Newly elected president of the Northern Calif. Callers Assn, GENE WARD is well qualified to cope with the problems confronting an organization of this kind. GENE is also Publication Secretary of the Dancers Assn. of No. Calif., Callers Workshop, no small job in itself.

In 1949 while Folk Dancing, CAROLYN & GENE joined BETTY GRASS' Beginner square dance class in San Leandro - this class later became the San Leandro GRASSHOPPERS. It was BETTY GRASS who talked GENE into square dance calling, opening a new way of life - GENE & Taw CAROLYN are presently busy four nites a week. Caller for two classes with the San Leandro Rec. Dept., the KNOLLITE SHUFFLERS, ODDS & ENDS (Primarily a Singles group) and the GRASSHOPPERS -- GENE presents his viewpoint thusly:

"Distances meant nothing where square dancing was concerned. Later on, when experience showed us that a feeder class was necessary to support clubs with members due to attrition rate, six clubs combined their square dance prospects into one class, teaching them for six months. The club caller would teach the first three months, and I was selected to teach the second three months.

CAROLYN and I have traveled from San Diego, to Canada and Hawaiian Islands, where we have danced and I have called in large cities and small towns, and have found square dancers all the same-Wonderful. All in all dancing is the way of expressing happiness, which in turn develops a sound mind and healthy body. Square dancing is a glorious activity, and CAROLYN and I are proud to be able to take a small part in this movement."

(Well said, GENE!)

HAPPY POLKA

Record: Sunny Hills AC 111 S0
Position: Skaters
Footwork: Identical throughout (start L for both)
Intro: 2 meas. WAIT
Measures:

Part A

- 1-4 HEEL, -, SNAP BACK, -; STEP,CLOSE,STEP,-; HEEL,-,SNAP BACK,
-; STEP, CLOSE, STEP, -;
Place L heel diag fwd to L bending R knee slightly, snap
ball of L ft bk and across in front of R; Take one two-
step diag fwd to L; Repeat all with R ft.
- 5-8 LADY IN; STEP, CLOSE, STEP, -; GENT FOLLOW; STEP,CLOSE,STEP,
-;
Retain hold of L hands, M does 2 two-steps in place as W
swings into COH in front of M with 2 two-steps to face RL
OD; W continues around with 2 more two-steps to face LOD
as M follows her in 2 two-steps making a full L-face turn
to resume skaters position.

- 9-16 Repeat Meas. 1-8.

Part B

- 17-20 IN, -, 2, -; 3, -, KICK, -; TURN R, -, 2, -; 3, -, TOUCH, -;
In skaters pos. walk diag fwd into COH L,R,L, kick R fwd;
Release hands, both take solo R-face full turn diag bk to
place R,L,R, touch L to R into skaters facing LOD.
- 21-24 TWO-STEP L; TWO-STEP R; TWO-STEP L; TWO-STEP R;
Do 4 fwd two-steps going in and out slightly.

- 25-32 Repeat Meas. 17-24

BUT on last two-step W takes $\frac{1}{2}$ R-face turn retaining hold
of R hands.

Part C

- 33-36 WALK, -,2,-; 3,-, SWING,-; ROLL ACROSS, -,2,-;3,-,SWING,-;
In R-hand star, M walk fwd (W bwd) L,R,L, swing R fwd;
Both roll across full R-face turn changing sides (W: XIF)
joining L hands.

- 37-40 TWO-STEP FWD; TWO-STEP TO SIDE; TWO-STEP FWD;
In L-hand star, W on M's L side but slightly ahead, M
takes 2 two-steps fwd (W bwd); Then change sides with one
two-step to side (L for both), W: XIF of M; Rejoin R
hands and take one two-step fwd. M is facing LOD - W is
facing RLOD through Meas. 33-40.

- 41-48 Repeat Meas 33-40

BUT on last two-step W does a $\frac{1}{2}$ R-face solo turn into sk-
aters.

DANCE ENTIRE DANCE THRU 3 TIMES

ENDING: On last two-step face partner, join MBs R and W's L hands
step back R, Step back L, pt R fwd.

TEACHING NOTE: Part B and Part C: The steps are the same but are
done in a different position.

