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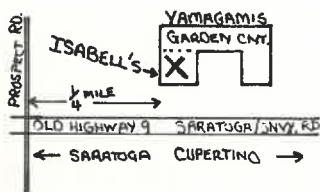

Dancers Do's and Don'ts
During the GAS CRUNCH!!!

Square dancers, known to be among the worlds most clever and innovative "critters", will unquestionably whip the current gasoline shortage hands down!

While the situation is serious, it has not reached epidemic proportions to warrant drastic measures such as having even day, odd day, and square dancers day at the gas pumps. 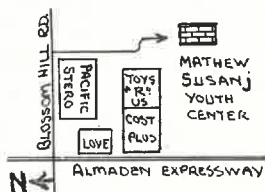

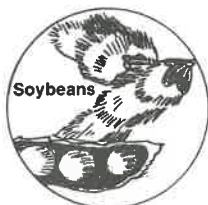
