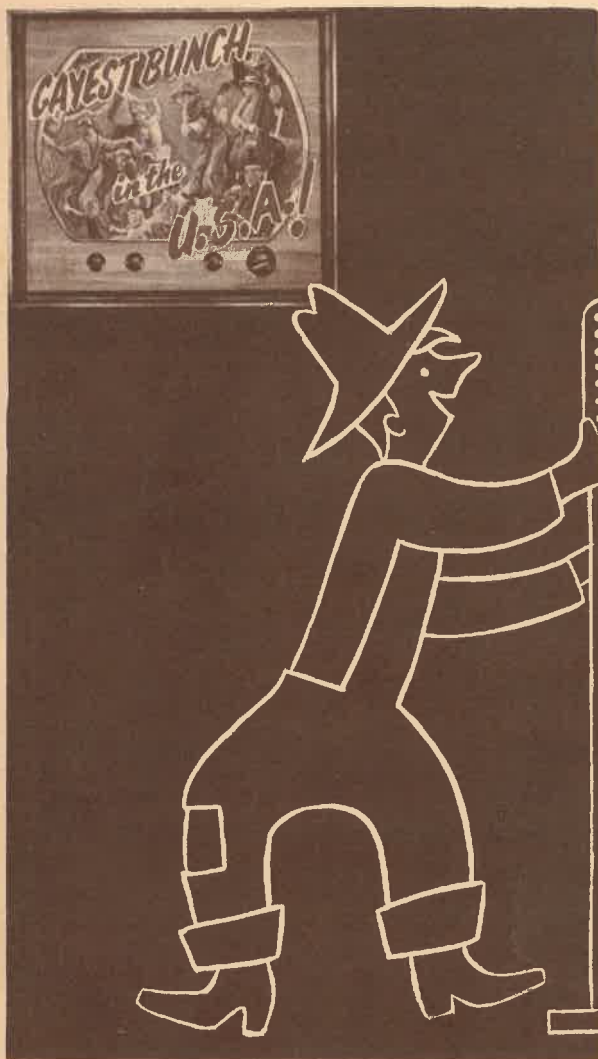

COMMERCIALISM?

Periodically a cry goes up about 'commercialism' in the field of Square Dancing. We used to have complaints about paying admission to the dances, we heard bitter comments about advertisements in dance magazines, and about Callers promoting records, and about charges for classes. In each case, however, people got used to the idea of paying for what they wanted, and in the end they got a much better product than they had before.

Look at the items you can buy now, designed and made especially for Square dancers. Remember how we used to hunt for shoes, for men's ties, for shirts, for petticoats, to say nothing of records and sound equipment. When we started dancing, we had one record without calls, and we turned it over all evening long. Now look at the choice! Is that bad?

The newest complaint I have heard is about the charges made by Callers. It is a lament for the old days, when so many Callers came to each Hoedown that all you had to do was to call them up from the floor in turn, and you had your program. The Calling may not all have been good, but it was varied and it was free. Now, the trend is toward a program of not more than two or three Callers, all invited, and all paid. Where, they ask, is it going to end? How can smaller Hoedowns afford to compete? Where can Beginning Callers get experience?

It seems to me that the answer is that Square Dancers are learning more all the time. As our activity grows up, more and more of us are learning what good Calling really is, and how much difference it makes to us to be able to relax, and quit worrying about whether or not the Caller knows what he is doing. Top quality Calling is like a good steak - there's nothing we'd like better, but we realize that we can't all have it every day. We're glad to worry along with what we can get, for our regular Club nights, but we do like to get out on Saturday night and dance to the best Callers we can find. And those who promote Hoedowns are realizing that, and are planning accordingly.

Actually, it seems to me that the law of supply and demand is operating very satisfactorily in the field of Square Dance Callers, and the situation is a very healthy one. We still have more Callers in the Bay Area than in almost any other similar area, of all degrees

Record: "Somebody Stole My Gal" - Victor 20-6199
 Position: Open; Both face LOD. Inside hands joined.
 Footwork: Start M's LEFT. W does counterpart throughout
 Intro: Three beats of music
 Meas.

