This selection has been made by the Round Dance Committee, Ruth Graham, Chairman, in cooperation with the Square Dancers Association. The Committee feels selections occasionally should include some of the popular dances presented during the past several years - thus, Blue Pacific Waltz.

BLUE PACIFIC WALTZ

By Henry "Buzz" Glass, Oakland, California.

Music: Blue Pacific Waltz. Old Timer #8070
Western Jubilee #702, Windsor #7609

Starting Position: Open dance position facing LOD,
joined hands extended backward.
Directions for gent, lady does
counterpart.

- | Measure | Pattern |

| Intro. | BALANCE FORWARD; BALANCE BACK; FORWARD; BACK;
Swinging joined hands forward and back, balance forward L (ct. 1, hold 2, 3), balance back R (ct. 1, hold 2, 3). Repeat. |
| 1 | STEP, SWING, - ;
Swinging joined hands forward, turn slightly away from partner and step L, swing R across L (ct. 1, 2, hold). |
| 2 | TURN, TURN, - ;
Swinging joined hands back and releasing, change places with 1 full turn in 2 steps (gent R face, lady L face): make $\frac{1}{2}$ turn R face on R (ct. 1), step L to complete turn (ct. 2, hold 3), end still facing LOD (Lady turns in front of gent). |
| 3-4 | STEP, SWING, - ; TURN, TURN, - ;
Repeat meas. 1-2 on opposite feet with lady on gent's L. |
| 5-6 | STEP, SWING, - ; STEP, SWING, - ;
Repeat meas. 1 then face partner, change hands and step R, swing L across R (ct. 1, 2, hold 3). |

- 7-8 WALTZ; WALTZ;
In closed position, 2 CW waltzes starting L.
- 9-16 STEP, SWING, - ; TURN, TURN, - ; STEP, SWING, - ; TURN,
TURN, - ; STEP, SWING, - ; STEP, SWING, - ; WALTZ;
WALTZ;
Repeat meas. 1-8.
- 17 STEP, SWING, - ;
Still in closed dance position but both turned to
face LOD, step forward L in LOD and swing R forward
(ct. 1, 2, hold 3).
- 18 TWINKLE;
Step forward R (ct. 1), turning R face to face
partner step L by R (ct. 2), step in place R, both
face RLOD (ct. 3) without dropping hands.
- 19 TWINKLE;
Repeat meas. 18 starting L. End both facing LOD.
- 20 STEP, TOUCH, - ;
Step forward R in LOD (ct. 1), touch L by R (ct. 2,
hold 3).
- 21-28 STEP, SWING, - ; TWINKLE; TWINKLE; STEP, TOUCH, - ;
STEP, SWING, - ; TWINKLE; TWINKLE; STEP, TOUCH, - ;
Repeat meas. 17-20 2 more times.
- 29 STEP, SWING, - ;
Repeat meas. 17.
- 30 HOOK, PIVOT, - ;
Gent crosses R over L, placing R near L (ct. 1 - the
hook step), then pivots L face until feet are
parallel, putting weight on R (ct. 2, 3) as lady does
1 waltz step starting L, swinging around L face to
face gent.
- 31-32 WALTZ; WALTZ;
In closed position, 2 CCW waltzes starting L.

Ending:

- 1-2 Gent steps side L (ct. 1, hold 2, 3), closes R to L
and bows (ct. 1, hold 2, 3), as lady steps forward R,
faces partner (ct. 1, hold 2, 3), steps L behind R
and curtseys (ct. 1, hold 2, 3), joining gent's L
and lady's R hands.

As they would move in and out the skirts would bend to the breeze more gracefully. And how they can judge those distances---at times the rotor tips must have been within a foot of each other! Maybe it doesn't sound funny, but if you could have seen it you'd have gotten the laugh of the year out of it".