Caught in the Riptide

ALLEN



At the last Association Stampede, we had the spectacle of a whole floor of better-than-average dancers being thrown for a loop by a call nearly ten years old, a real 'standard' of modern square dancing -- none other than my old friend 'Riptide.' According to an observer on the side lines, only four sets got thru it. Judging by experience, I would say that the rest of the dancers fell into three main categories -- those who could have done it if they had known it was 'Riptide' (or so they say), those who could have done it if the others in the set had known it, and a whole lot of dancers who just did not know what had hit them. BOB RUFF says he threw it in to see what would happen, and he found out! It seems that our average dancer, here in the Bay Area, although he probably knows more new calls than anyone anywhere, and is at least as skillful at following all sorts of tricky stuff, still can't do 'Riptide.' Why not? Obviously, he has not been taught how.

I realize that 'Riptide' is not the only thing not being taught today. There are dozens of non-directional oldtimers, like 'Take a ride on the trolley', that are being forgotten, and rightly so. There are other good calls that were done to death when they were new, and dropped for that reason, to be revived later -- an example might be the 'Jesse Polka Square.' But to my mind 'Riptide' is one of the best squares ever written, it has never dropped from favor in those areas where it is really understood, and it deserves to stand with such all-time favorites as 'Dip and Dive' or 'Right hand over, left hand under', but on a slightly more advanced level of dancing. Unfortunately, not every dancer can get to Asilomar and learn it from BOB OSGOOD, so if the local callers won't teach it, maybe I'll have to do it myself. So here goes;

FIRST AND THIRD GO FORWARD AND BACK

THEN STAR BY THE RIGHT ON THE INSIDE TRACK

These first two lines are very important. That phrase, 'the inside track', is a tip-off to those in the know that 'Riptide' is about to be called. It may lead into some other square, of course, but if you hear it, be on your toes.

TURN YOUR CORNER WITH A LEFT HAND SWING

AND BOX THE GNAT IN THE MIDDLE OF THE RING

Here is the first 'area of difficulty'. The calls are directed to the first and third couples only, since they are active, but after that left hand swing, the sides feel as if they were active too, and they will try to box the gnat with someone, instead of staying put. This is the only real weakness in the original call -- if the wording were something like 'Heads box the gnat at home', there would be no excuse for confusion. (Of course, it would not sound as well, either.) Except for this spot, the call is entirely directional, believe it or not.

THEN PASS RIGHT BACK TO THE SIDE OF THE TOWN

If you boxed the gnat correctly, you are now facing your partner holding right hands -- so pass right shoulders, back, like the man says, to the side where you came from -- to your corner.

FOR A DOS-A-DOS, GO ALL THE WAY 'ROUND

This is the second area of difficulty, but there is no excuse for this one. A true dos-a-dos is back-to-back, with no turns -- you face the person you are going to dos-a-dos, and all the time you are going around him you are facing the same wall. The heads are facing out, and the sides are facing in, and they stay that way.

LIKE AN OCEAN WAVE YOU HANG ON TIGHT

If you really went 'all the way 'round', you would be ready to pass right shoulders with the same person again, which is correct. You step forward into the ocean wave, and the ladies are in the middle, as they should be, and the heads are still facing out.

GO FORWARD AND BACK, THEN SWING BY THE RIGHT

SAME COUPLES STAR BY THE OLD LEFT WIND

TO THE OPPOSITE SHORE WITH A RIGHT HAND SWING

Perfectly directional -- any time you star to your opposite, from two lines of four, it means diagonally opposite.

GO BACK TO THE MIDDLE AND BOX THE FLEA
THEN PASS RIGHT BACK TO THE SIDE OF THE SEA
AND SEESAW 'ROUND 'EM, ALL THE WAY ROUND
AND YOU MAKE THAT WAVE WHEN YOU COME DOWN

If you remember that 'box the flea' and 'seesaw' are both left hand figures, you have it made. This time the ocean wave is the other way around -- if you seesaw all the way around, you are ready to pass left shoulders again, so you line up that way, which puts the men in the middle.

GO FORWARD AND BACK, THEN SWING BY THE LEFT
AND THE SAME COUPLES STAR IN THE CENTER OF THE SET

Notice that this star is a right hand star, while the last one was a left hand star. The call does not say that, but the general rule of using alternate hands covers the situation.

GO TO YOUR CORNER FOR A LEFT ALLEMANDE
RIGHT TO YOUR HONEY FOR A RIGHT AND LEFT GRAND

Here is where the sides become active too - the heads can't do a right and left grand alone!

Simple, wasn't it? Just remember which couples are active, and that they stay that way. Remember to do your basic figures simply and accurately. Remember that the first ocean wave puts the ladies in the middle, and the second one the men. And especially, remember that if you hear 'Star by the right on the inside track', you may be about to do 'Riptide.' Then the next time a visiting caller decides to see what will happen, maybe we'll make a little better showing.
