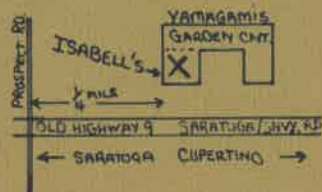

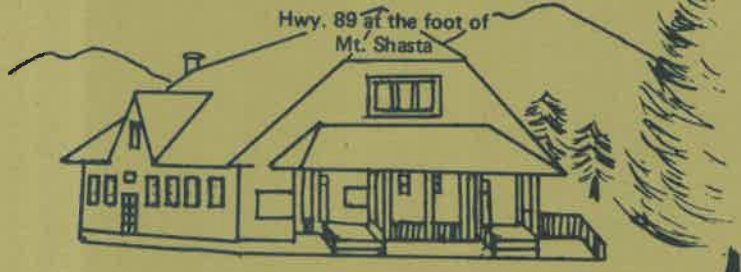

A LITTLE HISTORY....

Travel with us...back to Gilroy in 1949. LEE CLARK has just completed another adult education class in folk dancing held at the old Gilroy High School. The happy graduates want to continue dancing together so with folks like GEORGE REIF and VIVIAN RISK, the club was officially formed with LEE directing the dances. When he later moved from the area ACE SMITH took over and continued with the folk dancing although the square dancing, called by member HARRY CULLEM, was being added more and more to the program. The club ultimately converted to 100% square dancing and joined the SCVSDA in 1969. Following HARRY, KENNY STEEN was club caller for several years. The group currently dances (on a marvelous wooden floor!) at the Gilroy Grange Hall with BILL JEFFERS doing the calling. "Our Club has traditionally been a traveling group over the years", says ED PETERMAN, President and Club member since '58. "We've been to the Far West, Seattle and Canadian National Conventions and many other State and local Festivals. We do have some wonderful times together".

CALLERLAB Quarterly Selections (QS)

For the quarter beginning July 1, 1979, CALLERLAB has selected two calls for their Quarterly Selections. The two calls are TRACK & TRADE written by Ed Fraidenberg in 1976 (also rewritten by Ron Schneider in 1978 as Launch It) and the second call is MAKE ME A COLUMN by Dick Bayer. CALLERLAB urges all callers to use these two calls during the quarter beginning July 1, 1979 and further urges all callers to standardize the name to TRACK & TRADE since this call is more descriptive to the dancer. As an aside, you might mention that dancers may sometimes hear the call Launch It and they should do the TRACK & TRADE action. The descriptions and examples follow.

TRACK & TRADE: Starting from columns: Lead two dancers Promenade around the outside as in TRACK II; trailing two dancers Extend to a Half Tag Formation and TRADE, ends in two faced lines. (For ease of learning our examples use Boys in leading positions).

Examples: From static square;
Heads star thru, Double Pass Thru,
Girls do a "U" Turn Back, TRACK & TRADE, Ferris Wheel, Centers Pass Thru, Allemande Left.

Heads Pass Thru, Around 1 to line of 4,
Pass Thru, "U" Turn Back, Touch 1/4,
TRACK & TRADE, Wheel and Deal,
Square Thru 3/4, Trade By, Allemande Left

From 1p2p lines:
Pass Thru, Wheel and Deal, Double Pass Thru,

Centers In, Cast Off 3/4, Pass Thru,
"U" Turn Back, Touch 1/4, Track & Trade,
Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Star Thru,
Pass Thru, Trade By, Star Thru (1p2p lines)



MAKE ME A COLUMN: Starts from two faced lines: Centers facing in step forward and walk straight ahead to become lead dancer in column, Ends facing in follow along behind to become Number two dancer in column, Centers facing out turns towards the center and falls in behind end who was facing in and follows to become Number three dancer in the column while the ends facing out turn towards the centers and follow the adjacent center to become the number four dancer in the column. (ends in right or left hand column depending on starting two faced lines).

Examples: from static square
Heads lead right but veer left
MAKE ME A COLUMN,
Everybody Trade & Roll,
Allemande Left.

From 1p2p lines;
Pass Thru, Girls Fold, Star Thru,
MAKE ME A COLUMN, Single File Circulate,
Boys Run, Allemande Left.

The next issue will start our new schedule on publishing Square Dance News. We will be issuing a magazine every 45 days instead of monthly.

If you want to send in camera ready ads to take advantage of the lower price you must abide by the following rules:

1. **AD SIZE** .. Ads are made oversize and reduced by the printer to the final size that appears in the magazine. A full page ad before reduction, border to border is, 10" by 6", 1/2 page size is 5" by 6", etc. If you send in an ad the size that is in the magazine now it will be too small after being reduced to use. Remember 10" by 6" is the magic number. for a Full Page Ad.
2. Use a light blue pencil for your guide lines. Light blue does not photograph and all our material has to be photographed before it can be printed. Also you will not have to erase your guide lines.
3. Use black ink (felt pens are o.k.) on white paper. Colors do not photograph well.
4. If you want Callers photos in your ads we will have to compose the ad as special (half-tone) pictures must be used.

We are trying this new method, 45 days between issues, camera ready ads, to try and keep production costs from raising and beat inflation. We will have our problems, but if we all try we can keep the cost down and still enjoy our hobby, Square Dancing.

REMEMBER: August 1st is the deadline for the September First & October issue.

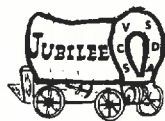
