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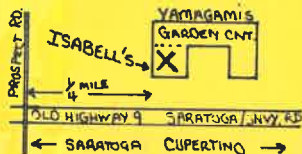

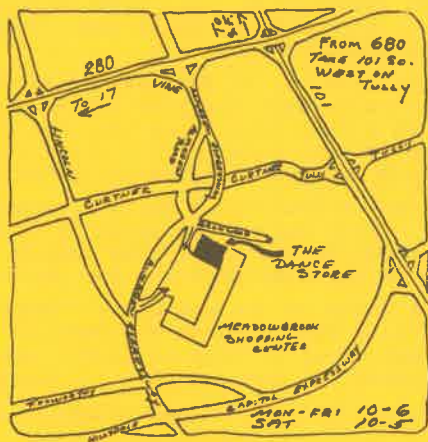
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FROM THE DESK OF Ken

Head Ladies Part: Head ladies move into the center and star right $3/4$; walk out of the star to the corner man for a left arm turn; drop hands with this man and move counter-clockwise to original opposite man for right arm turn; move to center and star by left $1\frac{1}{4}$, walk out to the side man for right arm turn, drop hands with him and move counter-clockwise to partner for courtesy turn.

Side Ladies Part: As head ladies move into the center, the side ladies will move to the right to their corner man for a right arm turn; move into the center and star by the left $1\frac{1}{4}$, walk out of the star to original opposite man for a right arm turn; drop hands with this man and move counter-clockwise to head man for left arm turn; move into center and star by right $3/4$; walk out of star to original partner for courtesy turn. Ladies remember to alternate hands .. do not use same hand twice. All four ladies, working simultaneously, will reach their partner at the same time for a courtesy turn.

Head Men's Part: Head men will receive the ladies from the left and put them in to the center for a star.

Side Men's Part: Side men will take ladies out of the center and send them to the right man. The men must take whatever hand the lady gives them. There are times when the men will use the same hand twice. Men must be sure to guide the ladies to the center or to the right, so the ladies will have no doubt as to the direction they are to go. Men use arm turns, use courtesy turn on final turn only.

NEWER DANCERS CHIT CHAT

with BARBARA



Hi Everybody! Now that the big rush is over, we can get back to the business at hand! Most of us had to miss some dancing over the Holidays and we feel like we forgot everything we ever learned. But, t'ain't so! Your first back-to-dancing night brings the happy surprise you haven't forgotten how. You may also be a little surprised to realize how much you missed Square Dancing, and at the satisfied feeling because you can get back to dancing each week! I share your feelings. Most all of you have gotten out to Hoedowns by now. Wasn't it nice to meet and dance with so many folks from other classes? Isn't it interesting to dance to different Callers? Each one has a little different style--you learn to listen for just the command. And that's good. TIP: If you get a little excited and feel you can't move fast enough, try prom-enad-ing close to the center of the square, take shorter steps step on each beat of music, and try to keep your square smaller. (Do this at class also!)

By now you really know you have to listen and pick out the commands you are to do. Especially when you are dancing to a Caller other than your own teacher. Let me share with you a secret: WHEN MOUTH OPENS - EARS CLOSE! When we hear a call that sounds unfamiliar, we have a tendency to open our mouth and draw in a quick gasp of air, or say "What did he say?" or groan, etc. As soon as we do any one of those things, our ears close, Callers usually give some help words after the command words. So keep those ears open!!

STYLING TIP: Ladies, in a Courtesy Turn (Ladies Chain, Right and Left Thru) use your free right hand to hold out your skirt. Very Pretty. Gents, when you have a free jamd. put it on your hip pocket, palm out. Neat.

There's an old saying that square dancing is friendship set to music. Act as if you're the host in each square. Try to dance with many different dancers each evening. Mistakes happen. When they do, don't stop and talk about it and try to figure out what went wrong where. As our good friend Rod says, "Grab one, they all work!" Keep moving -- even if you change partners. After you promenade home, you will have time to get your partner back. If you get too mixed up to keep going, get home quickly or into a line and be ready to go at the first appropriate call. Again, don't talk -- just listen -- and SMILE! In class, if there's some movement you don't quite understand, ask your Caller. Chances are good there are others who wonder about the same thing but are too shy to ask.
