callers for a period of one year. A copy of this list has been sent to all known Caller Associations.

Jack Lasry, Hollywood, Florida, was reelected to Chairman of the Board and his Executive Committee for 1978-1979 will include Al Brundage, Stamford CT, Lee Helsel, Sacramento, CA, Jon Jones, Arlington, TX, and Bob Van Antwerp, Buena Park, CA. John Kaltenthaler, Pocono Pines, PA will continue as Executive Secretary.

Small World Awards were presented to Mike Burnham, Essex, England and to Art Shepherd of Christchurch, New Zealand. 22 members received the quarter century awards.

The CALLERLAB Milestone award, the highest award giving, was presented to Manning Smith of College Station, Texas for all he has contributed to the square dance activity over a long period of time. A Milestone Award was also presented to Bob Osgood, Beverly Hills, Calif. for all of his contributions to square dancing and callers over a period of years.

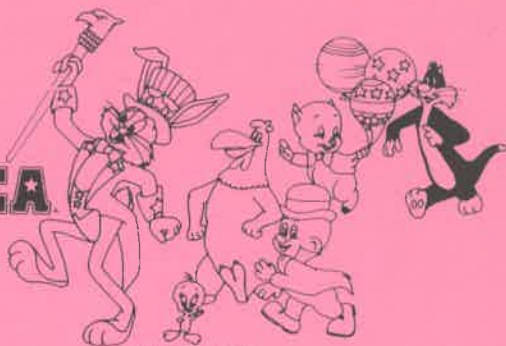
