COCOANUT GROVE

By Murle and Ariel Marquis, Glendale, California

Music: S.I.O. Record No. 3004

Position: Skaters position with lady's right hand on skirt edge. Footwork is identical throughout entire dance.

Sequence: I, I, II, I

INTRODUCTION

Meas.

1-4 Wait

5-8 Walk forward four steps, beginning with left foot.

PART I

1-4 CROSS; SIDE; IN BACK; STEP/STEP;
Touch left foot across in front of right. Touch left foot to side. With a lift of left toe and rising on ball of right foot, cross left foot in back of right, step on left. Step to side on right. Step in place on left.

5-8 CROSS; SIDE; IN BACK; STEP/STEP;
Repeat meas. 1-4 beginning with right foot.

9-12 WALK; PIVOT; GRAPEVINE; PIVOT;
Step forward on left. Step forward on right, pivoting $\frac{1}{4}$ right face turn (both have backs to center). Step to side on left. Step in back on right. Step to side on left, pivoting $\frac{1}{4}$ left face turn to face LOD.

13-16 WALK; PIVOT; GRAPEVINE; PIVOT;
Repeat action of meas. 9-12 beginning with right foot. The first pivot will be left and the second, right.

17-32 Repeat Part I

COCOANUT GROVE (Cont.)

PART II

- 1-4 CROSS/SIDE; CROSS/SWING; CROSS/SIDE; CROSS/SWING;
Crossing in front of right, step on left. Step to side on right. Again crossing left in front of right, step on left, swing right around while pivoting on left. This action moves diagonally right from LOD. Crossing in front of left, step on right. Step to side on left. Again crossing right in front of left, step on right, swing left around while pivoting on right. This action moves diagonally left from LOD.
- 5-8 CROSS/SIDE; CROSS/SWING; CROSS/SIDE; CROSS/SWING;
Repeat meas. 1-4
- 9-12 CANTER/TWO; THREE/FOUR; TWIRL/TWO; THREE/FOUR;
Both turning left face to complete one revolution in eight counts, step on left, rock back on right. Again step on left, rock back on right. While man continues this action for four more counts, lady does one right face twirl under man's left arm in four counts, to resume skaters position. Both now facing LOD.
- 13-16 GRAPEVINE; LEFT; GRAPEVINE; RIGHT;
Step to side on left. Step behind on right. Step to side on left. Touch right across in front of left. Repeat action stepping to side on right, behind on left, side on right, touch left across in front of right.
- 17-32 Repeat Part I

TAG

- 1-4 Walk forward four steps beginning with left foot (as in introduction).
- Repeat entire dance twice more. Twirl the lady and curtsy on last two counts.

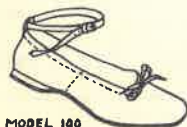

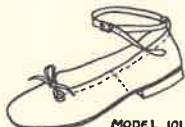
