NEWS FLASH ON SEVENTH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION....

The Seventh Annual National Square Dance Convention will be held June 19, 20, 21, 1958 in Louisville, Kentucky, according to DICK FLUCKE, Mission, Kansas, chairman of the Executive Committee.

Sponsored by the Kentuckiana (Kentucky, Indiana) Square Dance Association the Convention will be held in the new Coliseum of the Kentucky Exposition Center. The main auditorium in this building offers 33640 square ft. of dance space while seating 14,600 at the same time. Only the Atlantic City Auditorium exceeds it for size. In addition there are many other halls and committee rooms allowing ample space for all Convention activities. Geared to housing and feeding Kentucky Derby crowds, Louisville offers many hotels, motels and eating establishments that are sure to feed and house the multitudes of Square Dancers to their liking.

JAMES GLOOR, 3109 Chickadee Road, Louisville, is president of the Kentuckiana Association, sponsors of the Convention. ED served as chairman of the Convention Investigation Committee.

Site of the Eighth Convention was announced at St. Louis. It will be held May 28, 29, 30, 1959, in the Denver, Colorado, Municipal Auditorium.

With the announcement of the 1958 site, HOWARD THORNTON, 2936 Bella Vista Midwest City, Oklahoma, assumes chairmanship of the National Convention Executive committee. Dance of the Month

PENNY TWO-STEP

By Rose & Penny Crispino, Nampa, Idaho

RECORD: "Penny Two-Step" - Black Mountain - 1015

POSITION: Varsouvianna, facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Same throughout. Both start L

INTRODUCTION: Wait 4 meas.

MEAS:

- 1 - 4 WALK, 2; SIDE BEHIND, SIDE BRUSH; WALK, 2; SIDE BEHIND, SIDE BRUSH;
Walk fwd L, R; Both do grapevine to left with side-behind-side brushing R ft fwd; Walk fwd R, L; Both do grapevine to right with side-behind-side brushing L ft fwd.
- 5 - 8 REPEAT MEAS. 1-4;
- 9 - 12 STEP CLOSE, PIVOT/POINT; STEP CLOSE, PIVOT/POINT; STEP CLOSE, STEP; STEP CLOSE, STEP;
One two-step fwd starting L ft, both pivoting on 3rd step 1/2 R-face turn and point R ft RLOD; One two-step fwd in RLOD starting R ft both pivoting on 3rd step 1/2 L-face turn and point L ft LOD; 2 two-steps fwd L, R, L; R, L, R.
- 13 - 16 REPEAT MEAS 9-12. End in butterfly pos, M's back to COH.
- 17 - 20 SIDE BEHIND, SIDE BRUSH; SIDE BEHIND, SIDE BRUSH; TURN CLOSE, STEP BRUSH; TURN CLOSE, STEP BRUSH;
Both grapevine to the left; L-behind-L-brush R; Repeat grapevine to right brushing L; Each do one individual two-step R-face turning 1/4 L, R, L, brush R crossing line of dance going back-to-back with partner; Continue with another 1/4 R-face turning two-step R, L, R, brush L to end in butterfly pos, M's back to wall.
- 21 - 24 REPEAT MEAS 17-20, except in last meas, come into Vars pos. facing LOD.
- 25 - 28 WALK, 2; STEP CLOSE, STEP; WALK, 2; STEP CLOSE, STEP;
Both walk fwd L, R; One two-step fwd for M while W makes 1/2 R-face turn L, R, L to face RLOD in R-hand star with partner; Both walk in LOD (W backing up) R, L; One two-step fwd for M while W makes 1/2 R-face turn to resume Vars. pos.
- 29 - 32 REPEAT MEAS 25-28.

DANCE IS DONE THREE TIMES IN ALL.

ENDING: Walk 4 steps and B & C.

"Arky Style" - or, Who's My Partner Now?

First, your partner was the girl you brought to the dance. Then, your partner was the girl you started the square with, or the one you got after one change, when you promenaded a new lady home. But now we change partners so fast that there are times when you really don't have any partner at all, and other times when your guess would be as good as mine. Up until very recently, you would have been pretty safe in saying that you could always consider the girl on your right at any given time as your temporary partner, but these days you can't even say that. There are now several sorts of situations where your partner is the lady on your left.

One such situation is the Arky figure, where the girls and the men have changed places. The original "Arky Star" was a switch on the familiar "Texas Star", only instead of having the four men go into the center, star once around, and pick up their partners, they had the head gents and their corner girls form the star. Now, when these four picked up their partners, two couples were half-sashayed. This was very daring, because two men now had their partners on their left, and right away it opened the door to a rash of Arky figures. As long as the half-sashayed couple was still a couple, and working together, there was no problem, and if the call came, 'Break that star and swing your partner,' everyone knew what to do. The same was true of calls like 'First and third do a half-sashay, Lead on out to the right that way.' But then we get an Arky Square Thru, and that is tougher, because the man's and lady's parts of a Square Thru are different. In the call 'Head gents and your corner girls, Go up to the center and back, Now Square Thru -' and so on, the men actually have to walk the lady's path, turning left each time instead of right, and he feels that something is wrong. It is not wrong - only 'Arky'!

But notice - you remain an Arky couple only as long as you are acting as a single couple. In the call, 'Head gents and your corner girls, Up to the center and back, Now circle four just once around, California Twirl -', things have changed. The moment you started to circle - whether it was in fours or eights - you got a new partner, the girl on your right in the circle. As a California Twirl is done with your partner, you drop that original corner girl you had for an Arky partner, and Twirl the other girl. Clear as mud?

Here is another problem situation, with a different solution. In the call, 'Pass thru, face your partner, Pass thru, face your partner,' you know who to face each time, because you have just passed thru with a lady beside you - your partner at the time. But now try this. 'First and third go forw'd and back, with your opposite box the gnat, Face your partner -' what then? Did that 'Box the Gnat' change things? You are now facing the girl you boxed the gnat with, so your original partner is now on your left. Have you become an Arky couple, or is the girl you boxed the gnat with already your new partner, as she would be if you circled from there? If so, you are already facing her, so there is no need for the call. So it must mean your original girl. But there is enough ground for confusion here so that most callers would say, instead, 'Face the middle', which means to make a quarter turn and face the other middle - in this case, face your original partner. This is just a way of dodging the issue.

Of course, one obvious place where your partner is on your left is in an Allemande Thar position - you have left forearms joined with her. The ruling that that girl is your partner is rather arbitrary, and is based on the theory that if you get sufficiently involved with a girl, you do the decent thing and consider her your partner, as in a Swing, a Promenade, or a Circle, (Besides, in 'Throw in the Clutch' calls, you have to know who to come back to, and goodness knows where your original partner is by now.)

But if you want to start a real argument, among any group of people who call or write squares, ask them who is your partner in a circle facing out. I have argued that question so many times that right now I not only don't know which way it was decided the last time, but I can't even remember which way I was arguing. All I know is that there are two opposite points of view, and both sides are sure they are right. Any Suggestions?
