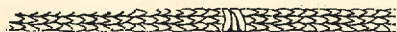

The 5th Annual California Square Dance Convention at Disneyland on April 11, 12, 13, 1958 is now in high gear, and here are the latest developments:

Governor KNIGHT has assured us that he will lead one of the Grand Marches. Workshops, both square and round will start at 2:00 p.m. Friday, 10:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Panels and Clinics will follow the same schedule.

There will be a special Work-Fun-Shop for square dancers at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, with BILL HANSEN, HARLEY SMITH and BOB VAN ANTWERP. With this cast of 'Characters' how can you miss? There will be more of these fun-shops scheduled from all over the State.

The round dancers will have a special session of workshops, clinics and program dance at The Retail Clerks Union Hall, for experienced and advance dancers, Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. This is in addition to the Disneyland Schedule. There will also be a Round Dance Party at the same hall on Sunday at 2:00 p.m.

The After-Party (11:40 p.m. Saturday) offers a Buffet Supper, Fashion Show, Variety Act and Dancing till 2:00 a.m. The party is limited to the first 1200 applicants -- So--Hurry! \$1.25 per person.

RECORD: "Champagne Time" - Coral 61741 (Lawrence Welk)
POSITION: Semi-closed, facing LOD
FOOTWORK: Opposite, directions for M

MEASURES

Part 1

1 - 4 WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; SIDE, CLOSE, SIDE, DRAW;

Walk fwd in LOD 2 slow steps L-R; Face partner assume loose-closed pos and step L to side along LOD, close R to L, cross L in front and to R side of R (W crosses in front also); Repeat starting M's R stepping to side along RLOD; Step L to side along LOD, close R to L, step L to side again along LOD and draw R to L (retain wt on L). End in semi-closed pos, facing RLOD.

5 - 8 WALK, -, 2, -; SIDE, CLOSE, CROSS, -; TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN;

Starting M's R walk fwd in RLOD 2 slow steps R-L; Face partner assume loose closed pos and step R to side along RLOD, close L to R, cross R in front and to L side of L; In closed pos do 2 turning two-steps progressing in LOD. End in semi-closed pos, facing LOD.

9 - 16 REPEAT MEAS 1 - 8.

Part 2

17 - 20 WALK, -, 2, -; PT FWD, -, BACK, CLOSE; FWD, -, 2, -; TO BANJO, -, DIP, -;

Semi-closed pos walk fwd in LOD 2 slow steps L-R; Point L fwd, hold 1 ct, step L bwd, close R to L; Walk fwd 2 slow steps L-R; Then as M steps L fwd, W steps R bwd turning 1/2 L-face to assume banjo pos (R hips adjacent), M "dips" fwd on R as W dips back on L.

21-24 BACK, FACE, DIP, -; BACK, FACE, DIP, -; TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN;

M steps L bwd twd RLOD (W steps R fwd), steps R to side turning R to face partner and wall, crosses L over R twd RLOD (sidcar pos - L hips adjacent), and dips fwd on L (W crosses behind and dips back on R); Repeat action of Meas 21 starting M's R, turning L and moving twd LOD; In closed pos do 2 turning two-steps progressing in LOD. End in semi-closed pos, facing LOD.

25 - 32 REPEAT MEAS 17 - 24.

SQUARE DANCING IS FOR COUPLES

First of all, I don't like anonymous letters. I can see why a person might not like to be quoted, and might ask to have his or her name kept out of it, but if anyone wants me to write something about something, I want to know who it is that is asking. So -- the only reason I am paying any attention at all to this letter, is the fact that I intend to write exactly the opposite of what the anonymous writer wanted said.

The letter in question was from a lady without a partner, who went to a Square Dance (she does not even say where) and was so thrilled when the Caller made a special point of asking all the lone ladies present to make skeleton squares, and then asked the men to fill in -- 'Your wives or girl friends won't mind sitting out one dance. Let's show these girls that we welcome them --' and so on. She thought this was a wonderful idea, and wanted me to write about it and encourage other Callers to do the same.

Right now, I can't think of a better way to kill the kind of Square Dancing that we all love, than to 'encourage' lone women to come, and to make a practice of forcing the men who are there to dance with them. I know that a lot of my friends have a sort of guilty conscience about the fact that they are reluctant to share their husbands with women who are less fortunate -- the same sort of feeling we all get when we are eating a thick steak and someone mentions starving peoples in Asia. I agree that women who have been unable to find partners -- whether for a Square Dance or for Life -- are unfortunate, and I am sorry for them. But letting them dance once an evening with my husband is just as unrealistic a solution to their problem as it would be to wrap up that steak and mail it off to Korea.

Just think of the result, if this idea got around! We all know that there are about twice as many women as men looking for a chance to dance. How long do you think a couple would keep on coming to a Club, if they knew that the man would have to dance every dance, willy-nilly, while his wife sat out every other one? If the lone women were young and pretty, the wives wouldn't like it, and if they were the usual type of women who can't find partners, the men would be stuck. Either way, the great charm of Square Dancing as a couple activity which you share with your husband or wife, would be lost.

Just to prevent argument, let me say right here that I am not talking about the woman who is temporarily without a partner -- the Caller's wife, or the Club member whose husband is in the hospital, or Overseas. These are personal friends, and the loan of a husband for a dance or two can really help, during a difficult time. Besides, they are already Square Dancers, and members of the Clan. My objection is to raising the hopes of unattached women who think square dancing looks like fun, and would like to learn, and expect the Caller to see that they get partners. Even if all they hope for is a partner for the dance, and not for Life, I think it is wrong to encourage them to come to regular Square Dances. Let them try out a Singles Group, if they can find one, although even in Singles Groups there are usually more women than men. But there the men are unattached too, and the Lone Woman is not poaching on anyone else's preserves. If she still can't find anyone to dance with, I would advise her to give it up, and try some other form of entertainment.

I've been accused many times of being 'heartless' and I will probably get it again, after this one. But I care a lot about the activity we call Square Dancing, as it is done by our friends all over the country, and I would hate to see it spoiled by a mistaken idea that it ought to be All Things to All People. As it is, it suits us, and it suits enough other people so that it ought to be saved. There are other activities available to those who do not fit into the picture as it stands, without knocking ourselves out to broaden our program to include them all. There! I said it, and I'm glad!
