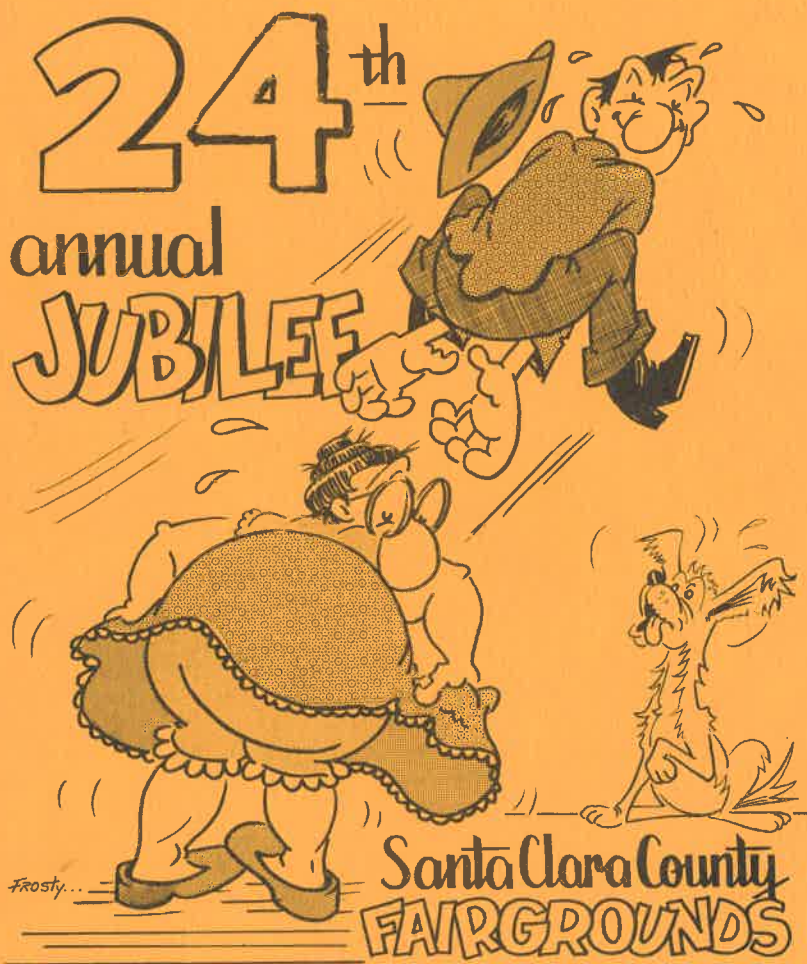

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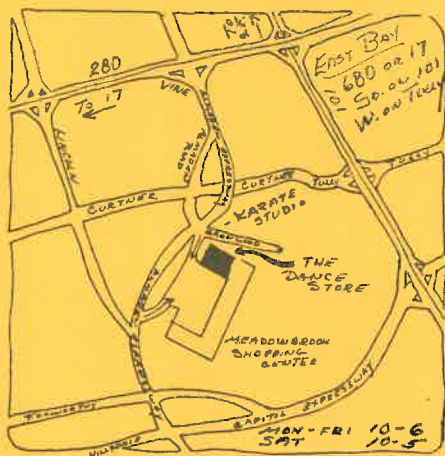
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A "HAPPENING" ? AN "EVENT" ?

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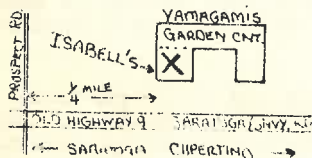

We are not many years away from the first days of our beginner's class, my Best Friend and I. (My Best Friend is also my husband and my dance partner. We have come a long way together and have managed to stay friendly through most of the trip.)

We started the beginner's class because we saw it advertised in the newspaper at a time we were in the market for a new activity. From what little we knew of square dancing, we thought it might be a pleasant enough form of exercise to become habit forming. The chance to meet new friends was an added incentive.

What "little" we knew was right! We grin as we think back to the September evening we decided to investigate.

Two cars were in the parking lot when we got to the meeting hall. We decided to sit in our own car and watch for awhile to see what developed.

The first development was most unexpected. Being ignorant of proper square dance attire, we were not prepared for the beruffled lady who suddenly appeared in the doorway, checking to see who might be outside the hall. To my Best Friend, I said something like, "Good golly, will you look at THAT!" Best Friend responded with "What IS it?"

What it was, was a rather heavy-set lady of mature years, with a pretty face, a yellow-flowered dress with babyish puffed sleeves, rows of little-girl ruffles, and a bouffant petticoat of buttercup yellow. She filled the doorway with all her glorious fluff.

Now that we are four years into square dancing, our reaction would be different, of course. Now I keep trying to acquire more and more glorious fluff of my own, the fluffier the better. But remember, on that first night, we were looking through very uneducated eyes.

