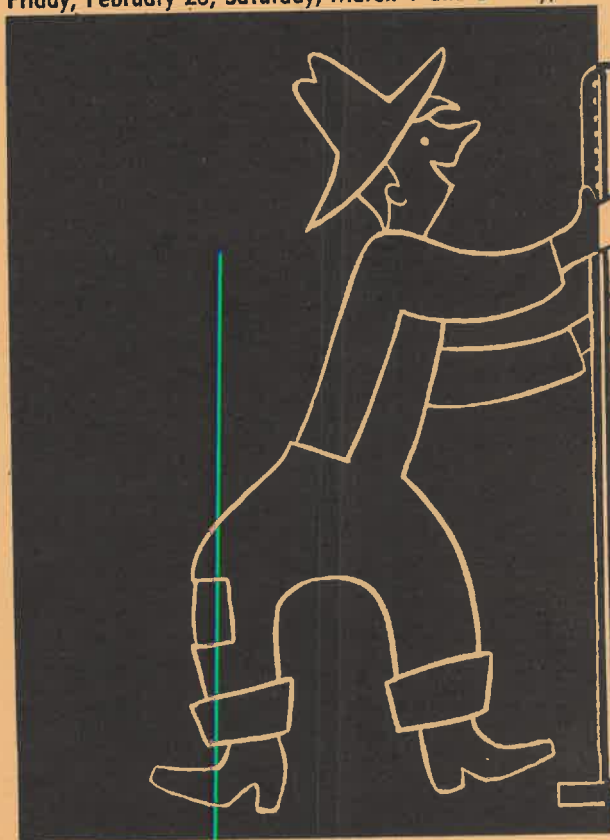

Dance of the Month

AIN'T SHE SWEET
By RUTH & DUD GRAHAM, Castro Valley, California

RECORD: S. I. O. 3103
 POSITION: Open, facing LOD - Inside hands joined
 FOOTWORK: Opposite - Directions for M
 INTRO: Wait 2 meas. Step apart (face partner), touch; Step together, touch (face LOD)

MEASURES

- 1-4 WALK, 2; FACE, POINT; CROSS OVER, 2; FACE, TOUCH;
 Walk slightly diag away from partner L, R, (keeping inside hands joined); Step fwd on L turning to face partner and point R twd partner; Do California Twirl (W turning L-face under her own L and M's R arm) facing partner on 3rd step and touch, i.e., R, L; R, touch L by R; Assume BUTTERFLY POS M's bk to wall
- 5-8 BAL L/2, 3/-; BAL R/2, 3/-; TURN AWAY, 2; 3, 4;
 Step L to side (RLOD), step R in back of L, step L in place; Step R to side (LOD) step L in back of R, step R in place; Turn away from partner (M to L, W to R) travelling in RLOD with a four step turn L, R, L, R, ending in OPEN POS facing RLOD.
- 9-12 WALK, 2; FACE, POINT; CROSS OVER, 2; FACE, TOUCH;
 Repeat Meas 1-4, travelling in RLOD.
- 13-16 BAL L/2, 3/-; BAL R/2, 3/-; TURN AWAY, 2; 3, 4;
 Repeat Meas 5-8 traveling in LOD on turn away, ending in LOOSE-CLOSED POS, M's back to COH.
- 17-20 SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, FRONT; STEP, BRUSH; STEP, TOUCH;
 Step L to side (LOD), step R behind L; Step L to side, step R across in front of L; Step L to side dropping leanding hands (M's L - W's R) and turning to face LOD in semi-open pos, brush R ft fwd; Step back on R (RLOD) again assuming loose-closed pos and touch L by R.
- 21-24 SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, FRONT; STEP, BRUSH; STEP, TOUCH;
 Repeat Meas. 17-20 ending in CLOSED POS, M's back to COH.
- 25-28 SIDE, CLOSE; FWD, TOUCH SIDE, CLOSE; BACK TOUCH;
 (Box two-step): Step to side (LOD) on L, close R to L; Step fwd (twd wall) on L, touch R by L; Step R to side (RLOD) close L to R; Step back on R (twd COH) touch L by R; turning to face LOD in SEMI-CLOSED POS.
- 29-32 FWD TWO-STEP; 2; TWIRL, 2; e, 4;
 Two fwd two-steps in LOD; While M continues with 4 walking steps, W does 2 R-face twirls under her R and M's L arms; ending in open POS ready to repeat dance.

