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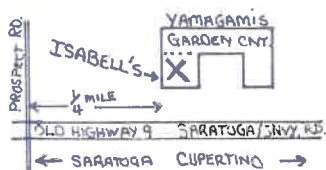

Gene and Mary Lou Brakeman, owners of The Dance Store at 2468 Almaden Expressway in San Jose, and Callers for the Circulators in Belmont and the Boots and Garters in San Jose, have been actively involved in Square Dancing for over 30 years, Mary Lou says longer than that for her, she Folk Danced as a child in San Francisco and always was the first up for the squares, often taking the boy's part, just like now. Gene and Mary Lou met at a singles square dance group in San Francisco the "Lonesome Polecats", soon starting another group with Gene learning to call and attending one of Bill Castner's early Callers Classes. Gene must have been one of the first, original "sight Callers" when a Caller they hired for a Hoedown was late and Gene had to step up and start the dance. Mary Lou says that was the longest tip she'd ever danced as Gene forgot the one memorized routine he'd been practicing & spent half an hour trying to get everyone "home." They first started offering square dance records in their Music Store in Redwood City as a service to the local Callers, soon expanding that part of the store to include all kinds of dance music, then separating the dance department and opening a Dance Supply Store in San Jose, expanding to include instruction books and sound systems. Gene, an electronic engineer, began developing his own Ashton Sound systems and Mary Lou added some clothing, finally combining with the Suzy Q, in their present location and changing the name to The Dance Store, where you can find, not only square dance clothing, music, books and accessories, but, also the largest selection of ballroom music in Northern California. Immediate plans for the store include an expansion of the tap, ballet, and gymnastic departments and an increase in the custom sewing & original square dance clothing departments. Stop in and see them, they are always willing to stop and talk about square dancing and have convinced many non square dancing customers to attend a local beginners class.

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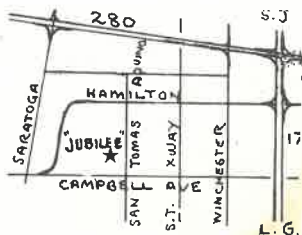

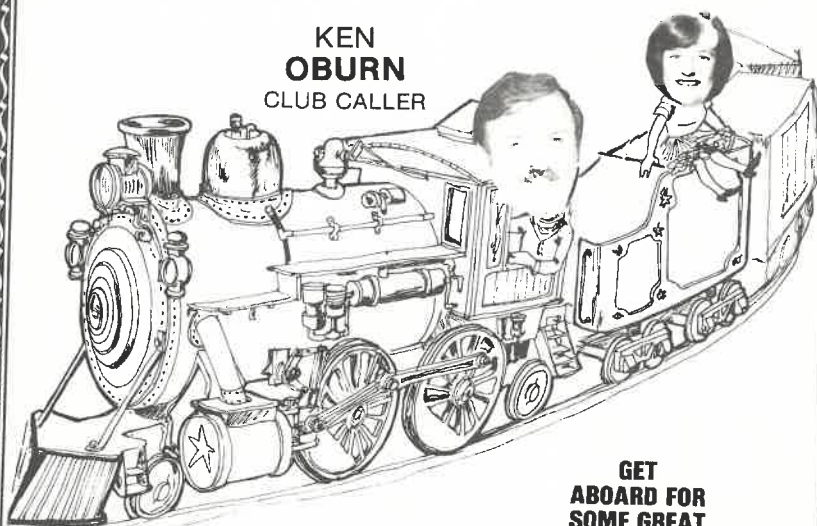

I am a compulsive caller and a member of Callers Anonymous. I read about this wonderful group, went to a meeting, took their advice and have not called a penny's worth since.

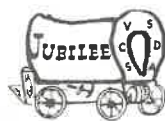
Callers Anonymous is a unique fellowship of men and women who share their experiences and their strength in an effort to solve a common problem, compulsive calling. It cost nothing to join. The only requirement is the desire to quit calling.

How does one tell if he is a compulsive caller? Here is a list of 20 questions. Anyone who answers YES to seven or more of these questions has a serious calling problem.

1. Do you lose time from work due to calling?
2. Is calling making your home life unhappy?
3. Is calling affecting your reputation?
4. Have you ever felt remorse after a calling date?
5. Do you call in the hope of making some money so you can pay your debts, record bills, or solve other financial difficulties?
6. Does calling keep you out late at night and prevent you from performing efficiently on the job the next day?
7. After a bad calling date do you feel you must return as soon as possible and try to cover your mistakes?
8. After a good calling date do you have a strong urge to return and call some more?
9. Do you often call until the last dancer is gone?
10. Do you ever borrow money to finance your calling?
11. Have you ever sold any personal property to finance your calling?
12. Are you reluctant to use calling money for normal expenditures?
13. Do you ever lie about your calling?
14. Do you ever call longer than you had planned because you just can't stop?
15. Do you ever call to take your mind off your problems?
16. Have you ever committed or considered committing, an illegal act to get a calling date?
17. Does calling cause you to have difficulty in sleeping?
18. Do arguments, disappointments or frustrations create with in you a compulsion to call?
19. Do you have an urge to celebrate good fortune by a few hours of calling?
20. Have you ever considered suicide as a result of your calling?