We hadn't long to sit and ponder the apparition. The fluffy lady turned out to be a welcomer, and she was good at it. She saw us in our car, had us out of it and into the hall with our names on a sign-up sheet almost before we knew it. We found ourselves shaking hands with someone introduced to us as The Caller.

By now, several more fluffy ladies and their partners had filed in, along with more potential class members. Some of the other newcomers had clearly had previous exposure to the square dance movement, because they showed none of the surprise we felt over the costumes. Some were even saying that getting to wear crinolines was reason enough to learn to dance.

"Well, to each his own," I thought. Anyway, the outlandish clothes did not bother me so much as the size of the ladies wearing them. One of the things I had hoped to get out of square dancing was help in my fight with a weight problem. Looking at the club members as they came in, I had the feeling that was one dream I might as well forget. Many of those dancers, male as well as female, had weight problems far bigger than mine.

Another pair of rank beginners joined us to chat. The men agreed they could wear the kinds of outfits they saw on the fellows without feeling silly, so long as they avoided the gaudy rhinestone jewelry and sequined ties worn by a few. But those women's clothes--now they were something else! The other lady said, "The shoes are the last straw. They look too much like the ones I used to wear for Sunday best when I was in the first grade!"

In sauntered a man wearing a sheriff's badge. I recall thinking that at least this was a respectable activity. Otherwise there wouldn't be a lawman involved in it. It was several more weeks before I found out his only police power had to do with fine-collecting.

The Caller finally got all of us newcomers into a circle, put a record on the turntable, came down among us and began shuffling his feet to the beat of the music. "If you can do this, you can square dance," said he.

Before the introductory lesson ended, we were allemandeing, right-and-left granding and boxing the gnat all over the floor. We felt very smart, and we were hooked!

Time passes. The first night seems far away as we dress for a dance--I in my glorious fluff and my Best Friend in his rhinestone jewelry and sequined tie, and as we face Plus 1 and Plus 2 calls with relative ease.

We have by now had our turns at being welcomers, and I have wondered whether we have looked as strange to some of the ones we have greeted as our welcomer looked to us four years ago. I find myself trying to explain my dress to those who look surprised.

Perhaps it is worthwhile to consider the newcomer's first impression, for not everyone sees the same picture at first glance. A glazed look might mean nothing more than astonishment, and that goes away with understanding. A word of encouragement here, an explanation there, might be useful words to keep in mind as our new classes assemble.

Rounds By . . . Clark & Maxine Smith

Clark & Maxine Smith were taken to a Square Dance Beginner Class by a couple that lived near them in Palo Alto. They had been trying to get them to a class for sometime, knowing that Clark & Maxine enjoyed music and dancing. That started them out in 1953. Finished their class and then found out that the Round Dancing part of Square Dancing was a little like Ballroom Dancing they had enjoyed for years. Started in a class with Larry & Thelma Jessen in Belmont. So along with their Square Dancing in a club, they started in what was almost to be their hobby for many years, Round Dancing as a separate night of dancing.

In 1961 Clark & Maxine started their first classes as teachers. It was rough going, as there had not been any teachers in the Santa Clara Valley for several years, and the interest was not there as much as in other areas of the East Bay etc. The classes were very small at the beginning, and the interest of the people who did attend was there, so little by little the classes grew from the members of one class getting other people to attend. They formed a Round Dance Club, "Smith's Happy Rounders". As the groups grew and the various groups expanded into different categories, the Advanced Club name was changed to "The Golden Slippers" and the intermediate groups were named "The Silver Slippers". Today there are still many Silver Slipper and Golden Slipper dancers enjoying their Round Dancing along with Square Dancing, which Clark & Maxine still prefer to call twin dancing, one goes along with the other.

During their many years of teaching, they attended many institutes to improve themselves in the methods of teaching Round Dancing with some of the finest Round Dance Teachers in the U.S. Later on, they themselves conducted or taught at various Festivals. National at Seattle, Far West in Portland Oregon State Festival, Washington State in Seattle, Sacramento Harvest Hoedown several times, Fresno Squareama, Sonora Cup of Gold several times, Hawaiian Festival, Many California State conventions, Reno Jubilee.

They semi-retired from doing large Festivals now, and just keep their teaching to small fun groups of 25 to 30 squares at various places. Three Surf City groups, Summer with Mike & Norma Degmetitch, Ron & Sherry Welsh, Round Dance Surf City with Jack & Ione Kern & Mike & Norma Degmetitch, Winter with Mike & Norma Degmetitch, Mike & Judy Sikorsky. They have two times up in Washington at the Hayloft at Linnwood, Memorial Day Weekend and Labor Day Weekend.

They have held various offices in the No. Calif. Round Dance Teachers Assoc., and in the Santa Clara Valley Callers Assoc. plus serving as Round Dance Coordinators several years for our Jubilees in San Jose.

Clark & Maxine have two married children. Son, David & Daughter, Lynn. Two Grandsons, Terry & Brian who give them lots of pleasure. ☺
