NOTES ON VISITING

by MADELINE ALLEN

We all know, by now, that "Square Dancing is Fun". At least, we have been told so often enough. But have you ever tried to do "Caribbean" at 160, with two couples who never heard of it and one couple who knows it backward but won't help? That's fun?

Of course, you can avoid a situation like that by dancing only in your own Club, to your own Caller, and preferably with your own square. You won't be bothered, but you won't be a Square Dancer either. Until you learn how to venture out and dance with all kinds of dancers, and enjoy it, you won't be getting all that Square Dancing has to offer.

The real question is, what ought you to know in order to make the most of any mixture of dancers you encounter? Here are a few tips from one who has had it.

In the first place, both the top and the bottom dancers in a square have problems and duties. The main object of all eight people is to do what the Caller says, or, if that is asking too much, to fool the Caller into thinking you are doing it. This last is accomplished by keeping moving, by swinging some girl when he says "swing", by forming an Allemande Thar with someone when it is called, and by accepting cheerfully any partner who comes your way, right or wrong. The weaker ones in the square can help by being flexible, taking any hand they are offered, and watching which direction the others are taking. The stronger ones can lead -- by forcing a Star to turn far enough before it breaks, by releasing a Corner so that he is facing the way he should go, by nudging a couple who ought to move, and especially by knowing where every person in the square should be and helping them to get there. Some ways in which they cannot help are by trying to explain the figure during the Call, by pushing past slower dancers to show how well they know the dance, or by frowning at everyone who makes a boo-boo.

If you find yourself outclassed, don't worry. Listen as carefully as you can, look at the others for a lead, and thank them, with a grin, when they stop you just in time from going the wrong way. Don't try to alibi by saying you can't hear -- the sound is the same for everyone, but the better the dancer, the less he has to hear. Above all, don't give up. Keep trying, keep moving, and eventually someone will put you on the right track again.

Another tip to visitors -- don't hang back until all the Sets in front are filled, and spend the evening dancing in the rear of the hall with all the other weak dancers. Start your own square right up in front, and other Eager Beavers will fill in. (They will, that is, if you look like Square Dancers. If the lady is wearing high heels and a tight skirt, or the gent has on a short sleeved shirt, don't be surprised if dancers avoid you. You look as if you not only didn't know anything, but didn't want to learn.)

Once you have found out how to walk into a strange Club, make yourself at home, make friends, and make people glad you came, you will visit often. And when something as tremendous as the Golden State Round Up comes your way, you will know how to get the most out of it. You will make yourself a part of the exciting whole, and will come away from it with lame feet and bleary eyes, but with a host of new friends from all over the country, and a new concept of Square Dancing.

Music: "Downhill Drag", Victor 20-5704.

Position: Open, facing LOD, inside hands joined.

Directions: For man, woman does counterpart.

Measures

Music A

- 1-4 STEP-SWING, STEP-CLOSE; STEP-SWING, STEP-CLOSE; AND REPEAT.
Starting with outside foot, step fwd. L swing R fwd., step on R and close L; (count 1 and, 2 and;). Repeat above starting with R foot. Repeat twice more starting L and then R foot.
- 5-8 STEP, POINT; POINT BACK, PIVOT; AND REPEAT.
Step fwd. L, point fwd. with R; point back with R, (weight still on L ft.) pivot on L (R face) to end facing RLOD; (change hands). Step RLOD with R, point L fwd.; point back with L, (weight still on R ft.) pivot on R (L face) to end facing partner; (gent's back to center, take closed dance position).
- 9-12 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP;
In closed dance position, four two-steps starting with man's L, turning CW, moving CCW. End in open position facing LOD.

Music A (Repeat)

- 13-24 Repeat measures 1-12, ending in BANJO POSITION, man facing LOD, woman's back to LOD. R hips adjacent.

OF THE MONTH

Music B

- 1-4 TWO-STEP FWD.; TWO-STEP, PIVOT; TWO-STEP FWD.; TWO-STEP, PIVOT 1/2 TURN;
In Banjo position man takes 2 two-steps fwd. in LOD, pivoting on third step of second two-step (R ft.) to face RLOD. (Do NOT drop hands, L hips are now adjacent). Then 2 two-steps RLOD, pivoting on third step of second two-step to face partner and take closed dance position.
- 5-8 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP;
Repeat measures 21-24 of part A ending in Banjo position.

Music B (Repeat)

- 9-16 Repeat B, measures 1-8.

TAG

- 1-4 POINT CLAP, CLAP CLAP; CLAP,---; TURN, TWO; THREE; BOW, CHUG;
Drop hands, point L ft. (ct. 1) clap four times (ct. and, 2, and; 1), make a three step turn away from partner in LOD, L R L ending facing partner (ct. 2; 1, 2;). Bow (ct.1) join both hands with partner and chug (ct.2) away.

Note: Start tag after 4th two-step of "B repeat", claps are started immediately following point forward, three step turn and bow are slow.

SEQUENCE---DANCE THRU TWICE, THEN TAG.
