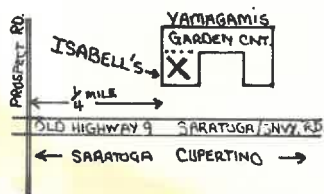

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FROM THE DESK OF Ken

The time is 7:00 am, Wednesday, February 14th and I'm sitting in the SUN at Tower Point Travel Trailer Park in Mesa, Arizona writing this column. The temperature is in the mid-60's and it will go to the mid-80's by noon. I guess I'll go swimming this afternoon, that is after I attend the Square Dance Workshop that starts at 10 am. If you like the S/D way of life Mesa is the place for you. A typical day at the park starts with a S/D Workshop from 10 to noon, then a R/D Workshop from 1 to 3, S/D Workshop 3 to 5 and evening dance 7:30 to 10 pm. This happens 5 to 6 days per week at about seven different Travel Trailer Parks in the Mesa area.

The winter season starts around October 15th and runs to April 15th. A few of the name callers in residence are: Bob Fisk. Bob Wickers, Johnny LeClaire and others. The average dance will have between 25 to 35 squares, would you believe at 10 in the morning? The average dancer can handle Plus 2 A.P.D. without too much trouble, of course they are dancing about 25 hours per week while at home your lucky to dance 5 hours per week. It does make a difference.

There are no Square Dance Clubs in the park and the dances are all caller run. The dancers travel from one park to another to dance to different callers. Most dances are \$2.50 per couple for non-residences of the park and only \$1.50 per couple for residences. The average Trailer Park holds 1,000 plus units and they are all full, close in that is.

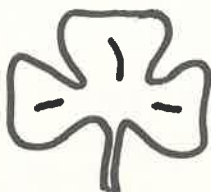

Why (and how) do you Square dance? People square dance for a variety of reasons; Exercise. Social camaraderie. Mental stimulus. A genuine love for dancing. A way to meet new friends. An excuse to get away from the boob tube, etc. It is quite probable that a large number of people do not have one specific reason for Square dancing...it's simply the enjoyable thing to do at that point in their lives and that a combined process of meeting new friends, learning new skills and having a good time is a sufficient multi-purpose end in itself. They may not even be considering what, if any, may be the next step in their progression.

It is a fact of life that peoples' Square dancing abilities are as varied as their reasons for Square dancing. Some are graceful, some clumsy, and the majority are widely spaced in between. Some learn quickly, some require several weeks (or months) to learn the difference between left and right and the majority are strung out between these limits. Some can react instantaneously and correctly to a hundred and fifty different calls...some hesitate noticeable before responding (sometimes incorrectly) to calls such as Right and Left Thru and the majority respond with varying degrees of alacrity & correctness to the majority of calls and callers.

What's my point? Just this: The people who love to dance tend to become irritated with those who don't. People who seldom make mistakes tend to become irritated with those who frequently do. Those who love to socialize at the club meetings tend to become irritated with those who insist on their dancing, especially when an incomplete square needs filling. If a Square dance club (or any organization of human beings) is to function as a healthy social entity, the viewpoints & circumstances of the majority of its members must be taken into account and a strong effort must be made to accomodate as wide a range of viewpoints and attitudes as possible.

Square dancing is a dynamic social movement. Not only does the total membership steadily rise but new calls are being introduced constantly...and their rate of introduction seems to increase as the number and capability of callers and dancers steadily improve. What this means is that when people drop out of square dancing for even a short period of time - or attend too few club meetings and hoedowns - they are apt to find themselves unable to cope with a steadily increasing number of calls and thus find less and less satisfaction in Square dancing.

What to do about it? All of us as club members have specific responsibilities in this regard. Those who dance well need to be more tolerant of those who don't. Those who are unable to attend dances as often as they should must make an effort to attend workshops and hoedowns at other, more convenient times. Hoedowns are especially helpful since all Callers are not alike and when new calls are taught & called in different ways they tend to be learned more quickly. In this regard, callers can also help. It is very helpful if a

Caller will cue or even re-teach new calls one or more times during a hoedown so latecomers and untalented learners (not all of whom are voluntary members of such categories) are in a better position to cope.

The next time you're bugged by some aspect of Square dancing that doesn't exactly fit your preferences, ask yourself this question, "Is my point of view representative of the majority? If so, how can I help correct the situation?" (Maybe you can't, but you should attempt to work at the problem.)

We will defend the right of any club to select the level of dancing to be called at their own Hoedown. However, we also feel very strongly that the dancer who pays to attend a dance has the right to know what level he will be expected to dance.

This created an embarrassing situation for dancers who caused their squares to break down because the calling was above their heads. We are all good club level dancers, but we do not pretend to be advanced dancers and would never willingly put ourselves in this uncomfortable position.

We sincerely hope that all clubs will be more careful about advertising the level of their dances in the future and that if no level is advertised, the calling will be held to floor level.

We still wanted to go faster and achieve more thrills. Along came a "Super Highway" called Advanced and beyond that the very limited access road by the name of "Challenge".

Many of you (dancers and callers) are really caught up with this speed trap. We sometimes think that because the road's there, we must drive on it. Might it not be better if we as individuals learned to handle the various road conditions along the way? Can we not enjoy the scenic routes in our own neighborhoods? Can we not enjoy the beauty of the secondary road and perhaps even the first four lane highway? Must we all travel on the divided highway? Must we all pass everyone on the road?

We talk about the scenic highways and byways and yet in our Square dancing the scenic portions have to be the people and the friendships established. Just as the forests, flowers, and the shrubs are the scenic roadside attractions and water falls add serenity, so do the friendships and people in Sq.-dancing accomplish the same things for us in our pursuit of this leisure time activity. We should take the time to enhance these friendships. We should take the time to smell the roses. We should make the effort to be especially outgoing and friendly to the strangers who attend our club dances. We should enjoy the scenic route for all it has to offer.

Let us all take stock of ourselves and review where we are and where we would like to go. Let us not get caught up in the "Speed Trap" of Square dancing. ♦
