NOT MORE... BETTER! or ... "Not So Much New Stuff Every Week"

Now that we have CALLERLAB definitions and "levels" we might make the mistake of trying too hard to advance to the next "level". This could be a serious mistake, alienating many good dancers who can't put in a lot of time practicing what is tossed at them on Club night. There are dancers of all degrees of experience and skill, to be sure, but don't lose track of the fact that 75% of all dancers will find their greatest enjoyment at MAINSTREAM level. Does that mean that we must all stay at that level - indefinitely? Not at all! We can improve in the direction of "better" dancing, and not just "more".

The MAINSTREAM (or the Intermediate) dancer has a big store of knowledge that can be used without having to learn more figures. All of us have the delightful experience of being surprised at a Hoedown with a familiar call coming at us and we were not in the formation ordinarily used as its starting position...and we did it!...and with very little trouble! All of us have discovered that different callers can put figures together in sequences we never dreamed possible. Those happy occasions are becoming more frequent, as the knowledge & skills of Callers increase. Thanks to "Callers' Notes" and new teaching manuals for Callers - one doesn't have to wait for the famous visiting Caller to experience new uses for our present dancing knowledge. Your own Caller is probably benefiting by such aids and may be wishing he or she had encouragement from the-dancers to broaden out your existing skills instead of having to drum up new figures to satisfy your jaded appetites.

I firmly believe we are on the verge of a great new era in square dancing - an era in which we will all get the benefit of learning new ways to dance better with what we have. We will still have new inventions striving for acceptance, but for every LOAD THE BOAT there are a hundred pieces of compounded junk that fill up Bill Bursleson's Square Dance Encyclopedia. But real goodies like SWAP AROUND will still surface in the minds of geniuses in our field. There will be an increase in the number of figures, but the sifting process initiated by CALLERLAB will stem the flow to a more manageable volume. We should take advantage of this trend to catch our breath and to more thoroughly enjoy that which we now have.

What new things then can we do with our existing squaredance knowledge? Well, first let me suggest some polishing up and some filling in on neglected material. In the forward rush of the past five years, some old standards have been sadly neglected. How many of our readers can do a standard TEACUP CHAIN without hesitation? 25% might be a high percentage. Yet, you should be able to do it from either head or side position, from either of those with the sides going into the-center first, and from all of those four starts, from a half-sashayed positions! And, you haven't even begun to think of GRAND TEACUP CHAIN, which is-a breeze to call

directionally. Can you work from DIAMONDS? DIAMOND CIRCULATE and FLIP THE DIAMOND are both in the PLUS 1 list, which includes other such oldies as PAIR OFF and TRADE THE WAVE. If any of these are new to you, then your education has been neglected for they are standards that have become traditional in the dancers' repertoire of years ago. Right there may be enough workshop material for months to come.

Of course, you know all the current QUARTERLY SELECTIONS.. previously termed "Experimental" by CALLERLAB? You DON'T?? Then you may have been putting in too much time with the far out stuff. There have been only 4 new QUARTERLY SELECTIONS in the past year, so it should not have been so difficult to learn those recommended figures. Perhaps you've been wasting your time on trying to master BANNER CIRCULATE or HITCH HIKE? If so, you are ready to concentrate on CHASE RIGHT & CYCLE AND WHEEL, which are on the QUARTERLY SELECTIONS every dancer should be learning. Catching up with the QUARTERLY list should be good for a few minutes of your time at your weekly workshop for the next couple of months.

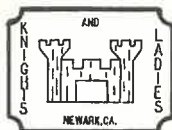

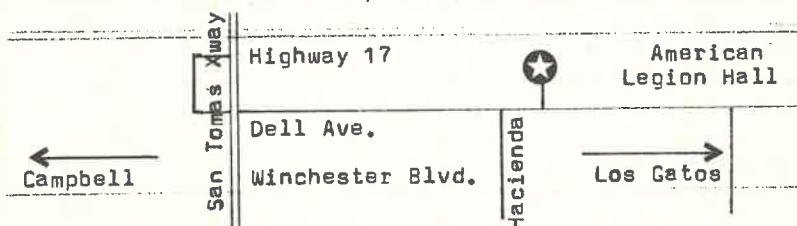
