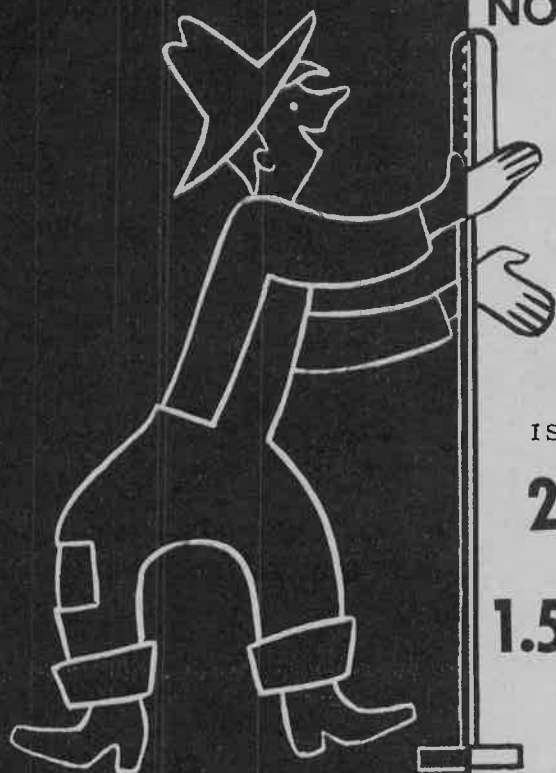

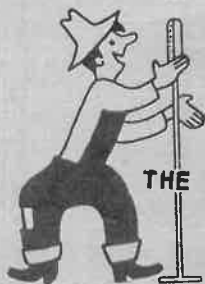

 FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout
 MEASURES: INTRODUCTION

1 - 4 WAIT 2 MEASURES: BALANCE APART; BALANCE TOGE
 With M's R & W's L hands joined, balance apart on L;
 gether on R to assume closed pos with M facing LOD.

LET'S GO SQUARE THRU

by MADELINE ALLEN

I imagine that if you called a SQUARE THRU anywhere in the Bay Area today, practically every dancer would start across with right hand extended. And if you went on with the patter, 'Right, Left, Right you do -' and so on, they'd keep on going until they reached home again. But if you stopped at that point, and told everyone to stay where they were and not to move or turn, what would you see? My guess is that you would see practically everything, and most of it would be wrong. Most dancers seem to have a general idea of what a SQUARE THRU is, but they are still not being taught, or at any rate not learning, that a 'general idea' is not enough. The only real point of calling a SQUARE THRU at all is that it is a square figure - every part is done with exactness, and if any part of it is called alone, such as a HALF SQUARE THRU or SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS ROUND, that also is exact. There is a right way to be facing at the end of each part of a SQUARE THRU, and no other way will do.

Actually, all that patter is just filler. If the caller says 'One and Three go Square Thru', he means the whole thing. One and Three give right hands to their opposites, pull them by, and turn to face their original partners. They give left hands to them, and pull them by. At this point they have done a HALF SQUARE THRU. But they don't stop here. They turn to face their original opposites, give right hands to them, and pull them by. They have now done a THREE QUARTER SQUARE THRU. Then they turn to face partners again, give them their left hands, and pull them by. The SQUARE THRU is not complete until you have pulled your original partner by with the left hand, and stand back to back with her. You do not face the set, or Courtesy Turn your partner, or stand facing her with left hands joined. If the call was a plain SQUARE THRU, you do all of that, and end back to back with the partner you started with, on the same spot on the floor, but facing your original corner. Incidentally, you now have a new partner, the lady on your right as you stand there -- your original opposite lady.

In doing fractions of a SQUARE THRU, the important thing to remember is that the pull by is the last thing you do, not the turn. Thus in a HALF SQUARE THRU, you go Right, Left, pull her by, and stop. You are now back to back with your original partner, just as if you had done the whole thing, but you are only halfway around the square - on the opposite side, and facing a new corner. If you do a THREE QUARTER SQUARE THRU, you do Right, Left, Right, and pull her by - and you are standing in home position, but facing out, with your partner on your right, just as if you had done a California Twirl from your original position.

Remember that the SQUARE THRU, like the DIXIE CHAIN, starts with the Right hand, unless the caller specifically says, 'LEFT SQUARE THRU', in which case you start with the same person, but with the left hand. The patter now goes 'Left, Right, Left, Right to your partner, pull her by -', and you are ready for a Left hand figure next.

Remember, also, that SQUARE THRU, like CROSS TRAIL THRU, can be done by any two people facing any other two people -- unlike RIGHT AND LEFT THRU, which requires a gent with a lady on his right. The person on the left plays the man's part, and turns right each time, while the one on the right acts the lady's part, and turns left. Just visualize a little square formed by the original four people, and walk around it. If the caller calls a SQUARE THRU from two lines of four, what he actually wants is two separate SQUARE THRUS, side by side, not one long RECTANGLE. Each four people must keep strictly to their own little square, and not let themselves get suckered in to going Along the Line, into the other square. Incidentally, you will notice that in this case, starting two parallel SQUARE THRUS from lines, you end up with four people facing each other in the center, and the other four facing out at the ends. Don't turn - it is up to the caller to get you out of it somehow. The beauty of all the forms of SQUARE THRU, from the point of view of the caller, is that they end in a certain, definite way, and you

can leave people there, walking, until you are ready to tell them to do something else.

There are two other variations of SQUARE THRU that you will probably not be hearing very much. One is the QUARTER SQUARE THRU - Right to your opposite, pull her by, stop - which is too short to be interesting, and is too much like a simple PASS THRU. The other is ALL FOUR COUPLES SQUARE THRU, which is just the opposite - too long. It works just like ALL FOUR COUPLES RIGHT AND LEFT THRU, but twice as far - you pass your partner across the set, and keep going until you get home, ending back to back with your partner, as usual. But in the process you have lost the essential feature of a SQUARE THRU - the squareness - and you are not really facing anyone, because the others have moved too. Speaking as one who uses figures in dances, I'd say that this maneuver has little if any future.

As of right now, this completes the story of the SQUARE THRU. By next month there may be other forms - who can tell? Oh yes - I nearly forgot to say that the whole thing is the brain child of BILL HANSEN, from down South, who has been keeping us all jumping for some time with his original figures. Thanks, Bill!
