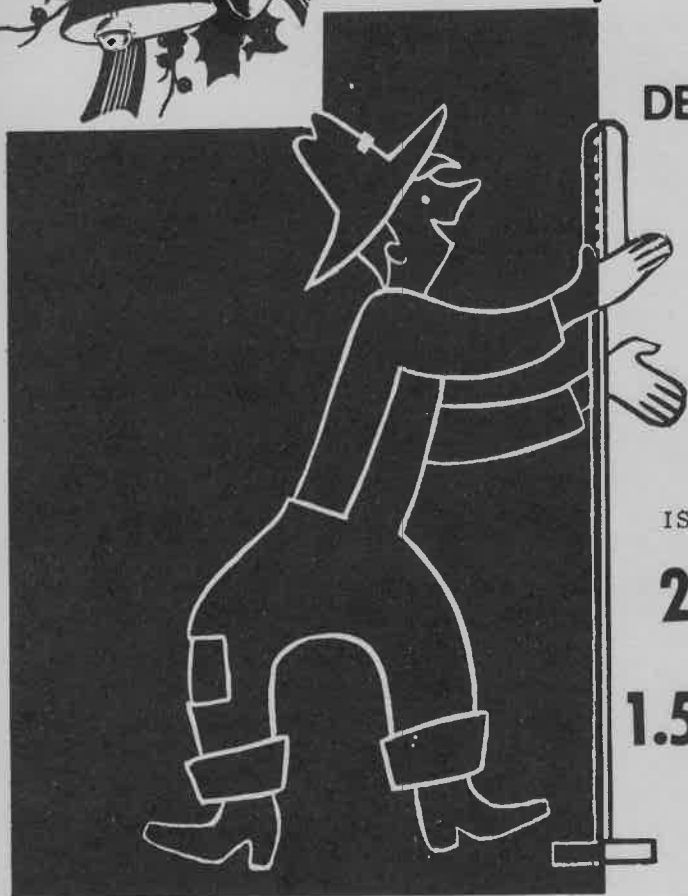

# Round

## *Dance of the Month*

TENNESSEE TWO-STEP  
By MANNING & NITA SMITH  
College Station, Texas

RECORD: "Tennessee Two-Step" - Columbia 21518

POSITION: Open, inside hands joined, facing LOD

FOOTWORK: Opposite, directions to M

MEAS:

A

1-2 WALK, 2, 3, 4; TURN AWAY, 2, 3, 4;

In open pos. walk fwd 4 steps in LOD; M turns L-face and W turns R-face away from partner and walk around in a small circle and back to partner, join R hands.

3-4 RIGHT STAR (TWO-STEP), 2; 3, 4;

With R hands joined star once and a half around in 4 two-steps to end in open pos facing RLOD, inside hands joined.

5-8 Repeat all of above to end facing LOD in open pos.

B

9-10 WALK, 2, SIDE, BEHIND; ROLL, 2, 3, 4;

In open pos walk fwd in LOD with L, R, face partner and step to side in LOD on L, behind on R; Roll L-face (W rolls R-face) twd LOD with L, R, L, R, ending in closed pos.

11-12 TWO-STEP TURN, TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN, TWO-STEP TURN;

In closed pos do 4 turning two-steps.

13-16 Repeat Meas 9-12 in LOD ending in open pos.

C

17-18 WALK, 2, 3, STEP/STEP; BACK-UP, 2, 3, STEP/STEP;

In open pos walk fwd L, R, L, R, L; Back up R, L, R, L/R, ending facing partner, M's bk to COH, both hands released.

19-20 CHASE, 2, 3, STEP/STEP; BACK-UP, 2, 3, STEP/STEP;

M "chases" W twd wall with L, R, L, R/L; Then W "chases" M twd COH M walks bwd R, L, R, L/R; on the last step both turn to face RLOD.

21-24 Repeat Meas. 17-20 starting in RLOD and ending with partners facing LOD in open pos ready to dance the complete routine from the beginning.

DANCE SEQUENCE: A B C, A B C, A B through Meas 14 plus ending.

ENDING: TWO-STEP TURN, TWO-STEP TURN; TWIRL, 2, 3, BOW.

In closed pos do 2 turning two-steps; Then, while M walks fwd L, R, L, W makes one R-face twirl stepping R, L, R, both step back and bow.

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# Guest Callers - Why ?

I suppose that if your own Club Caller were the best Caller in the world -- I mean really, not just to you -- there would be no excuse for ever having Guest Callers. Obviously, any other Caller would be a come-down, and the Club would not like it. So you and your Caller would live happily ever after, and you would never dance to anyone else.

Luckily, there is very little danger of this situation ever occurring, for the simple reason that there is no 'best Caller in the world', by any standards, and there is very little agreement even among Club members on relative excellence. Obviously, most of the members of any Club like their own Caller, or they would not be members. But you can love your Caller dearly, and be loyal to the death, and still yearn for a change once in a while if only so that you will appreciate him more. And your Caller himself may yearn to get away occasionally, and dance to someone else, and relax from the effort of trying to have something new ready every week for the same old people. For undoubtedly, the keynote of modern square dancing is 'novelty'.

