THREE O'CLOCK WALTZ

By Kay and Forrest Richards, San Leandro, California

Record: "Three O'Clock in the Morning"—S1.0.3100.

Position: Open, inside hands joined, facing LOD.

Footwork: Opposite throughout. Directions are given for the M.

Measures

- 1-4** **Waltz Away, 2, Close; Together, 2, Close; Banjo Around, 2, 3; Face, Touch, —;**
Starting M's L, progressing fwd in LOD, waltz slightly away from partner; Waltz in to face partner; Assume **butterfly pos** and with R hips adjacent, walk around partner $\frac{1}{2}$ CW turn in 3 steps LRL (This puts M on outside of circle); Partners facing, M's back to wall (W's back to COH): Step R in place and touch L beside R and hold 1 ct.
- 5-8** **Balance Apart, Touch, —; Solo Turn, 2, Close; Around, 2, Close; Step, Touch, —;**
Partners facing, M's back to wall, release M's R and W's L hands (keep others joined) and step slightly bwd on L, touch R to L and hold 1 ct; Turning away (M to R, W to L) from each other, progressing in LOD, starting M's R, do 1 full solo waltz turn in 6 steps (2 meas); Assume **butterfly pos** and step R in place, touch L beside R, hold 1 ct.
- 9-12** **Waltz Bal L; Waltz Bal R; Change Sides, 2, 3; Step, Touch, —;**
M's back to wall, step L to side along RLOD, step R behind L, step L in place; Repeat waltz bal starting R along LOD; Change sides in 3 steps, W turning R and crossing under her R and M's L arms (partners are now facing, M's back to COH); Reassume **butterfly pos** and step R to side along RLOD, touch L beside R, hold 1 ct.
- 13-16** **Waltz Bal L; Waltz Bal R; Twirl, 2, 3; Face, Touch, —;**
Butterfly pos, M's back to COH, repeat action of Meas 9-10; Then while M walks fwd 3 steps LRL in LOD, W makes a R-face twirl in 3 steps RLR under M's L and her R arm; Assume **loose-closed pos**, M's back to COH, step R in place, touch L beside R, hold 1 ct.
- 17-20** **(Grapevine): Side, Behind, Side; Cross, Touch, —; Step, Draw, —; Step, Touch, —;**
Starting M's L, grapevine along LOD: Step L to side, step R behind L, step L to side; Cross R in front of L, touch L beside R and hold 1 ct; Step L to side along LOD, draw R to L turning body slightly (retain wt on L); Step R to side along RLOD, touch L beside R, and hold 1 ct.
- 21-24** **(Grapevine): Side, Behind, Side; Cross, Touch, —; Step, Draw, —; Step, Touch, —;**
Still progressing in LOD, repeat action of Meas 17-20, ending in **semi-closed pos**, facing LOD.
- 25-28** **Waltz Forward, 2, Close; Waltz Forward, 2, Close; Step, Swing, —; W/Turn, 2, 3;**
Starting M's L, do 2 forward waltzes, semi-closed pos, in LOD; Then, step fwd L, swing R slightly fwd, and hold 1 ct; Then, while M steps slightly bwd RLR, W turns $\frac{1}{4}$ L-face to face M as partners assume **closed pos**, M facing LOD.
- 29-32** **Balance Bwd; Waltz (R); Waltz; Twirl;**
Starting M's L, balance bwd in RLOD; Starting M's R, do 2 meas of R-face turning waltzes; Then, as M walks fwd in LOD 3 steps RLR, W twirls R-face under M's L and her R arm LRL. End in **open pos** to repeat dance.
Entire Dance is done **three times** in all.

Note: This dance emphasizes R-face turning waltz with R ft. lead.

