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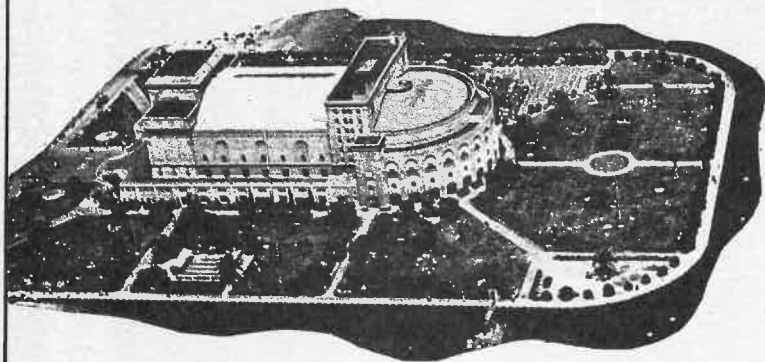

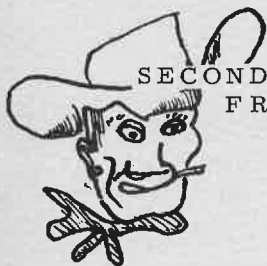

It is the first down-to-earth manual of this sort ever printed. and then go out to Hoedowns and have a good time? Better look at the alternatives before you throw him overboard.

Finally, after all your efforts, you still say you want to fire your caller. Then, do it. Soften it as much as you can, and give him some way to 'save face', if possible, and try to keep everything friendly, but let him go. Don't let the club slowly die, in order to save his feelings. After all, callers are more expendable than good clubs, and whatever a caller may say, you are not 'his' dancers, no matter if he did find you and teach you and promote the club. Slavery was outlawed in this country years ago. Maybe the P.A. system is his, and the lease of the hall, and maybe even the name of the club, but the square dancers belong to themselves. Don't be afraid to make your own decisions.

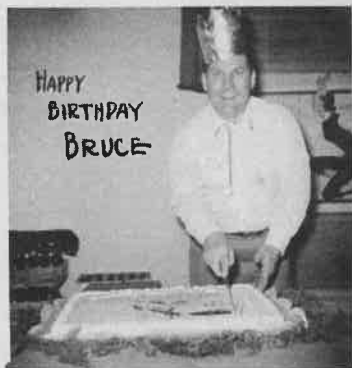

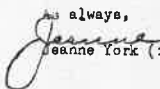
Dear Ed:
