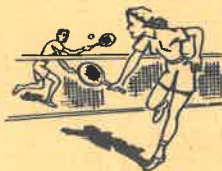

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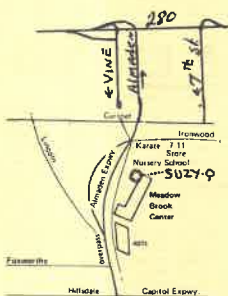
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FROM THE DESK OF Ken

I can remember about seventeen years ago when I wasn't even thinking about being a caller. The dances that we went to were sheer joy! At that time callers were calling a challenging dance with some sixty-five basics or less which would turn the crowds upside down with real challenging calling. Where have the callers gone who could call like that? I have observed the same ones calling so much new stuff that they have forgotten what really is appealing to the dancers. Moreover, an established caller can woo the crowd as long as he is an accomplished caller. The caller doesn't have to necessarily change his style (as some have). I'm not trying to live in the past. It's just that I know what is appealing to the dancers (the ninety percent, that is, who are still trying to enjoy the activity).

Recently I attended a festival and found myself as the female part of the picture where I was constantly Side Stepping. I was Side Stepping in a walk and dodge and I couldn't believe how many times the caller called Boy's Run and off we'd go Side Stepping again. In some choreography, recycling can almost be enjoyable ("almost"), especially if you call being a tangle foot in the process. It is awkward for the girl to be pulled around like a lost sheep and the girl still seems to be getting the brunt of any adjust-type movement. I can remember before Slide Thru came out, it was discussed, by callers, that after doing a four-handed Square Thru followed by a Star Thru, the gals could adjust better than the men. Using the left hand twice is really not good choreography, but it was the gals who had to put up with it. I would like to know why the male population of callers think it should be the women who must sacrifice the comfort and flow of the dance. Maybe it's because the women are smarter, more adaptable, and better built to take the unusual. Heaven knows if one of the species isn't, this world would be chaotic! I hope some of you callers are feeling the point.

In a recent article for Square Dance News, I said that it was my understanding that we would have a standardization of basics from callerlab that all of us could live with. Now it seems there is going to be no end to the list to which they keep adding. Now we have Mainstream 1 & 2. By next year it could very well be 3 & 4. I need now to stand up in quiet place and shout so everyone can hear, "I rebel!" We callers have a bull by the tail and don't know

how to let go. Perhaps the thing to do is to dish out so much and so often that we finally drive the ninety percent away, and then we could have our own way with the dancers who have shown a great amount of gullability in accepting whatever we decide to give them. I would certainly rather please the ninety percent of our square dance world than take a chance on literally putting my foot in my mouth and try to call something I don't particularly like or think is smooth for the dancers. How can I do a good job calling something that does not have a smooth flowing feel to it?

What about the number of new calls coming out today? In the August 1977 issue of Santa Clara Square Dance Callers Association Notes, there were sixty-two new calls printed. I might add there are from twenty to fifty each month. Many of the calls are only combinations of several basics. What has happened to the stand everyone endorsed, published by the S.I.O. of the American Square Dance Society, that said something about a call had to be versatile enough to be done from any position and should not be a combination of calls? That is really what a basic is.

I am violently opposed to printing all the new calls that come out. If Callerlab really wants to do something, have them screen and restrict the number of new movements being published. The callers are beginning to listen to Callerlab, so Callerlab should be careful what is decided. Callerlab should consider the masses and not be a dictator for square dancing.

With so many things coming out with multiple basics making up the call, the dancer finds himself having to memorize more and more. Is this why so many of our people cannot dance a simple challenge evening made up of seventy-five basics with directional calling?

And what about A.P.D.? Why is there so much of it? There are a number of reasons, both good and bad, for it. I believe some callers are getting sick of calling so much garbage. Then there are some callers who want to feel important and want to show how much they know, not just to benefit the dancer, but to swell their own pride. Now I have nothing at all against A.P.D. I've been using it ever since I started to call and write my own material sixteen years ago. A.P.D. gives a personal challenge and also a personal reward when things go right, but to douse the dancers continually with unusual material will only create a boredom for them when they get too use to it. A variety in our programming is necessary for a successful and enjoyable evening of dancing, but careful planning will enable the dancer to come back for more. If we allow ourselves to be careless and expect too much, A.P.D. with Spin Chain the Gears, Relay the Ducey, or even my old friend Tangle Foot Recycle, will become a complaint grounds for our beloved dancers.

Please, guys, handle with care! We want to have square dancing in existence when year 2000 gets here. But wait and see, some nut will think up one just for the occasion.....◆
