Recruiting New Dancers

by Bob Johnson .. Footnotes, Washington State

Are we expending too much effort recruiting class members and not enough effort trying to recruit future square dancers? We hear of how many couples and singles are in a class. We hear of so many that graduate. Perhaps this is where we need to take inventory. Are we graduating class members or are we graduating square dancers?

Let's review our recruiting techniques. What do we sell when presenting our hobby to a prospect? Are we honest enough to determine if he or she will be content to dress like a square dancer, if he or she desires a hobby that really needs to be enjoyed frequently to be comfortably enjoyed at all? Do we proudly display the ethics and standards we like to maintain in the square dance movement?

The past few years we have observed too many classes in which the main objective was to teach the movement, but the theme of the class seemed to be "don't educate them in the importance we place on manners, dress, and what the movement is really likd, Or you might discourage them". If knowing what it is all about and what is in store for them discourages them, we are prostituting our grand hobby to exercise the teacher and the class. If the new student dancers do not want to share our kind of fun and do not desire to share our customs and our traditions, they do not want square dancing, and no amount of chasing them, begging them will ever make them square dancers.

This year let's tell it like it is. Let's be honest with ourselves and the new class members - let's be honest about our hobby. The people who keep square dancing the great hobby it is are those who participate, not those who drop in and out a few times a year.

How many went through our classes doesn't put any feathers in our caps. We can self-evaluate our effectiveness by reviewing such facts as: How many former class members are dancing? How many joined the movement actively and really desired to become involved? How many of us can remember explaining the complete picture often enough to tell the whole truth? In other words, how many who did not go on after graduation should not have been expected to become involved?

NOT HOW MANY? BUT HOW GOOD?

The trouble with some people is that they won't admit their faults. I'd admit mine if I had any.

The International Association of Square Dance Callers

In the interest of brevity and in response to request from the square dancing public, the following abbreviations are recommended by CALLERLAB as a means of further identifying the appropriate dance level. Please note that all abbreviations are cumulative, that is each two letter abbreviation includes the calls of the level preceding it. Many clubs will not need levels other than MS or QS. CALLERLAB does not mean to imply any pressure to encourage dancers to try a level beyond where they are comfortable. Clearly, the Plus Programs, Advanced Dancing and Challenge Dancing are not designed for all dancers. The main purpose of the abbreviations is to help those publications and clubs who wish to label their dances and find space at a premium. The abbreviations will enable a dancer to know what calls he (or she) can expect to hear and will suggest whether a dancer should attend a particular dance or not. Not all clubs choose to label their dances - that is fine. However, when a dance is labeled, please use these abbreviations in the interest of standardization.

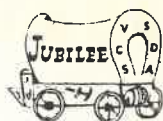

FIXED SQUARES

written by Caller, Ted Nation

The fixed square is an abomination to the whole idea of square dancing. Fixed squares are by their very nature, a perfect example of rudeness. Thus the practice of fixed or pat squares is qualified to be included in a discussion of rudeness. Everyone enjoys dancing with close friends. I enjoy this, but not to the exclusion of others. I try to think of everyone as close friends. A great deal of the fun of square dancing is the people you meet; let's keep these meetings enjoyable. It's embarrassing to try to fill a square and be told that you can't dance there. Dancers with experience have learned to accept this. However, the newer dancer is made to feel inadequate. He is embarrassed and hurt to think that he is not good enough to dance with the "experts." He doesn't realize that he is probably as good a dancer as anyone else in the square. the only possible good to be derived from this experience of rudeness is that it thickens the skin of the excluded majority. But, is this a good thing? Why should it be necessary for square dancers to wear a suit of armour? Why can't we all be friends and enjoy our activity together? If you feel the need to surround yourself with good dancers, then PLEASE, collect on the sidelines and go out together. If one couple is missing at dance time be polite; let someone else take their place. These suggestions will not abridge your right to dance in pat squares. They may, however, prevent the ruination of someone else's evening.

Rude square dancers always take me by surprise. Rudeness and square dancing don't mix well. A discourteous square dancer seems incongruous when compared with the rest. We continually tout the friendliness of square dancers. We tell non-dancers that if they join a square dance class they will enjoy good fellowship wherever they may travel. This, I'm afraid, is only partially true. I realize that the discourteous dancers make up only a small portion of the total number of participants. However, this small percentage is the most vocal. It seems to be some sort of natural phenomenon that the few individuals in possession of poor traits always make the biggest impression. This is unfortunate, but true. Bad encounters are generally remembered to the exclusion of the good.

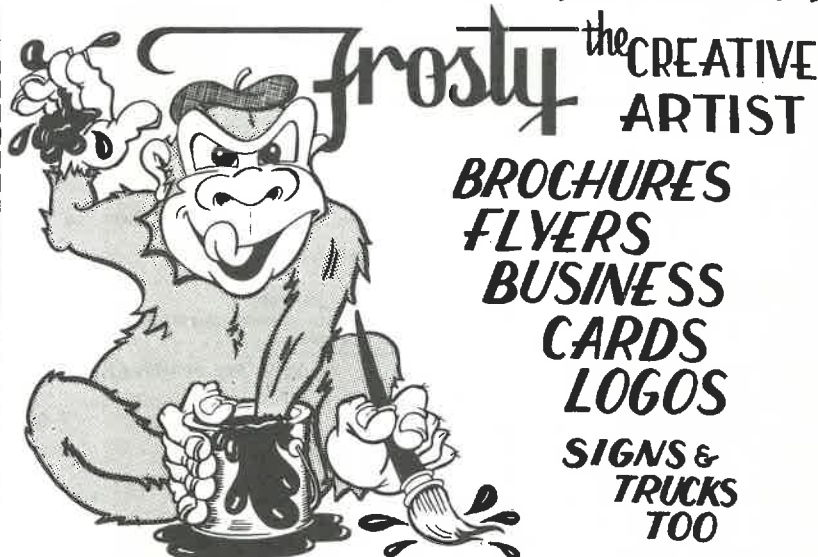

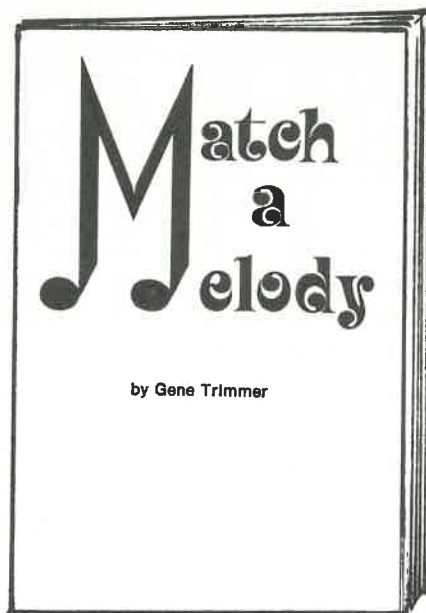

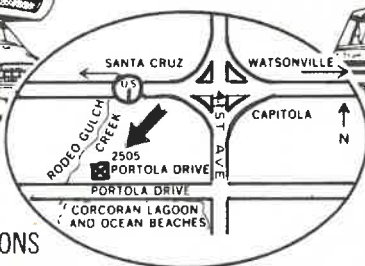
