SYMPATHY

By Dr. Roger Knapp, Corpus Christi, Texas

Record: Starday No. D-1001

Position: Semi-closed dance. Facing LOD

Start: Outside feet. Lady does counterpart through-out.

Figure: Part A

- 1-4 STEP, SWING,-; STEP, SWING,-; STEP, SWING,-; DIP, TURN, TURN;
Step forward outside feet and swing inside feet forward LOD. Step again forward LOD and swing outside feet forward. Step forward LOD again and swing inside feet forward. Dip in long step forward LOD and turning towards each other in two steps to face RLOD still with his L and her R hands joined and his R hand touching her waist.
- 5-8 STEP, SWING, (REVERSE); DIP, 2-3; WALTZ 2-3; TWIRL 2-3;
Step RLOD on his L and her R and swing his R and her L in LOD at the same time pivoting toward each other to face LOD and dip forward LOD and take two fast steps forward, still in semi-closed position. Close and waltz one meas. Twirl under his L and her R. End facing.

Part B

9-12 AWAY; AND TOGETHER; WALK AROUND 2-3-4-5-6;
Still holding his L and her R hands but facing each other balance away from each other in measure 9 and together in measure 10 but together in left hips adjacent and his R and her L palms touching at shoulder height. The gent still holding her R hand in his L walks around her CCW as she makes two full R face turns in place (whirl) ending with his back to center and her back to wall facing still, his L and her R hands joined.

13-16 AWAY; AND TOGETHER; WALK AROUND 2-3-4-5-6;
Repeat action of 9-12 ending in semi-closed position facing LOD. The gent has to make an additional left face turn at end of walk around to get into the semi-closed position and face LOD.

17-24 REPEAT PART A ending in closed position, gent facing wall.

Part C

25-28 BALANCE BACKWARD; BALANCE FORWARD; STEP SWING; TURN AROUND AND CLOSE 2-3;
In closed position gent balances backward toward center on L and then forward toward wall on R at same time pivoting to face (both) LOD in semi-closed position. Step forward on outside feet in LOD and swing inside feet forward. Gent turns L face and lady turns R face in three steps to end with gent's back to LOD and in closed dance position. This turn is made in place for the lady and the gent also, but he must move slightly LOD in order to close with his back to LOD.

29-32 WALTZ 2-3; WALTZ 2-3; WALTZ 2-3; TWIRL START;
In closed dance position waltz three measures turning CW and progressing LOD to twirl lady under his L and her R hands to end in semi-closed position ready to start.

Sequence of dance: Part A-B-A-C and repeat twice.
