ROUND DANCE

This selection was made by the Round Dance Committee of the Caller's Association. March is Ruth Graham's last month as chairman of this committee.

ANNIVERSARY PROGRESSIVE TWO-STEP

Music: "Eva Three Step (Parlophone); "Progressive Two-Step" (London); or "Gadabout" (Victor 20-4568)

Musical Intro: 4 Measures. Speed up record slightly

Starting Position: Facing (M faces partner and wall—both hands joined.) Directions for M; woman uses opposite.

Measure

Pattern

- 1-4 APART (L), 2; 3, POINT (R); FORWARD (R), 2; 3, JOIN HANDS;
Both step backward. M steps L,R,L. Points R (some prefer a "touch"). Both step fwd M with R,L,R, pt, L as M moves diag. to R finishing "Alamo style" in complete circle M facing out holding partner L to L and W originally on his right side with his R hand.
- 5-8 PAS DE BAS LEFT; PAS DE BAS RIGHT; LEFT HAND SWING; TAKE HANDS AGAIN;
Both do pas de bas CCW then CW (a light leap on L, step briefly on R in front of L toe, step L in place—repeating in opposite direction with opposite footwork. A two-step will do. Release R hands and retaining L, walk CCW half-way around partner so that M faces center resuming "Almo Style". Circle with M holding R hands with W now on his R. This turn is done in four steps—L,R;L,R close.
- 9-12 PAS DE BAS LEFT; PAS DE BAS RIGHT; RIGHT SWING, GIRLS TWIRL; AND CLOSE;
Pas de bas CW then CCW as above. Release L hands, walk CW half-way M with L,R,L,R as W twirls slowly in four steps R,L,R,L CCW under Man's R arm (like a "Box the Gnat") ending with M facing this new partner and the wall in closed position. (Orig. inst. called for no swirl—just the swing and change of position).

OF THE MONTH

13-16 STEP (L), CLOSE (R); STEP (L), CLOSE (R); TURN (L), STEP (R)/STEP (L); TURN (R), STEP (L)/STEP (R); Step left to side along LOD, close R to L and repeat same. One complete CW turn using footwork similar to Viennese Waltz turn. W steps forward R between M feet as he starts his turn stepping LOD with L heel lead pivoting sharply around W on the 1st ct. Two quick steps in place follow. Then W does the turning pivot as the M steps forward between her feet with the two quick steps following. Same general maneuver as the typical American two-step turn but with the English accent of Viennese Waltz. A complete turn is made in the two measures, partners are in original position and immediately separate backing away or apart to re-start at Measure 1.

NOTE: Progression is with M moving forward CCW one place each sequence.

Officials of the Convention have just announced that tickets are now on sale and these tickets can be purchased by mail immediately by sending check or money order to National Square Dance Convention, P. O. Box 9536, Dallas, Texas. A self-addressed stamped envelope must be enclosed with check or money order.

Mr. Lee Bedford Sr., Chairman of the Convention, said that price of tickets bought in advance by mail would be \$1.00 per person per day or \$3.00 per person for the three days. If the tickets are purchased on arrival at Dallas the tickets will cost \$1.25 per person or \$3.75 for the three days. Actually, \$1.25 is the regular price but it was felt that some concession should be made to those who cooperated by purchasing tickets in advance.

Tickets will be in different colors, a different color for each day. Therefore, those who purchase less than three tickets must specify the day or days for which they want the tickets. Tickets will entitle all participants to all of the events which are scheduled throughout each day and evening and will naturally include the dances which will be the biggest feature each evening of the Convention. All events will take place at the Texas State Fair Grounds and the buildings which are reserved for this Convention are all within a stone's throw of each other.

One of the feature attractions of the big National Square Convention to be held in Dallas April 8, 9 and 10, 1954, will be a Square Dance Workshop and Clinic. Bob Osgood of Los Angeles and Tom Mullen of Houston are in charge and they are asking teachers and callers, who have any highly interesting square dance material they wish to present during the Workshop and Clinic sessions, to write immediately to the above address, describing the particular material they want to present.

Texas was unanimously selected by the Location Committee for the 1954 Convention because of its traditional enthusiasm for Square Dancing and its southern and western hospitality. Plans for a mammoth festival in Dallas are now in the making. The Convention will kick-off with a huge parade in which music and Square Dancing typical of each state or locality will be featured. Approximately 50,000 Square Dancers, Square Dance spectators, musicians, Leaders and Callers are expected to converge on Dallas during the three days of the Convention.

Square Dancers who wish to participate in the "Trail Dances" on their way to and from the Convention may obtain a free copy of "Trail Dances" also by writing to the above address and enclosing a self-addressed stamped envelope. When writing give starting point and time of trip, route you may take to and from the Convention and when you expect to return home.

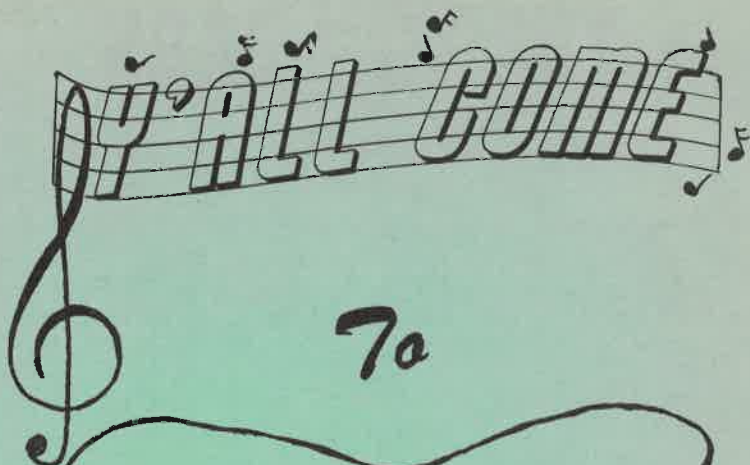
