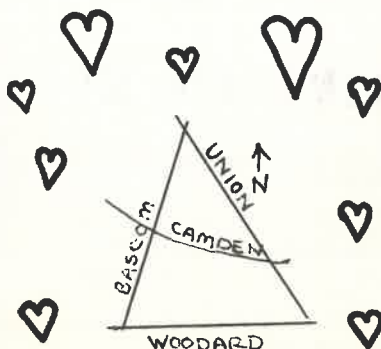

F. I. T. S. For Your Dancing Pleasure

Do you waste your interim time? Interim time being that deplorable period of doing absolutely nothing while poised for the immediate continuation of action. A great deal of this interim time (I.T.) is wasted at traffic signals, queued up in interminable lines and waiting in a "broken down" square for the Caller to say "allemand left"!

My usual interim time savers (I.T.S.) of exercising my face muscles or experimenting with different laughs (how I envy a low, sexy chuckle) work out fine in automobile traffic or in line at the grocery store but, they seem a bit disconcerting to other square dancers awaiting the "allemand left". There is clearly a need for additional I.T.S.

It's humiliating to just S T A N D t h e r e while other squares are whoopin', hollerin' and gyrating thru the calls, but really, a body can cough, scratch, count ceiling lights, or just stare at the Caller for just so long! Specific face-saving interim time savers (F.I.T.S.) must be established in order to stamp out this dreadful waste of time.

F.I.T.S. could be signaled to the square by either head man, since one or the other will probably be counting the ceiling lights, by holding up one, two or three fingers. This will put the square back into action, executing a move that keeps a dancer in position near their corner when the "magic" word "allemand" is called.

F.I.T.S. #1. All dancers join hands and circle left. In the event no "allemand left" is called after five minutes, then reverse and circle right. Continue with this F.I.T.S. until you hear "you know what".

F.I.T.S. #2. Head couples to center and back. (No allemand?) Then, do-sa-do with opposite. (No allemand?) Then, swing the opposite. (Still no allemand?) Then, go home and swing your partner. (Still none?) Then, side couples do it. Repeat if necessary.

F.I.T.S. #3. Head couples lead right..and circle to a line.. and if you haven't heard "it" yet...do-sa-do with the opposite person. If you still haven't heard "it", do a see-saw with the opposite. Chances are you'll hear the "allemand" a while before you do the see-saw because it takes the average dancer $3\frac{1}{2}$ minutes to find a left shoulder from this position.

Don't be lulled into thinking F.I.T.S. are unnecessary. Easy things like swinging your partner or yellow rocking can be very dangerous. Some Callers patter a l o n g time between "allemands" and to swing for that duration could cause nose bleed and yellow rocking could possibly produce an emotional involvement.

F.I.T.S. #1, 2 and 3 are simple maneuvers. Once mastered it can not only give a "broken down" square a new lease on life but offers a world of possibilities. Perhaps we could make them part of our basics list. We'd of course have beginner F.I.T.S., club level F.I.T.S. and for the high level dancer, advanced F.I.T.S. Maybe even a National Association of Callers where they can meet and compare F.I.T.S., (or do we already have one?).

Meanwhile, next time your square breaks down, don't waste a second, just have fun havin' F.I.T.S.!
