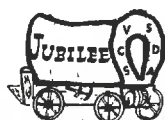

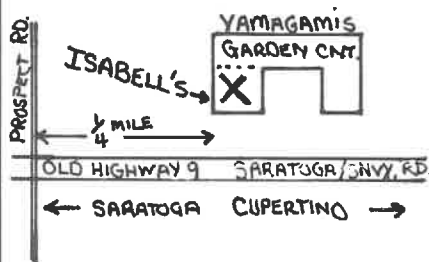

The Quarterly Selection Committee announces the selection of One figure for the fourth quarter beginning October 1, 1978.

GRAND WEAVE .. FROM A STATIC SQUARE, 4 LADIES WALK TO THE RIGHT (SPLITTING THE CORNER) CROSSING IN FRONT OF THEIR CORNER AND FOLD DIRECTLY BEHIND HIM TO BECOME 4 SINGLE FILE COLUMNS AT RIGHT ANGLES. ALL EIGHT WILL DO A WEAVE THROUGH THE CENTER AS A TAG THE LINE MOVEMENT .. EACH MAN ALLOWS THE MAN ON HIS LEFT TO PASS IN FRONT BUT CUTS RIGHT BEHIND HIM AND IN FRONT OF THE LADY FOLLOWING HIM. THE LADIES PASS IN SIMILAR FASHION, ALLOW THE LEFT HAND LADY TO CROSS IN FRONT. MEN MAKE A RIGHT FACE U-TURN BACK AND STARTRHU (ORIGINAL WAS WRITTEN AS SLIDE THRU) WITH THE LADY THAT FOLLOWED HIM COMING INTO PROMENADE POSITION AND ALL PROMENADE EXACTLY $\frac{1}{2}$ (ONE POSITION) AND WHEEL IN AS A COUPLE TO REFORM THE SQUARE. FOUR MEN HAVE PROGRESSED $\frac{1}{2}$ TO THEIR LEFT. THIS IS $\frac{1}{2}$ OF THE FIGURE AND HAS TAKEN 16 BEATS. REPEAT THE ACTION 3 MORE TIMES FOR A 64 BEAT MANEUVER. THE LADIES FOLLOW IN THEIR OWN FOOTSTEPS 4 TIMES. CAN BE USED AS " $\frac{1}{2}$ GRAND WEAVE" OR $\frac{1}{2}$ GRAND WEAVE. CAN ALSO BE DONE AS A LEFT GRAND WEAVE WITH MEN WALKING TO THEIR LEFT AND FOLDING BEHIND THE LADIES, ETC.

The International Association of Square Dance Callers

Recently, a number of inquiries and sample programs have been sent to this office which dealt with the subject of dance level identification. As you know, CALLERLAB has been publishing a recommended stratification system for several years which we feel properly defines the various dance levels being danced throughout the country and the world. There is some misunderstanding on the part of some as to our purpose and some misuse on the part of users of the terminology that we established. Therefore, we are sending this letter in hopes of helping a wider understanding of dance levels, their use and limitations, and guidelines for dancers, callers and program chairmen for all dances.

CALLERLAB has identified the following Dance Levels (Programs)

- B Basic Level - CALLERLAB list 1-39
- EB Extended Basic Level - CALLERLAB list 1-54
- MS Mainstream Level - CALLERLAB list 1-69
- QS Quarterly Selections - MS plus the current Quarterly Selections.
- +1 Plus One Level - QS plus the 12 calls listed in the +1 Program.
- +2 Plus Two Level - +1 and the 12 calls listed on the +2 Program.
- A1 Advanced Level One - +2 and the calls listed on the A1 List.
- A2 Advanced Level Two - A1 list and the calls listed on the A2 List.
- C1 Basic Challenge Level - A2 and the calls listed on the C1 List.
- C2 Extended Challenge Level - C1 and the calls listed on the C2 List.

As can be seen from this listing, all levels include all calls from previous lists. It is not the intent of CALLERLAB to try to force anyone to call or dance at any particular level. Clearly, programs or levels beyond QS are not for all dancers. As a matter of fact, CALLERLAB encourages clubs and callers to provide dances aimed at the Basic (B) and extended Basic (EB) levels for those dancers who dance less often than once a week.

CALLERLAB encourages clubs, callers and festivals to label their dances for the calls that are to be used in a dance Program. For instance, if a hall is to be labeled QS, then the caller should use any call found in the Mainstream Program (MS) and the current Quarterly Selection. He (or she) should not use calls from the +1 or +2 lists.

Read the CALLERLAB article on page 44 for a good explanation of the CALLERLAB symbols (MS) (+1) (+2), etc. We are trying to standardize our ads so that dancers will be able to look at an ad and know if they are capable of dancing at that dance.

If, on the other hand, a hall is labeled +1 level, the caller may use all calls in the +1 list, the QS list and the MS list. If the dance is labeled a +1 Workshop (Program), then the caller should be teaching and using calls and figures from the +1 list. If the intent is to workshop +2 calls, then the hall should be labeled a +2 workshop.

If there is a doubt as to how to label a hall, please write to CALLERLAB telling us what you would like to do and what calls are to be used. We will then advise you as to how we suggest you label the hall. By labeling the halls during festivals and dances, we hope to have a better dance program where the dancers will know what to expect and therefore enjoy their dancing more. It will enable a caller to provide a better program for the dancers by knowing what the floor should be able to handle. No one likes to feel they are wasting their money. CALLERLAB feels that by labeling the dances, in accordance with our recommendations, this concern is reduced.