CALLERLAB recently completed its 7th Annual Convention and we are happy to report that we had more than 940 people in attendance. They represented 544 callers and for the first time we had VIP Guests from the National Executive Committee, LEGACY and ROUNDALAB. Forty-seven States were represented as well as 6 Canadian Provinces and 5 overseas locations. The average calling experience of those in attendance was 16.338 years and we had 18 Exhibitors.

Eight callers received Small World Awards. These awards are presented each year to the callers who are in attendance from overseas locations. This year these included:

The highlight of the Awards ceremonies was the awarding of the Milestone Awards. The highest award given by CALLERLAB in recognition of outstanding service over a long period of time. There were five awards given out this year and included a Posthumous award to Benjamin Lovett, the caller who worked for Henry Ford in the late 20's and early 30's. To many, he was considered the granddaddy of today's dancing. Ralph Page of Keene, New Hampshire was honored for his many contributions over an extended period of time in the New England area.

Charlie Baldwin was the third member to be honored for his outstanding contributions not only in New England but for his leadership throughout the US and not just limited to his calling. Don Armstrong, a member of the Hall of Fame, was the fourth recipient for his contributions most notably in the field of Contras. The fifth award was presented to Jack Laszary for his contributions to many callers over the years in the fields of Education, Training, and Note Services.

CALLERLAB 7th CONVENTION at Miami Beach, Florida by HAROLD FLEEMAN

Ken has asked me to write a short note on this years CALLERLAB 7th Convention. (Short note!! IMPOSSIBLE) I must tell you this year we had over 900 people in attendance and more than 150 Callers attending for the first time. The best estimate that anyone can come up with would indicate that there are approximately 9 to 10,000 Callers throughout the world. Our current membership is just over 1200. 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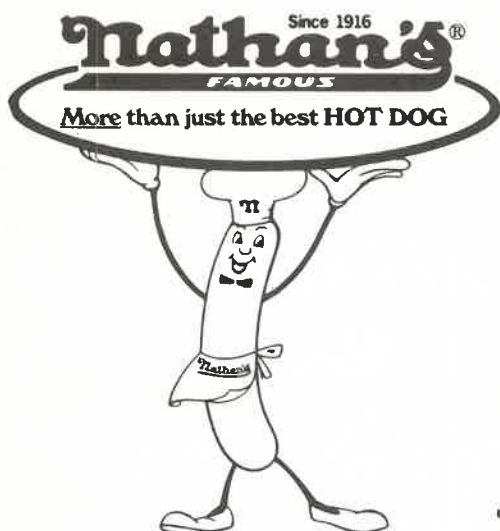

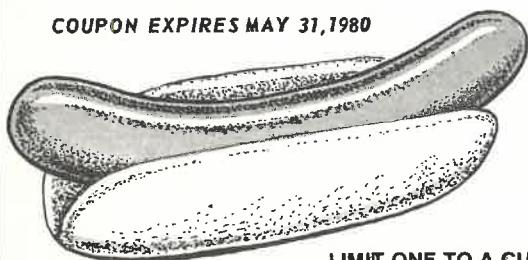

The International Association of Round Dance Teachers

At the invitation of CALLERLAB, two representatives from ROUNDALAB, attended the 7th annual Convention of CALLERLAB in Miami Beach, Florida. Attending were Charlie Capon, Executive secretary and Clancy and Betty Mueller, Chairmen of the Standardization Planning Committee.

Phase 1 and Phase 2 of Round Dancing were presented to CALLERLAB. Phase 1 and Phase 2 which includes those things a teacher needs to know in order to teach fundamental round dancing to people, were originally proposed by a committee chaired by Manning and Nita Smith. These phases have been thoroughly explored and discussed at subsequent ROUNDALAB meetings under the guidance of the Muellers and were adopted for a one year trial period October 1979.

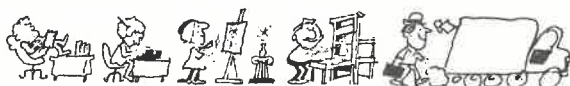
Phase 1 includes basic movements in the one-step, two-step, and waltz rhythms, dance positions, cardinal directions and movements used in round dancing, and stepping to the beat of the music. Phase 2 includes figures and secondary movements in the two-step and waltz. These two initial phases were developed at the request of CALLERLAB since this is an area of round dance teaching in which square dance callers who teach simple mixers and rounds generally work.

CALLERLAB unanimously endorsed and adopted the ROUNDALAB Phase 1 and Phase 2 of Round Dancing. CALLERLAB will include in its educational plan provisions for familiarizing callers with the adopted standards. It has further requested that ROUNDALAB develop a suggested teaching progression and wishes ROUNDALAB to provide suggested routines and/or dances for which clearly understandable cue sheets and records are available.

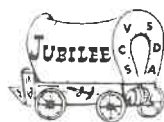
