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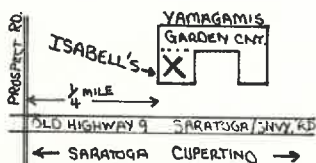

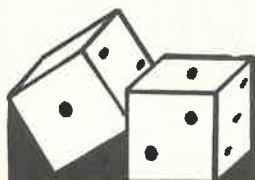

Bill Castner

July 5, 1921 - August 14, 1979

One of six children, WILLIAM E. CASTNER was born in Napa, Cal. on July 5, 1921. It was in the Napa Valley that Bill had his first contact with Square Dancing. He once recalled, "When I was a child, three or four years old, we went to Brown's Valley in Napa county in a flatbed wagon. My parents and others met every two weeks. In those days it was called 'Old Time Dancing' not Square Dancing but they danced Squares & Rounds and had a three piece band. The room was L-shaped and they put the kids to sleep at one end. Then at one o'clock we all got up for the best part, the one o'clock supper".

Bill entered the University of California in 1939 and he soon helped organize a campus activity known as the "U.C. Folk Dance Group". It was with this group that he began his calling career.

Bill joined the Air Force in 1940 and during his service years he maintained his interest in Folk Dancing. He often told of his visits to the Cecil Sharp House in London where he learned the Morris Stick and English line dances.

World War II ended and Bill returned to campus at University of California where he graduated with an M.A. in Engineering and an A.B. in Physical Education. It was during this five year period that he met and married his wife, Gretchen, started a family and plunged headlong into the Folk Dance activity with emphasis on Square Dancing. Bill started teaching school soon after graduation and this profession afforded him time to continue with his second career, Square Dance calling. He made calling tours every summer from 1949 through 1962. He called in forty-eight of the United States plus Mexico, Holland, France, Canada, Germany, England, Spain, Italy & Japan.

Bill was one of the first to conduct classes for callers in the Bay area and many of his 'graduates' are popular callers at the present time. He recorded more than twenty records but the one that he will always be identified with is "Oh Lonesome Me", one of Square Dance recordings biggest hits.

Since 1951 Bill has always had one or more Square Dance clubs that he called for on a regular basis. His last clubs were the Guys & Dolls of Pleasant Hill and the Forty Niners of So. San Francisco. He started calling for the Forty-Niners in May 1951 and remained with them for a record breaking twenty-eight years.

But probably the group that Bill is best known for nationally is the Squarenaders, an exhibition group that he organized in the early fifties. The Squarenaders have performed at every Golden State Round-Up since 1955 and at every National Convention since 1966

Bill was told by his doctors in early May that he had cancer of the liver, but as long as he was able to he called for his clubs and drilled the Squareaders. He directed the Squareaders from a wheel chair at the Round-Up this past May and with Gretchen at his side he made it to the National Convention in Milwaukee the end of June. He collapsed before he could appear with his group. He flew back to his home in LaFayette where he was cared for by Gretchen until his death on August 14, 1979.

Bill is gone but his contribution to the Square dance movement will live on. BILL CASTNER, a fiercely proud and independent man, Caller and Promotor of the American Folk Dance...the Square Dance.

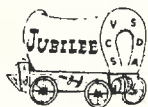

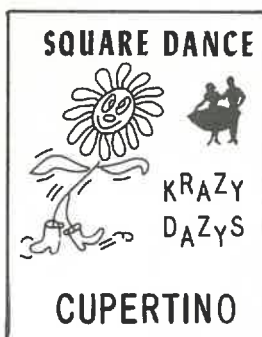

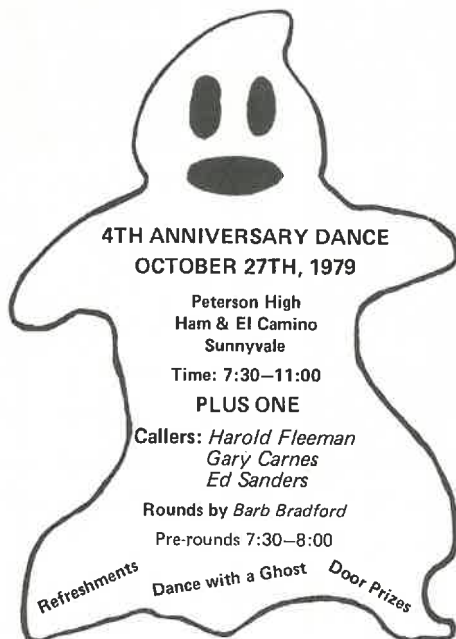