THE HURRICANE SIGNALS ARE UP

Feeling tired and run-down lately? Have to sit one out occasionally? Wish the squares weren't quite so long? Well, if this means you, cheer up. It isn't you at all. The fact is, some of our best and best-known callers around here have been undermining our self-confidence by speeding up the tempo on us. Not raising the Level -- that is not the same thing. They have simply been shoving ahead the little dingbat on the turntable, so that the record runs faster and faster. Then all they have to do is to say the same old words they have said all along, but say them at a higher pitch to keep up with the music, and they can sit back after the dance, while everyone is mopping brows and panting, and listen to those who don't know any better, saying to each other, "Boy! Old So-and-so is hotter 'n a firecracker tonight!" This gives the caller an illusion of being better than he really is, and the dancer the illusion that he must be having a swell time, or he wouldn't be so pooped. Unfortunately, it also gives him a lot of other things, including everything from sore feet to heart failure. And the lift it gives is only temporary, at best -- like any other drug, the effect wears off, and leaves you just plain tired.

Most of the victims of this sort of insidious speed-up don't realize what is the matter, or aren't sure. But me -- I am sure. I wear a watch with a sweep-second hand, and if I find that my feet are moving faster and faster, as I get farther and farther behind the calls, I sit one out and count. I have made a little mental chart of metronome beats per minute, by counting up records at home, and comparing notes with the best callers I know, and here it is: Under 128 -- Too slow, except for singing calls

128 - 132 -- Slow, but danceable

132 - 136 -- GOOD!

136 - 140 -- Fast, but good occasionally

140 and over - Too darn fast

When I have counted up the beats per minute, I decide whether I know the caller well enough to tell him. Invariably, when I do, the answer is "Oh no! Not that fast!" But, oh yes! I counted it. Then the answer goes on, almost always, "You know, I don't like to call this fast myself, but my Club insists on it." There are several good answers to that one, but here are two of them. In the first place, is it your whole Club, or one or two loud-mouths who sound like more? And if it is your whole Club, you'd better take the hint - what they really mean is that you are boring them to death, the way you are calling, and they want more excitement - and not being callers themselves, the only thing they know enough to ask for is more speed. Really good callers can produce all the excitement anyone could want without adding one beat per minute - they can make your feet go right on tracking around that ring, at a reasonable speed, while your head is in a whirl and you are yipping with joy. But it is harder.

So far, I have been talking about tempo - the speed of the record the caller is using. There is another sort of speed, maybe not as killing, but even more frustrating, which is known as timing - and this concerns the number of beats, or steps, the caller allows you in which to do each movement. I do not belong to the school of thought that wants to allow eight beats for a Ladies Chain, eight for a Right and Left Thru, and so on - those numbers, while traditional, are no longer realistic, the way we dance. But good callers do give their dancers a sporting chance, by allowing them enough beats so that if they never hesitate, or make any wrong moves, or fall asleep when it is their turn to move, they can still do everything he tells them to do without having to take two steps to one beat of music. To fail to do this is simply the badge of an incompetent caller - and it is a tribute to the general excellence of our Bay Area callers that we very seldom suffer from this particular trouble any more.

To those young and athletic dancers who may be inclined to pooh-pooh this whole problem of speed, and ask why they should not dance fast if they like it that way, I'd like to say that they simply don't know their Square Dance his-

tory. This same cycle has occurred in almost every Square Dance area, and every time it has been followed by a decline in square dancing as a whole, and a dropping-off of clubs and callers who insisted on it. Some dancers quit dancing entirely, others changed to more sensible callers, and the hardy few who really could dance at that speed night after night could not dance alone. So far, the Bay Area has been able to avoid most of the excesses that plagued the Los Angeles area, and our square dance movement has grown slowly and steadily, in a healthy fashion. For this reason, it is a matter of concern to a lot of us, to try to wake people up to the dangers of the cry for more speed. Instead, try crying for better calling and better dancing -- there is no limit to the challenge that can be had without increasing the speed. But it takes both better dancers and better callers to raise the Level of the Club than to move up that little Lever on the turntable.

Last quarterly meeting of the Associated Square Dancers of Superior Calif. was held at the Easter Seal Society rehabilitation center with nearly all clubs represented.