Now, there are Guest Callers and Guest Callers. The most usual system, here in the Bay Area, is for the Club to stick to its own Caller for the weekly Workshops, and then to have a Hoedown one Saturday a month, for which they hire a Guest Caller -- either alone or to share the program with their own Caller. This Caller is paid, and has the responsibility of running the dance, as directed by the Club. So far, everything is simple.

Then there is the Guest Caller who just drops in to dance, and who just happens to have his records with him. Now comes the problem -- shall he be asked to call? Who decides? Suppose the Club has heard him before, and never again would be too soon? Or suppose no one has ever heard him? Should we take a chance? Do we have to ask him? What if there are several strange Callers there -- do we have to ask all of them? These are all questions that we have been asked, by Clubs wanting to know what is right. So here is our opinion.

In the first place, the main object in planning a Square Dance of any sort is to give the dancers a good time. Dances are not planned for the benefit of Callers, to allow them to show off. So we say right off, you don't have to do anything about uninvited Callers. Take a vote, at a regular Club meeting, and find out how the majority of the members feel. Do they like to hear a lot of different Callers? Or do they feel cheated when the fellows they have paid do not call enough? Are there any particular Callers the Club does not want to hear? Maybe they would like to hear any Callers from a distance, but not local Callers. Or maybe they would like to ask one new Caller per party night, and no more. Anyway, whatever you decide, make it definite, and also decide who is to speak for the Club at the dance itself. Many a Guest Caller, hired for the evening by a strange Club, has been put on the spot by receiving conflicting orders during the evening from the Club President, the Program Chairman, and the Club's own Caller -- to say nothing of mere members who have ideas all their own.

There are two things to remember, however. One is, any Caller who comes to a dance only to get a chance to call, won't be missed if he does not come back. Any really good Caller, who gets a free evening and goes out dancing, would much rather be let alone so that he can dance -- it is a treat for him. But don't forget, either, the really new Caller, who may not have had a chance to call at a party before, and who really deserves a chance to be heard -- at least once. Giving new talent a break won't hurt the dancers, for once anyhow, and every dancer ought to be interested in developing a continuous supply of new Callers -- the chore of keeping up with modern calls is liable to wear the old ones out, but fast. So don't be too snooty to give a listen -- you may need that Caller, in a year or so.

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The third type of Guest Caller is the Caller who is a guest in the area -- the Travelling Caller. There again, the question always comes up -- should the Club go out on a limb and sponsor a Travelling Caller, at a high price, when the chances are he won't be a bit better than our own top Callers anyhow? The only answer I can give to this is, take a chance -- at least once. You don't ever have to have him again, if you don't like him. And he doesn't have to be better -- it is enough if he is different. There is that 'novelty' business again -- your own Caller tries to keep you interested by using new material all the time, but he very seldom uses an entirely new style -- in fact, he probably can't. And California Callers as a whole use a very similar style -- you don't realize how similar until you hear a few from other parts of the country. Try a Travelling Caller as you would try a Chinese or Mexican dinner -- fun once in a while, even if you still like steak better. Every different experience you have will make you a better Square Dancer, and a happier one.

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## *Square Dancers*

### AND THE MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM

In March of 1955 FRED ALLAN was asked by the Volunteer Department of the San Francisco Mental Health Society to put on a square dance at the monthly party in the San Francisco County Hospital's Psychopathic Ward. This was to have been a "one night" stand, because at that time the parties were handled on a month to month basis. Our group made such a hit with the patients, and we ourselves had so much enjoyment, that we were asked to take the monthly party on a regular basis.

Our first piece of equipment was a portable phonograph with no microphone or P. A. system. Later, Jack McKay loaned us his stand-by callers outfit and a small mike from his tape recorder. Fred received a great deal of help in staging these parties from material and suggestions, along with a considerable amount of time, given by Jack McKay, Bill Castner and Ed Kremers, for which we are deeply grateful. By gradual stages Fred acquired his own microphone and sound equipment.

Our group is unusual in that each member has earned his place in the club. For each monthly party we proselyted additional people who mixed with and danced with the patients. It was noticed each month that there were those who came time and time again, demonstrating their interest in this work and their desire to impart their love of folk, square and round dancing, and love of clean wholesome fun and good-fellowship to others. These "regulars" formed the original group and called themselves the "Sauare Rounders" in August, 1955, and FRED ALLAN was chosen by the group as its director and M. C. The charter members are: Fred & Dodie ALLAN, Amy & Gene LAJANNETTE, Grace & Bill LEWIN, Harry & Helen BAKER, Jerry & Gloria BERMAN, Lou MAGIDSON, Mayre NURMI and Val KRIZMAN. Those who have joined the group since then are: Tom & Ruby POTTINGER, Lyle & Edna TATMAN, Doreen McCURDY and Marge MELOY. Others who contributed to our group's success are: Dennis EVANS and Sophie & Gene HENSEN. Callers in the group are: Fred ALLAN, Tom POTTINGER, Amy LAJANNETTE, Lou MAGIDSON and Jerry BERMAN. Even though we are a comparatively small group we must of necessity remain that way, due to the fact that we can only bring a limited number of dancers to the hospital wards.