REPEAT ENTIRE DANCE TWICE (3 TIMES IN ALL), ENDING WITH ONE ADDITIONAL TWIRL FOR W. BOW & CURTSEY.

SMILE DARN YA' SMILE!

Last month I gave a big pat on the back to my favorite Square Dancers—the ones who are Always There. This month I am going to the opposite extreme, and saluting (!) the dancers I Least Like to Dance With — the Scowlers. And I make particular reference to the ones who scowl and mutter 'I can't hear!'

Of course, there are other Scowlers, too. There are the ones who think one couple in the square should not have come to the dance at all, because they are not up to 'our standards', and consider that they—the Scowlers—are stuck. They lose no opportunity of exchanging sour glances and shrugs, often making the poor 'outsiders' goof even worse. I honestly don't think there is a square dancer anywhere who is incompetent enough to spoil a square for me — but a Scowler in the same square succeeds in doing it easily.

Then there is the Scowler who does not think the Caller is good enough to call for him. Maybe the regular Caller has given a newcomer a guest spot, and our friend never heard of him. Maybe the poor guest, nervous already, flubs a line or delays too long. Out come the scowls, and all the efforts of the rest of us to enjoy ourselves in spite of the calling are wet-blanketed.

One particularly annoying Scowler is the guy who comes to the Round-Up, but comes only on Saturday night. All day Saturday and all day Sunday, there has been plenty of room, and plenty to learn and enjoy. But the Big Name Callers are on Saturday night, so our friend comes then, and the place is too crowded! So he scowls as he is battered around the floor, and complains bitterly about the sound and the mob and the level, and swears never to come back. He always does, but still at peak time. He never learns.

I suppose one reason why I am especially annoyed by the Scowler who 'can't hear', is that I see so much of the work and effort that goes into licking the sound problem at most of the big dances. The way most of our larger halls are designed, it is simply unrealistic to expect the same clear sound we are used to having at our Club dances. In spite of really heroic efforts on the part of Callers and Dance Committees, some of our halls continue to whelp everyone. But from the way the Scowlers look, and the way they talk, you would think that anything less than perfect sound was something the Caller had deliberately inflicted on them, just to annoy.

And how about the ones who say they 'can't hear' when no one else in the square has any trouble? Do they mean that they really do have poor hearing, and should get special consideration? Or don't they actually know how they sound? Don't they know that a good square dancer has to hear only about a quarter as much as a poor dancer? Do they realize that what they are really saying is 'I can't think as fast as that'? I'll admit that it is probably true, and if they actually put it that way, I'd sympathize. But going around the square with a frown on your face, muttering to everyone 'The sound is terrible — I can't hear', is simply trying to shift the blame for mistakes onto someone else. The same mistakes, done with spirit and recognized with a wide grin that says "I goofed again!", can raise the spirits of everyone in the square. A whole floor goofing with enthusiasm and howls of laughter is one of the happiest sights in square dancing. But please — no scowls!

P. S. Dan reminds me that there are Lady Scowlers, too. Of course there are, but the men are the ones I meet in a Grand Right and Left. Ladies, you watch your faces, too.

First and third you bow and swing

Head two couples lead to the right
Circle four, don't take all night
Head gents break and form two lines
Forward and back, you're doing fine
Now bend the line and pass thru
Face your partner, right and left thru
Inside arch and the outside under
Circle in the middle, don't you blunder
All the way around and pass on thru
Circle up four with the outside two
Side gents break and form two lines
Forward and back, you're doing fine
Bend the line and pass thru
Face your partner, cross trail thru
You turn back to a left allemande
Here we go, right and left grand . . .

INTRODUCTION:

Honour your partner, give her a swing
Sashay 'round the corner of the ring
Four ladies star to your opposite man
Star right back to your corner man
Allemande left on the old left hand
Here we go in a right and left grand
Half way 'round the ring you go
Meet your partner, do-ci-do
Gonna take a walk with your pal
Promenade that dear sweet gal, and
Swing to that steel guitar rag.

FIGURE:

Head couples bow, head couples swing
Lead out to right of ring
Two four hand stars with right hands
crossed

Back with a left—now don't get lost
Girls turn back and swing that man
Just as handsome as you can
Four hands up and 'round you go
Break right in to a do-ce-do (Note 1)
Just one change and home you go, to
Swing to that steel guitar rag.
