HIGH LEVEL QUANDARY

When you come right down to it, what every Square Dancer wants is more Square Dancers just like himself to dance with. No matter what his 'level' is, whether he likes to whoop and holler or prefers smooth dancing, or just likes an occasional Square Dance without being too serious about it, he still wants a lot of other dancers who like the same thing. High Level Dancers are no different from any others, except that their wants are a little harder to fill. We are all interested in how to go about developing more new dancers to suit everybody.

Originally, you learn to square dance by being brought to dances as a child, and watching. Then there was a period when small groups of people bought Square Dance records with Calls, and learned in basements and playrooms. (In many parts of the country, this is still the way most people start.) Next, having pushed one of its members into learning to call, the group would form a Club and rent a Hall, and whenever they could find a few more people who wanted to learn, they would invite them in and teach them. But as Square Dancing grew more complicated, it became apparent that no Club was going to be satisfied for very long if they had to begin all over again for each new group, so Beginners' classes were started. These classes were held for eight or ten weeks, and the 'graduates' were taken into the Club. Then as those already dancing learned more and more, even this system ceased to be adequate, and classes were lengthened to sixteen or twenty weeks, or were followed by Intermediate and Advanced classes, still in an attempt to bring new dancers up to the present levels of the Clubs before taking them in. Inevitably, some of the classes danced together so long that they no longer wanted to join a Club--they were a Club, and as soon as they graduated they got a Caller of their own. And others dropped off somewhere along the line, having decided that they never would get to be Square Dancers.

I think the time has come to re-examine the whole theory of 'learning' to square dance. Square Dancing used to be a simple game, like croquet, and once you had been told the rules, you went ahead and played. But now Square Dancing has become a lot more like learning a foreign language - you can take French courses in school, and learn grammar and some of the vocabulary, but you can't learn to speak it or understand it without a lot of practice. Just learning the vocabulary of Square Dancing today would take a beginner's whole time for several months, and by the time he had mastered a concept like 'ends will hinge', another new one would have been invented. At this rate, he would never catch up.

Now we come to the title subject of this article. High Level Dancers - and I consider myself one - are supposed to know all about Square Dancing. But how are they ever going to get new people to dance with, if beginners can't do 'Riptide', we are in effect complaining that there are some calls we know and they don't. Since teachers can't teach everything, maybe we ought to ask ourselves whether we would prefer new dancers to know 'the Old Mill Wheel' or 'Dixie Chain'. Shall we start everyone from scratch, and make them go thru the same things we went thru, or shall we forget the old and concentrate on the new?

Well, after considerable thought on the subject, some of us have decided that neither of these extremes is very important. If we could have our choice, we would ask for new dancers who could always be counted on to turn their partners in a Right and Left Thru, who could do a Do-paso from any angle and always find their new corners, and who had learned to listen and to react to each call. Once they had really mastered the most basic Basics, we would like to see them turned loose to dance at Clubs and Hoedowns, with some sort of sign on them that said in effect 'I am a New Dancer -- help me!' Perhaps a green ribbon, like the First Timers wear at Asilomar, would do. The point is, if you know that a certain couple in the square is new, and would welcome a little friendly direction, you can do a lot for them, without waiting for them to make mistakes. And if they have a solid background of basic maneuvers, the 'gimmicks' will cause only momentary confusion, and a little shove will do the work.

I can see the skeptics right now, asking, 'Who would walk up and dance with a couple wearing green ribbons, at a Hoedown? People would avoid them like the plague!' All I can say is, the very ones who would avoid them are the same ones who would be no help to them anyhow, and who might even discourage them permanently. Speaking for myself, there is nothing I like better than dancing with really new dancers -- people who are still in the process of becoming Square Dancers, and who really want to learn. I think we have all had the experience of offering help where it was not appreciated, and finding out that that couple we had never seen before had been dancing for several years and didn't think they had anything more to learn. To a real High Level Dancer, all new dancers are Prospects, to be encouraged and cultivated, until it becomes apparent whether or not they will ever make the grade and become real Square Dancers.

After a year, though, I'd take their green ribbons away from them. By then they ought to be able to stand on their own feet and defend themselves. -- Or, on second thought, perhaps they should be allowed to wear their ribbons as long as they themselves felt that they wanted help. What do you think?

Dear Sirs:

We just received our first copy, the December issue, of Square Dance--**WHERE?**, and I have a bone to pick. In the middle of page 19, quote--'still see a lot of back-lashing in the area. Sure wish we could discourage this annoying mannerism for all time.' -- Just what is so annoying about back-lashing?

I happen to be one that likes back-lashing and would like to find out what all the squawk is against back-lashing. I have tried to find someone that would give me a reasonable answer as to why a person shouldn't back-lash. Some of the answers I have had I can't agree with. One was, a person can break an arm back-lashing. I think that is silly. A person can break a leg square-dancing, too, as far as that goes. I think it should be up to the individual as to whether they want to back-lash or not. If you want to stop all the whirling and just walk around in a circle, why dance at all?

I find a number of (things) that annoy me. For instance, in a grand-right and left, a couple will switch the directions they are supposed to go and go the opposite directions-which can foul the whole square. Where as back-lashing doesn't foul a square at all. Another mannerism I think is annoying is yelling and shouting on the part of some dancers to where the call cannot be heard.

Whose idea was this that back-lashing is so annoying, anyway? Was it someone that is so broken-down that they can't back-lash, or whose? If a person is afraid they will get an arm broken let them stay home by the fireside where they belong.

I still think it should be up to the individual as to whether they should back-lash or not. It doesn't hurt anyone else and until I get a good enough reason as to why a person shouldn't back-lash, and this is still a free country I remain
