This selection has been made by the Round Dance Committee, Ruth Graham, Chairman, in cooperation with the Square Dancers Association.

WALTZ CAROUSEL

Original Dance of Dena M. Fresh, Mission, Kansas

Music: "It's a Sin to Tell a Lie" - Decca #23604,
Western Jubilee #718-A; Windsor #7616

Starting Position: OPEN (inside hands joined and back). Directions are for M with W doing OPPOSITE throughout. Start L foot.

Measure INTRODUCTION

- 1-2 WAIT
3-4 APART AND BOW; TOGETHER

DANCE

- 1-4 WALTZ AWAY (L); FACE TO FACE; STEP, SWING, PIVOT; STEP, TOUCH, -;
Waltz forward with L lead swinging joined hands forward and turning back to back; Waltz forward with R lead swinging hands back and facing partner; Step fwd on outside foot and swing inside ft fwd to pivot back to back; Still back to back, step side in LOD and touch free foot beside it;
- 5-8 LADY AROUND, 2, 3; 4, 5, 6; TWIRL, TOUCH, -; STEP, TOUCH, -;
M remaining facing center, change joined hands to M L & W R, while M takes six steps in place or slightly bwd, W "runs" in six steps around to face M on last ct of second meas. On meas. 7 W twirls under his L and her R in three steps as M does step L and touch R. Then, moving LOD M does step R touch L as W steps L and touches R. End facing RLOD in OPEN position.

OF THE MONTH

- 9-16 Repeat Meas. 1-8 but moving RLOD. On last step touch M faces RLOD while W faces LOD and change hand hold to L hand STAR.
- 17-20 DIP (L), 2, PIVOT; DIP, 2, PIVOT; STAR AROUND, 2, 3; 4,5,6;
Moving in LOD step back on L (W fwd on R) with dip or accented knee bend on first ct, back on R, & turn one-half face L or CCW turn twd each other to face in opposite directions & star with R hands. M steps fwd on R (W back on L) with another dip, fwd on L, turn or pivot to face each other with one-half R-face or CW turn and star with L hands. Go into waltz-around each moving fwd for one full rev in two meas. to end M f facing RLOD and W LOD.
- 21-24 LADY TURNS; BOTH TURN; STAR AROUND, 2, 3; 4, 5, 6;
Moving LOD, W turns R face or CW away from partner in 3 cts while M does one waltz backing up in LOD. The M then turns R face or CW away from partner While W completes her turn of meas. 21 with another waltz step. This is timed so partners join L hands in star at outset of meas. 23. Star around ends in semi-closed position, Man facing wall.
- 25-28 STEP (L), SWING, -; CROSS, SIDE, BEHIND; STEP, SWING, -; CROSS, SIDE, BEHIND;
In semi-closed pos moving LOD M does step L, swing R, hold; step R across in front of L, steps to side on L in LOD, step on R behind L while W does opposite. Repeat.
- 29-32 BALANCE BACK (L); WALTZ TURN; WALTZ; TWIRL;
In CLOSED pos M facing wall, balance back on L, two meas. of CW waltz turn end with W twirling in usual fashion to open out and repeat dance.

RECORD PERMITS THREE ENTIRE SEQUENCES.

ENDING BALANCE BACK (L); WALTZ; WALTZ & TWIRL: BOW AND CURTSY;

Note: Mrs. Fresh (quoted) "I wanted a dance to symbolize a merry-go-round. From the beginning and throughout, we like the up-and-down motion in a somewhat exaggerated or accented movement--especially in meas. 17-24--where the knee dip and star around with a lean-away gives that feeling."

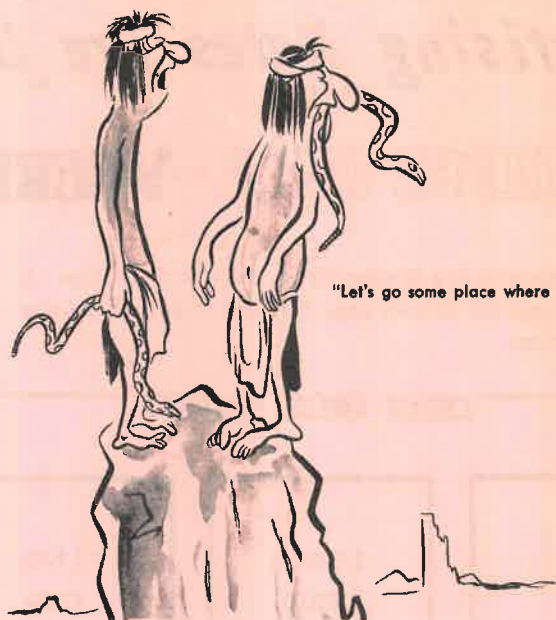