- 1-4 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TURN AWAY, TWO; THREE, TOUCH;
 Two fwd two-steps; Drop hands, turn away (M's L, W's R)
 with 3 steps, progressing in LOD, join M's L and W's R
 hands and touch R toe by L instep. End open position,
 both facing RLOD.
- 5-8 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TURN AWAY, TWO; THREE, TOUCH;
 Repeat Meas. 1-4 progressing RLOD, M turning R (W-L).
 End open position, both facing LOD, M's R and W's L
 hands joined.
- 9-12 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; STEP, TOUCH; STEP/PIVOT, DRAW;
 Progressing in LOD, drop hands, and, turning individually
 with 2 two-steps, make $\frac{1}{2}$ turn to face RLOD in open pos; Join
 M's L and W's R hands and step bwd in LOD on L and touch R by
 L; Step fwd in RLOD on R, pivoting on R to face LOD, drop M's
 L and W's R and join M's R and W's L and draw L to R and
 touch.
- 13-16 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; STEP, TOUCH; STEP/PIVOT, DRAW;
 Repeat Meas 9-12. End facing partner, M's back to COH,
 both hands joined.
- 17-20 SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, TOUCH; STEP, BRUSH/PIVOT; STEP, TOUCH;
 Step to side on L in LOD, step behind L on R; Step to side
 on L and touch R by L (drop M's R and W's L but keep others
 joined); Step to side on R in RLOD, and, brushing L in
 front of R, pivot to a back-to-back position; Step in RLOD
 on L and touch R by L. Keep M's L and W's R joined.
- 21-24 SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, TOUCH; STEP, BRUSH/PIVOT; STEP, TOUCH;
 Moving in LOD, still in back-to-back position, Step to side
 in LOD on R, step behind R on L; Step to side on R and
 touch L by R; Step to side on L in RLOD, brush R in front
 of L, pivoting on L to a face-to-face position; Step in
 RLOD on R and touch L by R. Take Semi-closed position,
 both facing LOD.
- 25-28 SLIDE, SLIDE; SLIDE, STEP/THRU; SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, STEP/
 THRU;
 Three Sliding steps in LOD, stepping fwd with L ft and using the
 R to propel, as in a buzz swing in square dancing (on the 3rd
 slide, keep wt on L), then step on R across in front of L; Tak-
 ing loose closed position, M's back to COH, grapevine to L:
 Step to side on L, step behind L on R; Step to side on L, both
 turning to face LOD, step fwd and thru on R. Take closed po-
 sition.

29-32 TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWIRL; TWIRL;

Two R-face turning two-steps progressing LOD; then, M walks fwd 4 steps as W turns R-face under her own R and M's L arms, with 2 twirls. End semi-closed position, both facing LOD.

33-40 SLIDE, SLIDE; SLIDE, STEP/THRU; SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, STEP/thru; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWIRL; TWIRL;

Repeat Meas 25-32. End open position to repeat pattern. do entire pattern three times in all. On the last time thru the pattern, add:

ENDING: ONE EXTRA TWIRL; STEP AWAY, AND POINT.

Fraternization among Clubs and Callers could be our answer, this calls for cooperation; THAT SOMETHING: which has made our Round-Ups so successful.

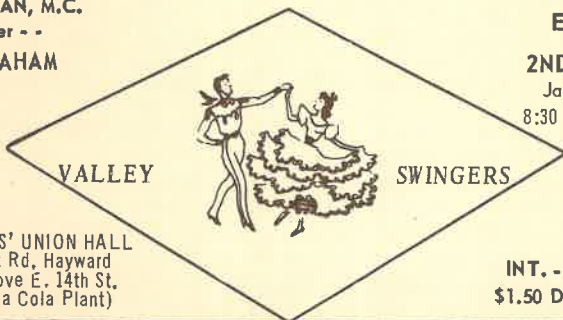