Besides these parties at the County Hospital, we have put on monthly parties for the Red Cross at Letterman General Hospital. All told, the group has a total of over 1800 volunteer hours to date. Occasionally the SQUARE ROUNDERS have had both volunteer fund-raising programs as well as paid engagements as an exhibition group. Any proceeds for paid engagements go into our treasury for operating expenses. Whenever there is a deficit it is made up pro-rata among the group.

The SQUARE ROUNDERS meet quarterly (oftener if necessary) for pot-luck get-togethers where we practice fun numbers and exhibitions which we present during intermissions at the hospital parties. We have had many letters from doctors, therapists and directors telling us how much the patients enjoy the parties and how they look forward each month to another party. In fact, the square and round dance programs are among the most popular forms of recreation in the mental health field. We would be very glad to help others who are interested in this type of program for mental patients.

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# Beaux & Belles- Woodland

S T O R Y

On any given night of square dancing at Willow Oak Hall in Woodland the thoughts of many members of the Woodland BEAUX & BELLES transgress, momentarily, to Pocatello, Idaho and Colorado Springs, Colorado in reminiscence of two square dance enthusiasts who contributed greatly toward furthering the cause of square dancing in this community.

For it is to these two towns that STAN DAY and RANDY EAKES, both callers, moved after establishing a foothold for square dancing in Woodland.

The "Oldtimers" among the group recall the gay times they enjoyed at Graco Hall in 1953 and '54 when STAN DAY contributed his calling, records, recording machine and a place to dance; and donated all the proceeds collected at his dances to worthwhile charities. And they feel saddened that it was while calling a square dance that he suffered the first of several heart attacks and reluctantly left square dancing for less strenuous pursuits.

And they also recall a period of little or no square dancing in Woodland because of the lack of a caller and an organized square dancing program.

It was at this time that a square dancing couple of the Graco Group WALLY and JUNE KIRKNESS, began travelling to Sacramento once or twice a week rather than give up the pleasure of square dancing.

As members of the Sacramento SQUARE WHEELERS, they soon met RANDY EAKES and learned that he was searching for a club to call to.

RANDY had called for several clubs in years past but had discontinued calling when his charming wife, MARY, had suffered an attack of polio. Now MARY was again squaring 'em up, and RANDY was brushing up old techniques.

So as usually happens when an unattached caller meets a restless square dancer, the BEAUX AND BELLES of Woodland were founded.

Now it was RANDY who was journeying several nights a week to Woodland to give unselfishly of his time and efforts until the new club got on its feet.

Under WALLY KIRKNESS' leadership (he maintains that it was his wife, JUNE, who did all the work) a class of 22 couples was soon graduated. Of these 22 couples, 16 couples are still active members of the group.

The officers of the new club were: WALLY KIRKNESS, JIM CRAYNE, BARBARA GILLMORE and MARGARET SCHNEIDER. More or less under the wing of the SQUARE WHEELERS, the club flourished; and the roster of guests at party nights testify that they had some mighty fine times. The club joined the Associated Square Dancers of Superior California and became active in the affairs of the Association. (The outgoing president of the club, JOE SCHNEIDER, is currently a member of the Board of Directors of the Association).

Late in the summer of 1956 RANDY EAKES was transferred to Colorado, and the BEAUX AND BELLES were again without a caller. However (and very fortunate for the club) IVAN HASBROUCK, caller for the LADS & LASSIES in North Highlands, agreed to fill in until a permanent caller could be located.

The club took to IVAN and his wife, MARIAN, like a duck takes to water. And they apparently liked the group, as IVAN has been "filling in" on a permanent basis for well over a year. His easy-going manner, rous-

ing calls and tactfulness in all instruction periods stimulated the new officers: JOESCHNEIDER, RALPH GILLMORE, DOUG McWILLIAMS and OL-ETA WADEMAN to a zealous recruiting campaign, and when they finished their term in office, the club roster boasted a total of 85 square dancing couples.

The first words of the bylaws of the BEAUX AND BELLES contain the key to the success of square dancing in Woodland; and the recently elected officers: RALPH GILMORE, WAYNE GUFFIN, DONNA HALTERMAN, PEG GIGER, HUGH HART and NELL WHITWORTH, affirm that these words will be always first in their thoughts -- THE PURPOSE OF THIS CLUB IS TO HAVE FUN WHILE SQUARE DANCING!
